CAUSE No 37 OF 1972

Parties —

Kenya Timber and Furniture Workers' Union
and

Timber Industries Employers' Association

Issues in dispute —

1 Wages increase

2 Effective date and duration of agreement

1 The Kenya Timber and Furniture Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and the Timber Industries Employers' Association shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents

2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 12th day of January, 1973, and relied on their written and verbal submissions

AWARD

3 The Collective Agreement between the parties which is in the process of being revised was signed on 9th September, 1969, and was effective from 1st April, 1969, for a period of 20 months. Thereafter followed the 12 months' wage standstill under the Tripartite Agreement

The Claimants forwarded to the Respondents their proposals for revising it in August, 1971. Eleven meetings of Joint Negotiating Committee were held starting on 3rd December, 1971, and ending on 26th June, 1972, with deadlock on the two issues in dispute

The dispute was referred to the Ministry of Labour and a conciliator was appointed but the parties failed to resolve the two issues. The parties' respective stands as reported by the conciliator to the Permanent Secretary Ministry of Labour, on 3rd October, 1972, were as follows —

"The Union claimed that they wanted an overall increase of Sh 87/50 to all employees in the urban areas. Their claim was based on rising cost of living in urban areas and they observed that the salaries in the urban section had not been reviewed for a long time. They also observed that the house rents had risen considerably and they felt strongly that a review of salaries was ripe. A comparison was made whereby the rural wages had been considerably reviewed and it was only fair that the urban wages should be accordingly reviewed. Incidentally the Sh 87/50 constituted 29.4 per cent

The employers' association maintained that due to the prevailing economic conditions in the Timber Industry it was only fair that they raise salaries by only 5 per cent mandate given to them by their members. The conciliator adjourned the meeting for another date to give the Association time to seek a fresh mandate from their members. In another meeting held the Association analysed various facts that prompted them to give only 5 per cent. It was observed that the rise of cost of living as at August, 1972, showed the percentage to be in the region of 2.6 per cent to 3 per cent. It was also observed that of late due to lack of business and undercutting by middlemen the Timber Industry was undergoing through difficult period and the situation was forcing some employers to close down. However, the Association had moved from the initial 5 per cent to a new percentage of 6 per cent. The Union efforts of the conciliator to raise and lower percentages both parties were not willing to do otherwise and the conciliator humbly recorded a deadlock on all issues."

The parties signed the Notification of Dispute Form "A" on 18th October, 1972, and the Labour Commissioner issued his certificate on 30th October, 1972

During the hearing the parties elaborated their respective stands as recorded by the conciliator hereinbefore

Briefly the Claimants maintain that since 1965 the wages of the workers in the employment of the Respondents' group had gone up by Sh 32 only in Nairobi and Mombasa and by Sh 30 in other urban centres, whereby during the same period there had been a tremendous rent growth and an increase in travel costs. Moreover, the "Middle Income Index" had gone up from 100 points in July, 1964, to 120.5 in August, 1971. They pointed out that the cost of living indices did not include rent until August, 1971

The Claimants submitted that this clearly proved that the workers had not benefited at all in this industry. They completely rejected the Respondents' contention that wage increases in the past had taken all these factors into account

The Claimants informed the Court that this very group had negotiated a 15 per cent wage increase for workers in the rural section and that they the Claimants had recently negotiated a 25 per cent wage increase for the workers in the Nyanza and Western Province Urban Employers' Group as follows over a three-year period —

1st year	9 per cent increase
2nd year	8 per cent increase
3rd year	8 per cent increase

Under these circumstances the Claimants strongly asked the Court to award the workers a flat increase of Sh 87/50 for the first 15 months effective from 1st January, 1972, and another increase of similar amount for the next 15 months

The Respondents stated that the timber industry was going through a difficult phase due to loss of Uganda and Tanzania markets and although they were making efforts to develop overseas export markets this would take time. Further the debts owed to them in Kampala had not yet been paid

The Respondents while rejecting the Claimants' contention that they had given a 15 per cent increase to the rural section, said that the average increase was about 6.80 per cent as the house allowance of Sh 26 and ration Sh 29.50 had to be added to the basic wages before comparison could be made with the urban section. In any case, they maintained that this was a step in the right direction and was in line with the Government policy on wages to narrow the gap between rural and urban wages

The Respondents totally rejected the Claimants' approach of going back seven years to show the increase granted and the rise in the cost of living and house rents for the same period. They maintained that each wage negotiated had properly assessed and taken into consideration all these factors

The Court notes that the present wage structure which is the subject matter of review in this dispute is as follows —

The Court is rather surprised that despite the fact that the Claimants had forwarded their demands to the Respondents as far back as August, 1971, nearly the whole of 1972 was lost in negotiations and conciliation. It was on 30th October, 1972, that the Labour Commissioner issued his certificate when the matter was referred to the Industrial Court

The Court has carefully gone through the records and submissions and despite the fact that the Claimants had introduced a demand for deconsolidation of housing and travelling allowances, it cannot find that the Claimants unduly dragged their feet and contributed to this extraordinary delay. The Court feels that both parties are responsible for this one year's delay before the matter could be finalized

After a careful consideration of all the submissions the Court awards that the workers should get a wage increase of Sh 30 p m from 1st June, 1972, for the first 15 months, thereafter they should get another wage increase of Sh 15 p m for the next 15 months

The Court further awards that the effective date of the agreement should be 1st June, 1972, and it should remain in force for a period of 30 months from that date

6 Applicants must enclose with their applications cheques for Sh 1,000 as a deposit, which will be dealt with as follows —

- If the applicant is offered and takes up and pays for a plot within a period of 14 days as required in paragraph 5 below, the deposit will be credited to him
- If the application is unsuccessful the applicant's deposit will be returned to him
- If the application is successful and the applicant fails to take up and pay for the plot offered to him within a period of 14 days as requested in paragraph 5 of the General Conditions, the Commissioner of Lands may declare the deposit forfeited and the applicant shall have no further claim thereto

General Conditions

1 The ordinary conditions applicable to township grants of this nature except as varied hereby shall apply to this grant

2 The grant will be made under the provisions of the Government Lands Act (Cap 280 of the Laws of Kenya), and title will be issued under the Registration of Titles Act (Cap 281)

3 The grant will be issued in the name of the allottee as stated in the letter of application

4 The term of the grant will be for 99 years from the 1st day of the month following the notification of the approval of the grant

5 Each allottee of a plot shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands within 14 days of notification that his application has been approved, the initial estimated amount for the construction of roads and drains to serve the plot, the assessed stand premium and proportion of annual rent together with the legal fees payable in respect of the preparation and registration of the grant (Sh 255) and the stamp duty in respect of the grant (approximately 2 per cent of the stand premium and annual rent). In default of payment within the specified time the Commissioner of Lands may cancel the allocation and the applicant shall have no further claim to the grant of the plot

Special Conditions

1 No buildings shall be erected on the land nor shall additions or external alterations be made to any buildings otherwise than in conformity with plans and specifications previously approved in writing by the Commissioner of Lands and the local authority. The Commissioner shall not give his approval unless he is satisfied that the proposals are such as to develop the land adequately and satisfactorily

2 The grantee shall within six months of the commencement of the term submit in triplicate to the local authority and the Commissioner of Lands plans (including block plans showing the positions of the buildings and a system of drainage for the disposal of sewage, surface and sullage water), drawings elevations and specifications of the buildings the grantee proposes to erect on the land and shall within 24 months of the commencement of the term complete the erection of such buildings and the construction of the drainage system in conformity with such plans, drawings, elevations and specifications as amended (if such be the case) by the Commissioner

Provided that if default shall be made in the performance or observance of any of the requirements of this condition it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Lands or any person authorized by him on behalf of the President of the Republic of Kenya to re-enter into and upon the land or any part thereof in the name of the whole and thereupon the term hereby

created shall cease but without prejudice to any right of action or remedy of the President or the Commissioner in respect of any antecedent breach of any condition herein contained

3 The grantee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and condition all buildings at any time erected on the land

4 Should the grantee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that he/she/they is/are unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid the Commissioner of Lands shall (at the grantee's expense) accept a surrender of land comprised herein

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given (1) within 12 months of the commencement of the term the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee 50 per centum of the stand premium paid in respect of the land or (2) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee 25 per centum of the said stand premium. In the event of notice being given after the expiration of the said building period no refund shall be made

5 The land and buildings shall only be used for workshops, garages and godowns

6 The buildings shall not cover more than 90 per centum of the area of the land or such lesser area as may be laid down by the local authority in its bylaws. Accommodation not exceeding 100 sq ft may be provided for a caretaker or night-watchman

7 The land shall not be used for any trade or business which the Commissioner of Lands considers to be dangerous or offensive

8 The grantee shall not subdivide the land without prior written consent of the Commissioner of Lands

9 The grantee shall not sell, transfer, sublet, charge or part with the possession of the land or any part thereof or any building thereon except with the prior consent in writing of the Commissioner of Lands. No application for such consent (except in respect of a loan required for building purposes) will be considered until Special Condition No 2 has been performed

10 The grantee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such sum as the Commissioner may estimate to be the proportionate cost of constructing all roads and drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land and shall on completion of such construction and the ascertainment of the actual proportionate cost either pay (within seven days of demand) or be refunded the amount by which the actual proportionate cost exceeds or falls short of the amount paid as aforesaid

11 The grantee shall from time to time pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such proportion of the cost of maintaining all roads and drains serving or adjoining the land as the Commissioner of Lands may assess

12 Should the Commissioner of Lands at any time require the said roads to be constructed to a higher standard the grantee shall pay to the Commissioner on demand such proportion of the cost of such construction as the Commissioner may assess

Such rental will be at a rate of 4 per cent of the unimproved freehold value of the land as assessed by the Commissioner of Lands

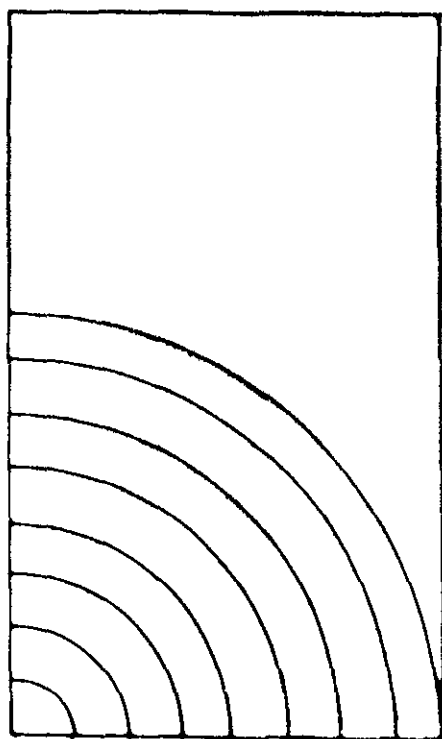

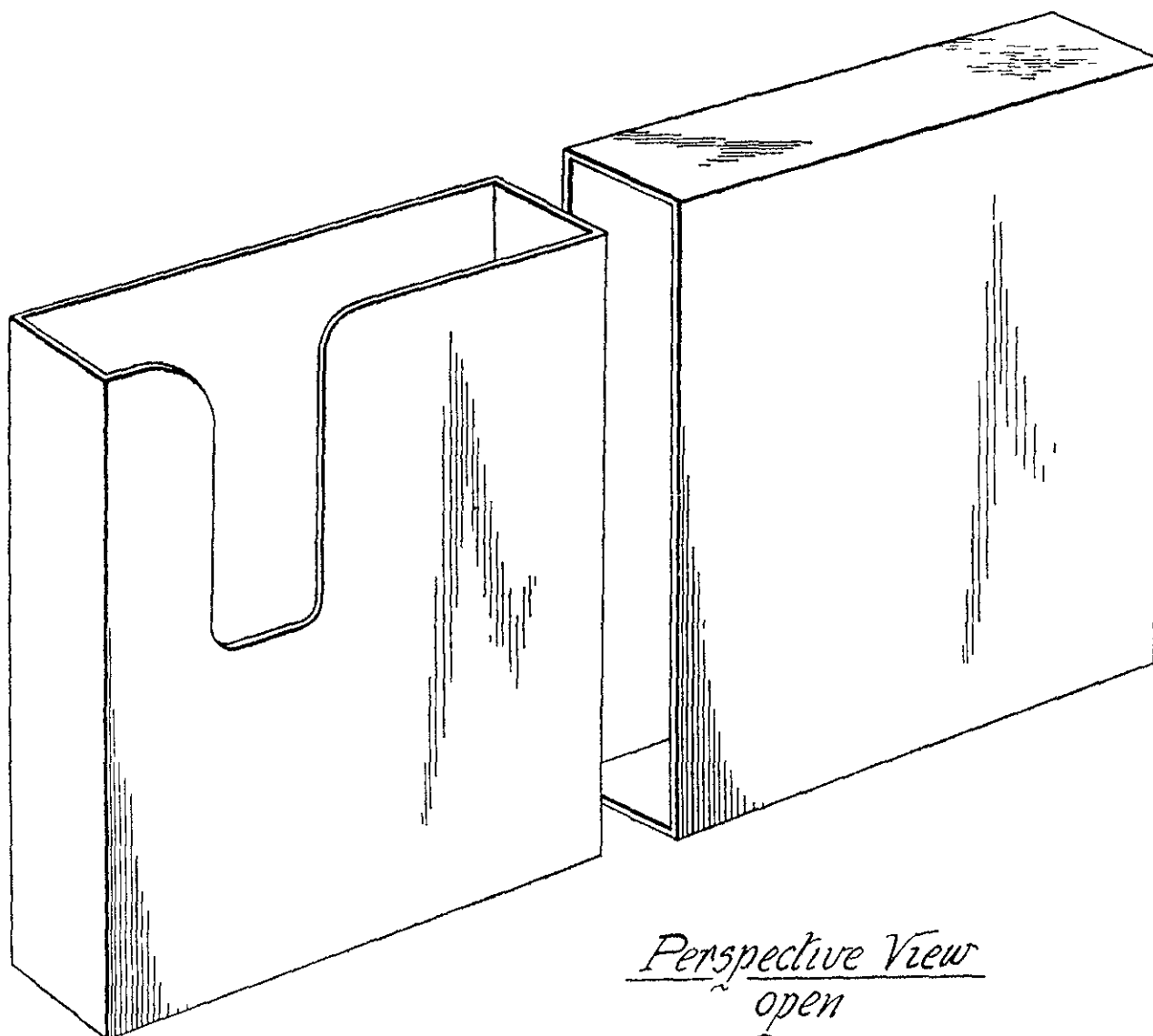

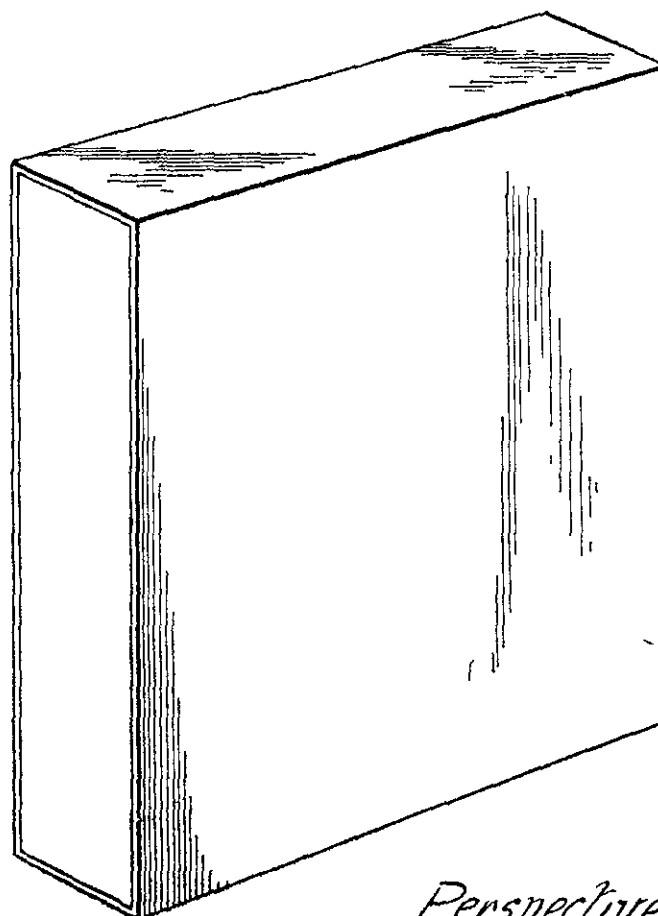
