The only hours for which labour may be ordered during ordinary working days are 7 a.m. noon, 1 p.m., or 4 p.m.

In the event of port labour after being ordered, having to stand by during working or overtime hours awaiting arrival of vessels commencement of work cargo or berth accommodation or where work is stopped due to trimming bulk cargo, shifting cargo removing and replacing hatch covers, clearing and/or dunnaging holds (in overtime hours only) or in other circumstances of a like nature where the fault lies with the ship, the actual cost of such labour shall be debited against the steamship company concerned.

This amendment takes effect as from 1st August 1951.

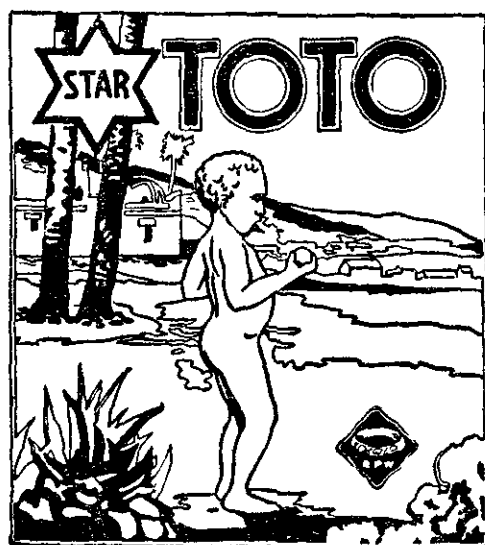

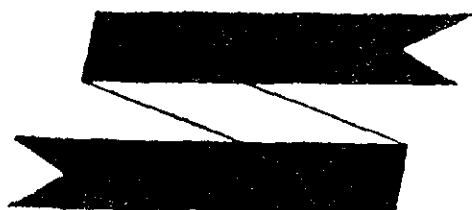
