The following telegram, dated the 9th February, 1952, has been received by His Excellency the Governor from the Secretary of State for the Colonies —

“THE PROCLAMATION of HER MAJESTY QUEEN ELIZABETH THE SECOND was signed at the ACCESSION COUNCIL held on the 8th February Immediately after the signature of the Proclamation HER MAJESTY was pleased to make the following DECLARATION —

‘By the sudden death of my dear Father I am called to assume the duties and responsibilities of Sovereignty At this time of deep sorrow it is a profound consolation to me to be assured of the sympathy which you and all my peoples feel towards me, to my Mother and Sister and to the other members of my family My Father was our revered and beloved head as he was of the wider family of his subjects The grief which his loss brings is shared among us all My heart is too full for me to say more to you to-day than that I shall always work as my Father did throughout his reign to uphold constitutional Government and to advance the happiness and prosperity of my peoples spread as they are all the world over I know that in my resolve to follow his shining example of service and devotion I shall be inspired by the loyalty and affection of those whose Queen I have been called to be, and by the Counsel of their elected Parliaments

I pray that God will help me to discharge worthily this heavy task that has been laid upon me so early in my life ’ ”

**A BILL ENTITLED
AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTMENT, SALARY, TENURE OF OFFICE AND DUTIES AND POWERS OF THE DIRECTOR OF AUDIT AND FOR THE AUDITING OF PUBLIC ACCOUNTS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES INCIDENTAL THERETO AND CONNECTED THEREWITH**

ENACTED by the Governor of the Colony of Kenya, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows —

Short title and commencement

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Audit Ordinance, 1952, and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor may by notice in the Gazette appoint

Interpretation

2. In this Ordinance unless the context otherwise requires—

5

“accounting officer” means any officer charged with the duty of accounting for any service in respect of which moneys have been appropriated by the Legislative Council,

“officer” means any person in the employment of the Government of the Colony,

10

“public moneys” include—

(a) the public revenues of the Colony,

(b) any trust or other moneys held, whether temporarily or otherwise, by any officer in his official capacity either alone or jointly with any other person, whether an officer or not

15

Appointment and salary of Director of Audit

3. (1) The Governor, with the approval of the Secretary of State, shall appoint an officer to be styled the Director of Audit who shall not be capable while holding the said office of holding any other office of profit under the Crown. The annual salary of the Director of Audit shall be one thousand nine hundred pounds and such salary shall be charged on and paid out of the public revenues of the Colony

(2) The officer who at the commencement of this Ordinance holds the office of Director of Audit shall be deemed to have been appointed Director of Audit under this section

25

Tenure of office

4. (1) The Director of Audit shall hold office during good behaviour and may only be removed by the Governor with the approval of the Secretary of State

(2) Save as is otherwise provided in sub-section (1) of this section, the Director of Audit shall be deemed to be an officer in the public service of the Colony and the provisions of the law and regulations in force relating to the public service shall apply to him,

30

5. On any vacancy occurring in the office of the Director of Audit from death, retirement, resignation or other cause the Governor, with the approval of the Secretary of State, shall appoint a person in his place

Duty to fill vacancy in office of Director of Audit

5 6. (1) In the event of the illness, suspension or absence of the Director of Audit, the Governor may appoint an officer to act as Director of Audit during such illness, suspension or absence

Acting Director of Audit

(2) In the event of the post of Director of Audit becoming
10 vacant the Governor may appoint a person to act as Director of Audit pending the appointment of a Director of Audit in accordance with the provisions of section 5 of this Ordinance

(3) Every person appointed to act as Director of Audit pursuant to the provisions of this section shall have and may
15 exercise all the powers and authority and shall perform the duties by this Ordinance conferred and imposed on the Director of Audit

7. (1) The staff required to assist the Director of Audit in the performance of his duties shall be composed of such
20 officers as the Governor may determine

Staff of Audit office

(2) Anything which under the authority of this Ordinance or of any other law is directed to be done by the Director of Audit, other than the certifying and reporting of accounts for the Legislative Council, may be done by any officer of his
25 staff so authorized by him

8. (1) The Director of Audit shall, on behalf of the Legislative Council, examine, inquire into and audit the accounts of all accounting officers and of all persons entrusted with the collection, receipt, custody, issue or payment of public moneys, or with the receipt, custody, issue, sale, transfer or delivery of
30 any stamps, securities, stores or other Government property

Duties of Director of Audit

(2) The Director of Audit shall satisfy himself—

(a) that all reasonable precautions have been taken to safeguard the collection of public moneys and that the laws, directions or instructions relating thereto
35 have been duly observed, and

(b) that all money appropriated or otherwise disbursed has been expended and applied for the purpose or purposes for which the grants made by the Legislative Council were intended to provide and that the
40 expenditure conforms to the authority which governs it

9. (1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any law contained, the accounts of any corporate body established by an Ordinance of the Legislative Council of the Colony
45 shall be audited by the Director of Audit if the Legislative Council by resolution so directs In the exercise of his duties under this section the Director of Audit—

Accounts of statutory bodies

(a) shall have, in relation to any such corporate body and its members, officers and employees, the same discretion and powers as are conferred upon him by sections 8 and 11 of this Ordinance in relation to public moneys, stamps, securities, stores or other Government property,

(b) may authorize any person publicly carrying on the profession of accountant or any officer to inspect, examine or audit the books and accounts of any body which he may be required to examine and audit pursuant to the provisions of this section and such person or officer shall report thereon to the

Provided that any such authority given to an officer shall be subject to the concurrence of the head of the department in which the officer is employed

(2) The Director of Audit shall report on his examination 5
and audit of the accounts referred to in this section and shall transmit such report to the Member for presentation to the Legislative Council

Provided that—

- (i) the Member shall obtain the observations of the body 10
on any matter to which attention has been called by the Director of Audit in his report, and such observations shall be presented to the Legislative Council with the said report,
- (ii) if the Member fails within a reasonable time to present 15
such report to Legislative Council, the Director of Audit shall transmit such report to the Speaker of the Legislative Council to be by him presented to the said Council

10. If at any time it appears to the Director of Audit 20
that any irregularities have occurred in the receipt, custody or expenditure of public moneys or in the receipt, custody, issue, sale, transfer or delivery of any stamps, securities, stores or other Government property, or in the accounting for the same, he shall immediately bring the matter to the notice of 25
the Member

Powers of

11. (1) In the exercise of his duties under this Ordinance the Director of Audit may—

- (a) call upon any officer for any explanations and information he may require in order to enable him to 30
discharge his duties,
- (b) authorize any officer on his behalf to conduct any inquiry, examination, or audit and such officer shall report thereon to the Director of Audit

Provided that any such authority shall be sub- 35
ject to the concurrence of the head of the department in which the officer concerned is employed,

- (c) without payment of any fee cause search to be made in and extracts to be taken from any book, document or record in any public office, 40
- (d) examine upon oath, declaration or affirmation (which oath, declaration or affirmation the Director of Audit is hereby empowered to administer) all persons whom he may think fit to examine respecting the receipt or expenditure of money or the receipt 45
or issue of any stores affected by the provisions of this Ordinance and respecting all other matters and things whatever necessary for the due performance and exercise of the duties and powers vested in him,
- (e) lay before the Attorney General a case in writing as 50
to any question regarding the interpretation of any Ordinance or regulation concerning the powers of the Director of Audit or the discharge of his duties, and the Attorney General shall give a written opinion on such case 55

(2) In the exercise of his duties under this Ordinance the Director of Audit or any person duly authorized by him shall have access to all records, books, vouchers, documents, cash, stamps, securities, stores or other Government property in the possession of any officer.

(3) Any person examined pursuant to the provisions of paragraph (d) of sub-section (1) of this section who gives a false answer to any question put to him or makes a false statement on any matter knowing that answer or statement to be false or not knowing or believing it to be true shall be deemed to be guilty of perjury and shall be liable to be prosecuted and punished accordingly

12. Within a period of four months after the close of each financial year the Accountant General shall transmit to the Director of Audit accounts showing fully the financial position of the Colony on the last day of such financial year. Such accounts shall include—

- (a) a statement of assets and liabilities,
- (b) an annual abstract of accounts,
- (c) a detailed statement of revenue and expenditure, and
- (d) such other statements as the Legislative Council may, from time to time, require

13. (1) The Director of Audit shall prepare and transmit to the Member within seven months after the close of each financial year a report upon his examination and audit of all accounts relating to public moneys, stamps securities, stores and other Government property, together with certified copies of the accounts referred to in the last preceding section

(2) The Member shall lay such report on the table of the Legislative Council within thirty days of its receipt by him or if the Legislative Council is not in session within fourteen days after the commencement of its next sitting

(3) The Director of Audit may at any time if it appears to him to be desirable transmit a special report to the Member for presentation in like manner to the Legislative Council. Such special report may be made on any matter incidental to his powers and duties under this Ordinance

(4) If the Member does not within the time prescribed lay such annual or special report on the table of the Legislative Council the Director of Audit shall forthwith transmit such report to the Speaker of the Legislative Council to be by him presented to the said Council

MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Consequent upon the devolution upon the Government of the Colony of certain financial powers which until 1949 were exercised by the Secretary of State for the Colonies the accounts of the Colony are now certified by the Director of Audit instead of the Director General of Colonial Audit in the United Kingdom. A corollary to this devolution is that the powers, duties and salary of the Director of Audit should be provided for by statute and this Bill will so provide

The most important clauses of the Bill are *clause 3* (1) which will specify the salary of the Director of Audit and make it a direct charge on the public revenues of the Colony, *clause 8* which sets out the functions of the Director of Audit and makes it clear that in exercising those functions he is acting on behalf of the Legislative Council, *clause 9* which confers on the Director of Audit when directed by the Legislative Council power to audit the accounts of any corporate body established by an Ordinance passed by the Legislative Council, *clause 11* which confers on the Director of Audit certain powers which he may exercise in performing his duties under the Ordinance, and *clause 13* whereby the duty of certifying the accounts of the Colony is imposed on the Director of Audit

No additional expenditure of public moneys will be incurred if the provisions of this Bill become law
