*Director, National Industrial Training Scheme (One Post)*  
(No. 243/71)

*Salary scale.*—£2,334 to £2,820. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should preferably be professionally qualified in mechanical, civil or electrical engineering, with experience of working in industry; or should be in possession of a Higher National Certificate or Final of the City and Guilds Examination, in any of the branches of engineering mentioned, in addition to a teaching or industrial experience. They must have a wide knowledge or experience of industrial training needs, and be able to design training programmes and courses for apprentices and trainees which will be carried out through employer's training schemes, or in formal industrial or technical training institutions. The successful candidate will be required to be responsible for all provisions of the amended Industrial Training Act, and especially to co-ordinate the policy for industrial training as recommended by the National Industrial Training Council and its related Industrial Training Committees. He will also be expected to perform administrative duties and to control staff engaged in training and inspection duties related to the Industrial Training Act.

- (b) If the application is successful and the applicant fails to take up and pay for the plot offered to him within a period of 14 days as required in paragraph 5 below, the Commissioner of Lands may declare the deposit forfeited and the applicant shall have no further claim thereto.

5. The allottee shall pay to the Murang'a County Council within 14 days of notification that his application has been approved the assessed stand premium and proportion of annual rent, together with the fees payable in respect of the preparation and registration of the lease and the stamp duty. In default of payment within the specified time the Commissioner of Lands or the County Council may cancel the allocation and the applicant shall have no further claim to the lease of the plot.

## General Condition

1. The grant will be made under the Trust Land Act (Cap. 288). The term of the lease will be 33 years from the first day of the month following the notification of the approval of the lease.

## Special Conditions

1. The grantee shall erect for occupation within 24 months of the commencement of the term buildings of approved design on proper foundations constructed of stone, burnt-brick or concrete with roofing of tiles or other permanent materials approved by the Council and shall maintain the same (including the external paintwork) in good and substantial repair and condition to the satisfaction of the County Council.

2. The erection of buildings shall not be commenced until plans (including block plans showing the position of the buildings and a system of drainage for disposal of sewage, surface and sullage water), drawings, elevations and specifications shall be submitted in triplicate to the County Council.

3. No additions shall be made to the buildings without prior consent in writing of the County Council.

4. The land and buildings shall only be used for a cinema (excluding the sale of petrol) and the grantee shall throughout the term and to the satisfaction of the local authority make substantial use of the land and buildings for such purpose.

5. The land shall not be used in any manner which the County Council considers to be dangerous or offensive to the public in the neighbourhood.

6. The land shall not be subdivided.

7. The grantee shall not alienate the land or part thereof by sale, charge, transfer of possession, sublease, bequest or other wise, howsoever without the previous consent in writing of the County Council and no application for such consent (except in respect of a loan required for building purposes) will be considered until Special Condition No. 1 has been performed.

8. The grantee shall pay all sums that may from time to time be demanded by the County Council in respect of the cost of constructing, maintaining, repairing, improving and renewing all roads, drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land.

9. The grantee shall be responsible for the payment of all taxes, charges or duties of whatever description that may be levied, imposed or charged by the County Council or Government upon land or buildings.

10. The grantee shall on receipt of notice in writing in that behalf from the County Council forthwith adequately fence or hedge the land and shall thereafter maintain such fence or hedge to the satisfaction of the County Council.

11. The County Council or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon the land and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes and drains, telephone and telegraph wires and electric mains of all descriptions either overhead or underground.

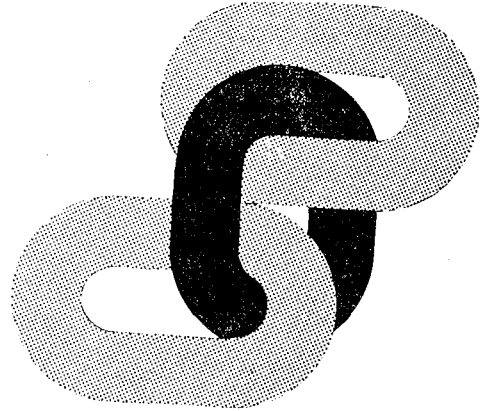

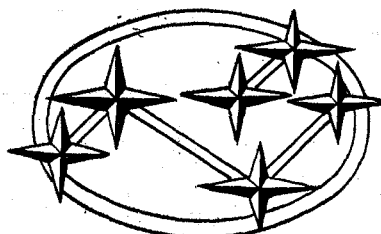

- (3) *Bill Supplement* contains Bills which are for introduction into the National Assembly only.
- (4) *Act Supplement* contains Acts passed by the National Assembly.

All "copy" submitted for publication should be prepared on one side of a foolscap sheet no matter how small the notice or Act, each page being numbered, and should be typewritten with double spacing. Copy should be clear, legible, and contain a minimum of alterations.

Particular attention should be paid to the following points:—

- (i) Signatures must be clarified by means of rubber-stamping or typing the name of the signer in capital letters.
- (ii) Dates must be correct and filled in where necessary.
- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings to notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya.

Extract from the Code of Regulations, section D—

**Kenya Gazette**

D.41. (1) Communications for the *Kenya Gazette* should reach the Government Printer not later than 12 noon on Tuesday of the week that publication is desired. The Government Printer will not publish communications received after that hour until the next subsequent issue of the *Gazette*.

(2) It will facilitate work at the Press if Permanent Secretaries will forward *Gazette* notices to the Government Printer when ready.

It is emphasized that these notes are for guidance only, but it is requested that persons submitting copy for publication first satisfy themselves that such copy is complete in every respect.

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Subscribers and advertisers are advised to remit subscriptions or advertisement charges by cheque, postal order or money order drawn in favour of "The Government Printer, Nairobi". Revenue stamps cannot be accepted. Subscriptions and advertisement charges must be paid in advance.
