TRAINING REVIEW COMMITTEE

FOLLOWING the recommendations in Chapter XI of the Report of the Commission of Inquiry (Public Service Structure and Remuneration Commission), the Government has appointed a Committee of Review on Training consisting of the following members:—

W. N. Wamalwa, Chairman, Public Service Commission (*Chairman*);

S. W. Karanja, Registrar of the University of Nairobi (*Member*);

Dr. B. A. N. Collins, Professor of Government and Public Administration, University of Guyana (*Member*);

Miss K. K. Sondhi, Under Secretary, Office of the President (*Secretary*).

The Terms of Reference of the Committee are:—

- (a) To examine the Kenya Government's existing training policy, objectives and programmes in the light of current and foreseeable training priorities and recommend what changes may be necessary.
- (b) To examine the structure of the Government's training organization and consider what changes may be necessary to make it a more effective instrument for meeting Kenya's needs for manpower development and improved job performance.

- (c) To advise on the most suitable methods of staffing and financing training institutions.
- (d) To consider how best to achieve optimum collaboration between training institutes and co-operation between the public and private sectors in training matters.
- (e) To advise on methods for the selection of trainees and the evaluation of the effectiveness of training.
- (f) To assess and advise on the financial implications that may arise from the Committee's recommendations.

The Committee will be inviting individuals and organizations to give evidence but any interested parties may submit written memoranda or apply to appear before the Committee at one of its public hearings. All memoranda and requests for hearings should be submitted to the Secretary, Training Review Committee, Private Bag, Nairobi, not later than 30th June, 1971. Memoranda and evidence given will be treated in confidence.

The Committee will hold hearings at Mombasa, Kisumu, Nakuru and Nyeri as well as Nairobi at dates and times to be notified in the Press and on the V.O.K. The offices of the Committee will be on the 7th floor of Harambee House, Harambee Avenue, Nairobi.
