## ELDORET—CINEMA PLOT

THE Commissioner of Lands gives notice that tenders in terms of proposals for development are invited for the purpose of erecting a cinema on the plot as described in the Schedule hereto

2 A plan of the plot may be seen at the Public Map Office situated in the Lands Department building, City Square, Nairobi, or at the office of the District Commissioner, Eldoret, or may be obtained from the Public Map Office, P.O. Box 30089, Nairobi, on payment of Sh 4 post free

## Tenders

1 Sealed envelopes marked "Tender for Cinema Plot" must be deposited with the District Commissioner Eldoret before noon on 13th October, 1960

2 Each tender should be accompanied by a statement containing a detailed description of the proposal of the tenderer for the development of the site. Proposals must be in accordance with the township by-laws and should be for a cinema on modern lines

3 The stand premium, annual rental and fees payable in respect of the preparation and registration of the grant together with the stamp duty (which is approximately 2 per cent of the stand premium and the rent) in respect of the grant must be paid within 14 days of the demand therefor

4 In the consideration of tenders, regard will be paid to the relative merits of the proposals and the financial sufficiency of the tenderer(s) to undertake them

5 Particular attention will be paid to the tenderer's ability to provide films of good quality

6 The Commissioner does not undertake to accept any of the submitted tenders

7 The tenders shall be deemed to be upon and subject to the conditions herein contained and the provisions of the Crown Lands Ordinance (Cap 155 of the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya) and in particular Part VII thereof

8 The grant will be issued in the name of the allottee as stated in the letter of application

9 Grants will be made under the Crown Lands Ordinance (Cap 155 of the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya) and title will be issued under the Registration of Titles Ordinance. The term of the grants will be 99 years from the first day of the month following the notification of the approval of the grant

## Special Conditions

1 No building shall be erected on the land nor shall additions or external alterations be made to any buildings otherwise than in conformity with plans and specifications previously approved in writing by the Commissioner of Lands and the Local Authority. The Commissioner shall not give his approval unless he is satisfied that the proposals are such as to develop the land adequately and satisfactorily

2 The grantee shall within six months of the commencement of the term submit in triplicate to the Local Authority and the Commissioner of Lands plans (including block plans showing the positions of the buildings and a system of drainage for the disposal of sewage surface and sullage water), drawings, elevations and specifications of the buildings the grantee proposes to erect on the land and shall within 24 months of the commencement of the term complete the erection of such buildings and the construction of the drainage system in conformity with such plans, drawings, elevations and specifications as amended (if such be the case) by the Commissioner provided that if default shall be made in the performance or observance of any of the requirements of this condition it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Lands or any person authorized by him on behalf of Her Majesty to re-enter into and upon the land or any part thereof in the name of the whole and thereupon the term hereby created shall cease but without prejudice to any right of action or remedy of Her Majesty the Governor or the Commissioner in respect of any antecedent breach of any condition herein contained

Provided further than should the grantee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that he/she is unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid the Commissioner of Lands shall (at the grantee's expense) accept a surrender of the land comprised herein

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given (1) within 12 months of the commencement of the term the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee 50 per centum of the stand premium paid in respect of the land, or (2) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee 25 per centum of the said stand premium. In the event of notice being given after the expiration of the said building period no refund shall be made

3 The land and buildings shall only be used for the purposes of a cinema

4 The buildings shall not cover more than 90 per centum of the area of the land and shall conform to a building line decided upon by the Local Authority

5 The grantee shall not subdivide the land

6 The grantee shall not sell, transfer, sublet or charge the land or any part thereof (except in respect of a loan required for building purposes to be approved by the Commissioner in writing) until Special Condition No 2 has been performed

7 The grantee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such sum as the Commissioner may estimate to be the proportionate cost of constructing all roads and drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land

8 The grantee shall from time to time pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such proportion of the cost of maintaining all roads and drains serving or adjoining the land as the Commissioner may assess
