**A BILL ENTITLED
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CO-OPERATIVE
SOCIETIES ORDINANCE**

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Co-operative Societies (Amendment) Ordinance, 1951, and shall be read and construed as one with the Co-operative Societies Ordinance hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance

Ordinance

2. Section 55 of the principal Ordinance is amended in the following respects—

(a) by substituting a comma for the full stop at the end of sub-section (4) thereof and by adding thereto the following—

and shall be enforced in the same manner as if the decision had been a judgment of a civil court,

(b) by substituting a comma for the full stop at the end of sub-section (5) thereof, and by adding thereto the following—

and shall be enforced in the same manner as if the award had been a judgment of a civil court

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Co-operative Societies Ordinance (Cap 287) contains no provision whereby the decision of the Registrar, or the award of an arbitrator or arbitrators under section 55 can be enforced

It is considered essential that such decisions and awards should be capable of implementation in order that the purpose of section 55 can be given proper effect

This Bill will amend section 55 to enable these decisions and awards to be enforced in the same manner as judgments of the civil courts

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be incurred if the provisions of this Bill become law
