LOANS FOR HIGHER EDUCATION

APPLICATIONS for educational loans for higher education are now invited from the parents or guardians of students wishing to pursue higher education. The following are the conditions governing the granting of loans:—

1. The parent or guardian of the student shall, at the date of application, be a permanent resident of the Colony.

2. The student shall have already been admitted to, or have obtained the promise of, admission to a university or institution of higher education. The parent or guardian should state whether an application for admission has been made through the Ministry of Education.

3. The parent or guardian shall make a written declaration as to his financial inability to make provision in whole or in part for the continued education of the student.

4. The candidate shall be not less than 17 years of age at the time of application.

5. The parent or guardian shall give proof of such reasonable security as the Board of Management shall require. The security may take the form of mortgage on property, insurance policies with an adequate surrender value and personal bonds signed by substantial citizens.

6. Payment of loans will be made in instalments over a period of study, and interest will be payable on such instalment at the rate of $4\frac{1}{4}$ per centum per annum.

7. Loans shall be repaid, together with interest, over a period of not more than eight years, the first instalment of such repayment to be paid not more than 18 months after the receipt of the last instalment of the loan.

8. Students in respect of whom loans are issued will be expected to return to the Colony and take up employment in it on completion of their studies.
