CEYLON AWARDS 1961

KENYA CULTURAL CENTRE

REPORT FOR THE YEAR 1959

Your Council met on seven occasions during the year. The main matters that concerned the Council during the course of the year were —

1 *Financing and Planning of the Additions to the Cultural Centre*

Considerable difficulties were experienced in finding finance for this, but as a result of lengthy negotiations the President and Honorary Treasurer were able to make arrangements with the Kenya Building Society for a loan up to £30,000 at a favourable rate of interest, which has been guaranteed by the Kenya Government, such loan to be repaid over a period of approximately 18 years. At the present state of progress it is not anticipated that the full sum requested will be required.

The following Constituent Members have agreed to have accommodation in the new building —

This takes up all the available accommodation other than the Committee Room and General Purposes Hall which will be available for letting from time to time and the flat which is to be used for the purposes of the Cultural Centre staff. Recovering of the cost of the building has been arranged as follows —

Two schemes have been offered to the interested Constituent Members, either a Scheme of Tenant Purchase, where the Constituent Member concerned will be charged a proportionate cost of the area occupied and will borrow from the Cultural Centre the sum required for payment, such sum being repaid to the Cultural Centre over a period of 18 years in bi-annual instalments of capital and interest at the rate of 7 per cent. The alternate scheme is a straight form of letting at so much a sq ft per annum for the area occupied. At the moment the cost of renting will be approximately Sh 8/50 per sq ft per annum. This figure cannot be calculated finally until the building is completed, but it is not anticipated that it will be above this sum. Occupiers of the building will also be called upon to share a proportion of the running costs, including maintenance of the building.

Some income will also arise from the letting of the General Purposes Hall and the Committee Room which we hope will be sufficient for repayment of that portion of the building and for the general funds of the Cultural Centre.

It is anticipated that the building will be handed over by the contractors in October (very much behind schedule) and that the Official Opening of the War Memorial will take place as soon as possible after that date.

At the meeting of 11th September, 1959, of this Board of Management, various matters were discussed concerning the design of the building and these suggestions were discussed with the architects and incorporated in the building.

2 *Theatre Committee*

In accordance with representations from interested parties, the Theatre Committee was reconstituted and in accordance with recommendations from this Board of Management certain persons were elected to the Theatre Committee to work on behalf of the theatre as a whole and not as representing any particular body. This committee has been acting regularly and actively since its appointment.

3 *Kenya National Theatre*

The Kenya National Theatre was used for the following performances during the year —

In addition to the above the theatre was used for Film Censorship and Rehearsals.

The Council wish to record their very grateful thanks to all the considerable voluntary work given by the various members during the year, without whose help the theatre would not have functioned as efficiently as it did. The Council have considered various recommendations from the Theatre Committee from time to time and further recommendations for improvements will be considered and carried out in accordance with the priority as to their necessity and the funds available.

4 *Accounts for the Year*

There was an excess of expenditure over income for the year from the theatre of Sh 20,689 after providing for depreciation on the various assets of Sh 42,486. After including income from investments and interests on deposits less other expenses of the Kenya Cultural Centre, the net excess expenditure over income for the year was Sh 10,978.

Additions to the theatre during the year were completed in regard to the roofing of the bar balcony which amounted to Sh 18,280. There was also the renewal of the carpet in the auditorium, certain improvements to the lighting and sound equipment and a purchase of a standard box set of scenery for use by the renters of the theatre for which a charge is made.

The Council wish to record their grateful thanks, once again, to the Honorary Auditors for their work on these Accounts.

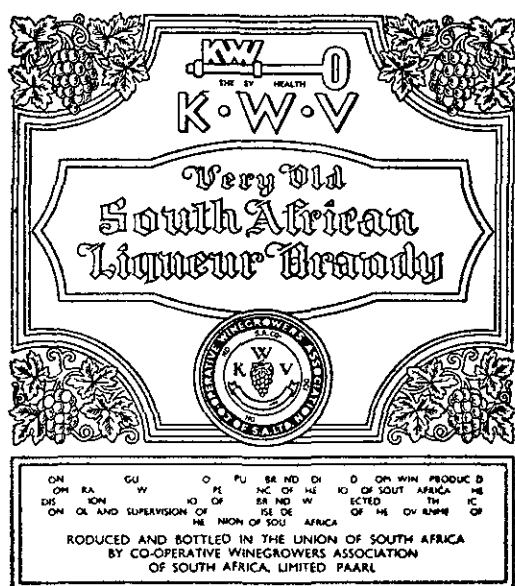

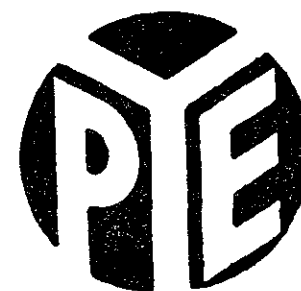
