THE WEIGHTS AND MEASURES RULES, 1952 (G N 694 of 1952)

Approval of Instrument Presenting Novel Features

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by rule 20 of the Weights and Measures Rules 1952 the Minister for Commerce and Industry hereby approves for trade use a pattern of instrument for the weighing of green leaf tea on tea estates which has been submitted by Messrs Kettles-Roy and Tyson Limited Nairobi

The pattern of instrument approved is a modified form of Salters No 235 T spring balance which—

- (a) is permanently tared for use with a green leaf tea sheet weighing four pounds,
- (b) is of 50 lb capacity with a red dial which is graduated into 4-oz white subdivisions
- (c) the dial is clearly and permanently marked with a legend in white stating "For Tea Estate Use Only",
- (d) has a range of adjustment for balancing amounting to plus or minus four ounces after a green leaf tea sheet has been placed on the load hook

Detailed drawings and photographs of the instrument have been lodged with me at the Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Nairobi and copies thereof may be inspected upon application to the Superintendent of Weights and Measures at the head-quarters of the Weights and Measures Department Nairobi, during office hours
