Tenders should be in terms of the royalty which the tenderer would be willing to pay per ton of fibre and fibre tow produced No offer of less than £10 per ton for fibre will be accepted, and the following conditions will apply —

(g) Apart from the cutting of sanseveria and the maintenance of firebreaks no other form of user shall be permitted

(h) The licensee shall deposit Sh 2,000 on the signing of the licence which is returnable on the termination of the licence provided all the terms and conditions have been satisfactorily carried out

(i) The tenderer shall supply full information of the amount of capital available for the operation of this concession

(3) The successful tenderer will be required to pay within seven days of notification that his tender has been accepted 25 per cent of the amount tendered, together with the rent due to 31st December, 1951

(4) The balance of the purchase price will be payable on demand prior to the issue of title

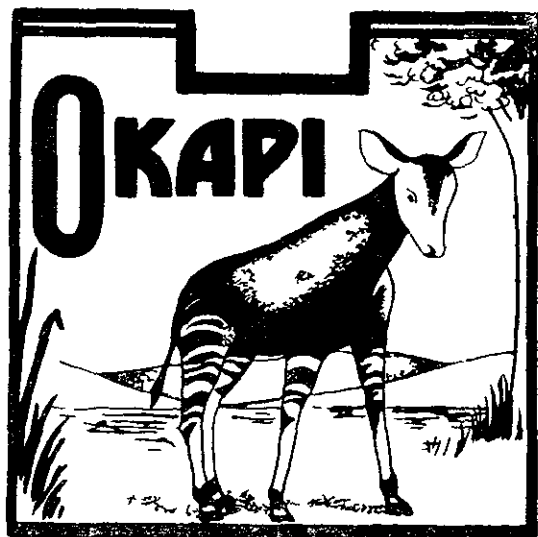
