Notice of the Imposition of Drought Restrictions on the Extraction of Water from Certain Rivers in the Nairobi, Kiambu and Thika Districts

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Water Apportionment Board by section 27 of the Water Ordinance, 1951, holders of water extraction permits in the Nairobi, Kiambu and Thika Districts are hereby notified that due to the drought conditions no water may be directly diverted from the rivers and their tributaries appearing in the Schedule to this notice—

(a) for irrigation purposes,

(b) under permits valid for flood flow only.

Diversions from normal flow may continue except that diversions from normal flow for irrigation purposes must cease until further notice.

Extraction of water from dams may continue for irrigation purposes so long as the flow of the river downstream of the dam is not lower than the flow of the river into the dam.
