E.A. COMMUNITY SALARIES REVIEW COMMISSION (GENERAL FUND SERVICES)

GENERAL NOTICE

IT IS notified for general information that the East African Authority have appointed a Salaries Review Commission with the following terms of reference:—

- (a) To consider and make recommendations with regard to salaries of the categories of staff within the scales of "S" and "FI" (i.e. those earning Sh. 150 to Sh. 1,033 per month). The Commission should exclude consideration of fringe benefits;


