- (1) a site layout plan in sufficient detail to show the siting of the buildings in relation to the plot boundaries
- (11) an indication of the number of bedrooms and other rooms to be constructed this accommodation to be completed and ready for occupation within 36 months of the commencement of the term of the grant Applicants may if they wish submit their plans for subsequent additional development
