Applicants must be civil servants who are qualified in accordance with the scheme of service for Accountancy Grades (Personnel Circular No 32 of 10th November, 1966), and be suitable in all other respects for consideration for appointment to this grade. Preference will be given to those who are familiar with the National Social Security Fund Act, 1965.

Duties include administration and management of professional and technical work in rehabilitation vocational training, cottage industries and other manufacturing workshops for disabled persons.

Community Development Officer (Youth) (Five Posts) (No 14/72)

Salary scale—£936 to £1,254 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants should possess a degree preferably in Education and have considerable experience in working with young people or an acceptable equivalent combination of both. They must have administrative ability and have dedication to work with local people in the rural areas. Duties include supervision of projects and resources for rural development and the training of young people, particularly school leavers for self employment, wage employment and determination of their training needs.

Assistant Community Development Officer (Vocational Rehabilitation) (Nine Posts) (No 15/72)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants should possess the East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent with at least three years' industrial and commercial experience. Applicants in possession of a Diploma in Social Work from a recognized institution will also be considered. Successful candidates will be required to carry out a range of semi professional and technical duties such as managing smaller centres, rehabilitation and vocational training, employment and resettlement of the disabled, etc.

Assistant Community Development Officer (Ten Posts) (No 16/72)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants should possess the East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent, with at least three years' experience in Community Development or related field. Training in Community Development or Social Work will be an advantage. Successful candidates will be posted to districts to assist in the running of Community Development projects.

Vacancies in the Ministry of Works

Senior Inspector (Buildings) (Four Posts) (No 17/72)

Salary scale—£936 to £1,254 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants should be of East African Certificate of Education standard or its equivalent. They must have completed an approved apprenticeship or training in a recognized building trade and obtained the Buildings Technician's Certificate from the Kenya Polytechnic or its equivalent. In addition, they must have at least four years' relevant practical experience and have a thorough knowledge of the Ministry of Works standard specifications, Government Regulations and procedures relating to buildings, stores, financial control and have experience in reinforced concrete making and carrying out the various tests required. Ability to read and interpret drawings, bills of quantities, surveying, levelling and estimate costs of new buildings and renovations is essential. A knowledge of water supplies and civil engineering works would be an advantage.

Foreman (Roads) (Twenty-five Posts) (No 18/72)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants should have practical experience in road construction and maintenance. They must have a working knowledge of the operation, care and running maintenance of road plant and machinery. They should be able to speak and write English and Swahili fluently and must have ability to organize work and control labour. Preference will be given to those who have successfully completed Road Maintenance courses at the Kenya Highways Training Centre.

Senior Darkroom Assistant (One Post), Ministry of Health (No 19/72)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

THIS year's Personnel Officers' Examination Nos 1 and 2, details of which are set out in Personnel Circular No 31 of 10th November, 1966, will be held on Thursday the 20th and Friday the 21st April, 1972, and will be subject to the conditions set out below

2 *Scheme of Examinations*—Each examination will consist of three papers held over two days as follows —

First Day

- (i) Personnel Management (three hours) 9 a m to 12 noon
- (ii) Government Personnel Regulations/Administration (three hours) 1 30 p m to 4 30 p m

Second Day

- (iii) Office Administration—

Examination No 1 (two hours) 9 a m to 11 a m, and
Examination No 2 (three hours) 9 a m to 12 noon

3 *Syllabuses*—The syllabuses of the examinations are given in Part III of the Appendix to Personnel Circular No 31 of 1966. A list of books which candidates are recommended to study as part of their preparation for these examinations was given in the Public Service Commission's Circular Letter No 31/11 of 1st August, 1970. Although the list is not exhaustive, candidates are advised to read as widely as possible.

4 *Eligibility to Enter*—The examination will be open to civil servants who must be Kenya citizens serving with the Government of Kenya, and in the case of —

(a) *Examination No 1*

be serving Clerical, Higher or Senior Clerical Officers serving in Personnel Branches, or in the case of

(b) *Examination No 2*

- (i) Personnel Officers Grade III, or
- (ii) Personnel Officers Grade II (those Graduates who were appointed directly as Personnel Officers Grade II)

Candidates must have passed Examination No 1 or have been exempted before offering themselves for Examination No 2

5 *Entry Fees*—Candidates for examination No 1 will be required to pay an entry fee of K Sh 10 and for No 2 an entry fee of K Sh 20 per candidate. In no circumstances will these fees be refundable.

6 *Entries*—Candidates are required to complete in quadruplicate the Entry Form, set out in the Appendix, copies of which can be reproduced by each Ministry/Department and should be submitted through the Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Departments to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, Gill House, P O Box 30095, Nairobi, to reach him not later than Saturday, 4th March, 1972, and must be accompanied by the remittance covering the appropriate fees. Money/Postal Orders should be crossed and made payable to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya. In no circumstances will late entries be accepted. Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Departments are requested to ensure that entry forms are properly completed in quadruplicate and transmitted to this office in good time.

7 *Conditions of Obtaining a Pass*—In order to obtain a pass in the appropriate full examination, candidate must pass every paper at one and the same sitting. The names of successful candidates will be published in the Kenya Gazette.

8 *Effect of Passing*—Once a candidate has passed one of these examinations, he will be eligible to be considered by the Public Service Commission of Kenya for promotion to the next higher grade as and when vacancies occur, and in accordance with the provisions of the Scheme of Service as set out in Personnel Circular No 31 of 1966.

9 *Examination Centres*—The examinations will be held at Mombasa, Nyeri, Embu, Nairobi, Nakuru, Kakamega, Kisumu and Garissa, and candidates must indicate at which Centre they propose to sit, which will normally be that nearest to their stations. The actual venue in each Provincial Centre will be notified to individual candidates in due course.

10 *Conduct of Examinations*—Candidates will not be permitted to consult any books, files, notes, etc., during the examination, and any infringement of this rule will result in immediate disqualification from the examination, and such disqualification may also result in disciplinary action. Arrangements for the issue of examination papers, invigilation and submission of completed answer scripts will be as laid down by the Examination Officer, Public Service Commission of Kenya.

In all matters related to these examinations, the decision of the Public Service Commission of Kenya will be final.

THE Government Clerical Examination will be held on Wednesday, 26th and Thursday, 27th April, 1972, at Mombasa, Nyeri, Embu, Nairobi, Nakuru, Kakamega, Kisumu and Garissa Centres

2 *Eligibility to Enter*—The examination will be open to civil servants only of the following categories —

- (i) Junior Clerical Officers who have had at least two years' service in that grade at the date of the examination
- (ii) Other civil servants with at least two years' secondary school education, irrespective of their length of service

3 *Scheme of Examination*—The examination will consist of the following subjects which will be set at approximately East African Certificate of Education level —

- (a) English Language (two hours)
- (b) Arithmetic (two hours)
- (c) Government Clerical Procedure (two hours)

4 *Conditions of Obtaining a Pass*—Candidates are required to enter for and pass in all three subjects at one and the same sitting There will be no partial passes

5 *Exemption*—Candidates who have already passed in three or more subjects of the former Higher Clerical Examination, two of which must be the English and Arithmetic papers, or those who have passed the former Civil Service Examination at one

and the same sitting may be exempted from the English Language and/or Arithmetic papers of the Clerical Examination In cases where candidates wish to claim exemption from sitting the English and/or Arithmetic under this Rule, full details of the Examinations passed must be given in the 'Remarks' column of the Entry Form

6 *Effect of Passing*—The passing of this examination will render candidates eligible for promotion to the grade of Clerical Officer, scale £276 to £417 per annum

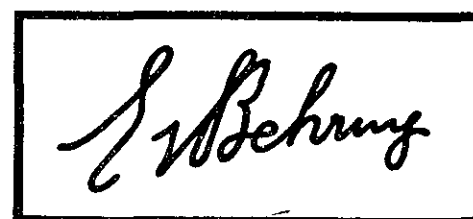

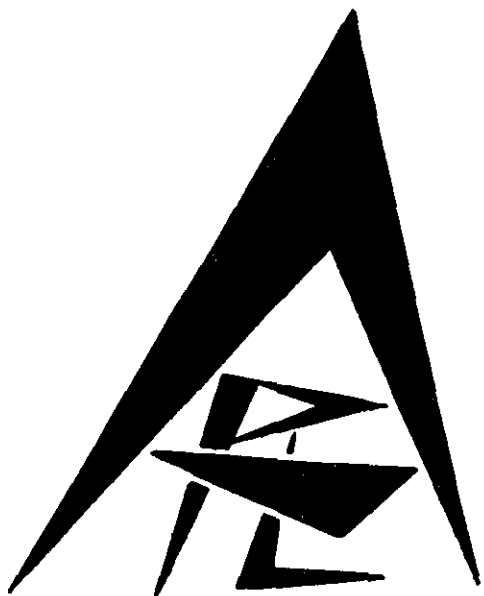
