CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

APPLICATIONS are invited from persons resident in Kenya, who left school in 1959/60, for the following posts for trainees and must be submitted through the principal of the last secondary school attended, to the Secretary, Civil Service. The minimum educational standard for all vacancies is a Cambridge School Certificate Division II unless otherwise stated (the year of passing must be given) entitling successful candidates to be appointed at £208 10s. p.a. initially. For those with Higher School Certificate the entry point will be £290 5s. for men and £276 15s. for women and for those with a degree from Makerere College £513. At the end of the first year of training and on passing an examination, trainees will be eligible for the scale £471 by £21 to £555. Trainees will serve on temporary terms during the period of training.

Candidates may submit an application in respect of *one* post only though a second choice may be mentioned in cage 1 of the form. Applications in triplicate must be supported by—

- (a) a letter of recommendation in original in respect of the vacancy for which application is made, from the principal of the last secondary school attended. Application forms should be sent to the principal who should forward them to the Secretary;
- (b) an essay in the applicant's writing of not more than 300 words stating the reasons for applying for the particular vacancy;

Librarian (Trainee)—Medical Research Laboratory, Ministry of Health
