Motor Trade and Allied Industries Employers Association Issues in Dispute:

- (a) Whether the refusal by the Employers to deduct Insurance Premius on cheeff-off is a negotiable matter.
- (b) If it is a negotiable matter, whether the Employers must comply with the Union's demand.
- The Kenya Motor Engineering and Allied Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and the Motor Trade and Allied Industries Employers Association shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents.

The issues in dispute as stated by the parties in Form "A" are (a) Refusal to deduct Insurance Premiums on check-off and (b) Whether the issue is a negotiable matter or not. However, during the mention of this dispute on 9th July 1968 the President ruled that the issues in dispute should be as they appear

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 9th day of August 1968 and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

6. An agreement on matters governing Recognition, Negotiating and Grievance Procedure was entered into and signed by the Parties on 16th October 1963.

In clause 1 (c) of this agreement provision is made for:—

"Collective bargaining machinery for negotiations on an Industry basis for those terms and conditions of service as listed in Appendix "A" of this Agreement for those employees listed in Appendix "B" of this Agreement."

Appendix "A" referred to in clause 1 (c) contains the following list:-

- 1. Rates of Pay, Overtime and Allowances.
- 2. Hours of Work.
- 3. Methods of Wage Payment.
- 4. Leave.
- 5. Duration and Termination of Contract.
- 6. Principles of Redundancy.
- 7. Medical Expenses and Sick Pay.
- 8. Provident Fund Benefits.

The Claimants have argued that their demand falls under item (3) above.

The Court cannot accept this submission as by no stretch of imagination can it be held that "Methods of Wage Payment" includes the deduction of insurance premiums on checkoff.

The Court feels that the Claimants' demand in the present dispute should be discussed and handled through the Joint Consultative Machinery for which provision is made in Part D of the Recognition Agreement.

Further the Court cannot accept that even if discussion did take place on the Claimants' demands at the J.I.C. level that this renders the matter negotiable. The Court is satisfied that the Respondents discussed this matter with the Claimants with out prejudice to their rights under the Recognition Agreement. They, like any good employer, wanted to explore with a view to helping the Claimtants in making arrangements, if feasible, which would be in the interest of the workers.

In view of the foregoing reasons and after a careful consideration of all the submissions made by the parties the Court rules that the subject matter of this dispute is not a negotiable




