- (a) Compensation will not be paid to growers who have not submitted final crop statements to the Kenya Farmers' Association within a period of six weeks from the average harvesting dates, or within three weeks of the publication of this notice, whichever is the later and will not be paid in respect of any deliveries in excess of the quantities stated on the final crop statements
- (b) Growers must make every effort to deliver their crop in the month for which delivery orders have been issued should a grower receive a delivery order in one month and not comply with it until the following month or later, he will receive only the allowance applicable to the month for which the delivery order was made out

OVERSEAS SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ENGINEERING CANDIDATES

APPLICATIONS are invited for the award of scholarships which form part of a scheme instituted by the Federation of British Industries to provide graduate engineers from overseas with practical training in industrial establishments in the United Kingdom.

The scholarships offered by the Federation are of three types:—

Type A.—For recently graduated engineers. They provide training for two years and living expenses at the rate of £476 per annum, free of income tax. They also cover the cost of travel to and from the United Kingdom. They are awarded to candidates of special merit, who would otherwise be unable to take advantage of the training facilities offered.

Type B.—Also for recently graduated engineers. They provide training for two years and living expenses at the rate of £476 per annum free of income tax, but do not cover the cost of travel to the United Kingdom. Successful candidates are required to pay their passages to Britain, and to deposit in advance the cost of their homeward passages.

Type C.—For more experienced applicants. They provide training from six to 12 months and the major part of living expenses. They are designed for the benefit of practising engineers whose employers, whether public or private organizations or Government Departments, are willing to release them temporarily, and support their applications. Successful candidates are required to contribute to their maintenance at the rate of £100 a year. They are also required to pay their passages to the United Kingdom and to deposit in advance the cost of their homeward passages. They receive maintenance payments from the Federation at the rate of £450 per annum, free of income tax.

Qualifications

All applicants must—

- (a) hold a degree or diploma in engineering issued by a recognized university faculty, institute or school;
- (b) be able to profit from training in industrial—as distinct from academic—surroundings;
- (c) be medically fit;
- (d) speak and write English well;
- (e) possess good character, initiative and a sense of responsibility;
- (f) undertake to return and follow their profession in their own country.

Applicants for Types A and B scholarships should normally—

- (g) have recently graduated;
- (h) have had not more than two years' industrial or practical experience;
- (i) require general practical training in engineering.

Applicants for Type C scholarships should normally—

- (j) be not more than 35 years of age;
- (k) have had not less than five years' practical experience;
- (l) wish to secure specialized knowledge in a particular branch of engineering;
- (m) provide letters from their employers supporting their applications and consenting to release them for the required period of training, if an award is made.

Finance

Maintenance payments start from the date of arrival in the United Kingdom and end on the date of departure, provided that this takes place within a reasonable time of completion of training. These payments are made by the Federation monthly in advance.

Application

Persons in Kenya wishing to apply for any of the above scholarships, if they have the required qualifications and can comply with the other conditions set out above, should write to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education, P.O. Box 30040, Nairobi, giving full details of their qualifications and personal particulars. The closing date for applications is 24th January, 1961. Suitable applicants will be invited to attend at their own expense an interview in Nairobi and will be informed separately of the place, date and time for the interview.

THE Government of Ghana proposes to award three scholarships during 1961 to suitably qualified persons from other African States or Territories, independent or dependent countries. The field of study will be at University and Professional levels and will embrace all courses offered at the University College of Ghana, the Kumasi College of Technology and the College of Administration, namely: B.A. (General and Honours), LL.B., B.Sc. (General), (Sociology) (Special), (Agriculture) and (Economics), Divinity, Engineering, Pharmacy, Accountancy, Secretaryship and Administration.

Terms

The scholarship, which will normally be for the duration of the course for which an award is made, will cover full board and lodging, books, examination and other institutional fees. Free medical treatment as well as clothing replacement allowance will be provided. Free passages to and from Ghana will also be provided.

Qualifications

Candidates, who must be citizens of an African State or Territory, should possess the Higher School Certificate with at least two passes at "Principal" level in subjects relevant to the course of study they wish to pursue, or the General Certificate of Education with passes in at least five subjects two of which must be at "Advanced" level in relevant subjects, or an equivalent qualification. An adequate knowledge of English is desirable; in special cases, however, a preliminary language course will be arranged for successful candidates who have no knowledge of the English Language which is the medium of instruction.

Method of Application

Interested persons can apply for application forms to Registrar of Scholarships, Accra, to whom also, all further enquiries in this matter should be directed.
