For the purposes of these charges, a child is one between the apparent ages of 12 and 16 years; children below 12 years have free admission to the ground except for the stand, where all children except babies in arms, must pay admission charges.

## (ii) Occasions Where the Stadium is Hired

(a) Where no admission is levied: Sh. 50 per hour with a minimum charge of Sh. 50 and a maximum charge of Sh. 400 for any one day.

(b) Where admission charges are levied by the organizers:—

(b) Hirer will be responsible for supplying equipment.

(c) The Council will be responsible for preparation of the ground, supply of tickets and basic equipment.
