Applicants must be holding a recognized qualification in Occupational Therapy and in addition have undergone a post graduate course, with a minimum of two years' experience at Occupational Therapist Grade II level or five years' service and must be responsible and keen in teaching and also interested in the academic practical and general welfare of students. Administrative experience will be an advantage

Duties of the post include teaching Occupational Therapy students and supervision of these in areas of practical. Although relevant subjects are preferred, the successful applicant may be expected to teach students in other disciplines as the Principal directs

Laboratory Technologist I (Tutor) (Three Posts) (No 308/73)

Salary scale—£1,212 to £1,614 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants must possess Fellowship or Diploma in Laboratory Technology in either Haematology, Microbiology, Histology technique or Biochemistry with a minimum of two years' service as Laboratory Technologists and must be responsible and keen in teaching and interested in the academic, practical and general welfare of students

Duties include teaching technologists and technicians and supervision of students work on bench. Although relevant subjects are preferred, tutors may be expected to teach the other disciplines as the Principal directs. Preference will be given to Kenya citizens

Occupational Therapist (Tutor) (Two Posts) (No 309/73)

Salary scale—£936 to £1,254 PENSIONABLE

Applicants must hold recognized qualifications in Occupational Therapy and two years of field experience which includes psychiatric experience and must have some administrative experience in a department. They must have interest in the teaching of students and their welfare

Duties will include teaching and supervision in the faculty as well as in the areas of practicals

Radiographer II (Tutor) (One Post) (No 310/73)

Salary scale—£936 to £1,254 PENSIONABLE

Applicants must hold a recognized qualification in Diagnostic Radiography DSR(R) and must have a minimum of two years' practical experience in Diagnostic X ray Department and preferably with interest and ability in teaching students in the faculty of Radiography

Duties include general teaching and supervision of students at practical work

Pharmaceutical Technician (Tutor) (One Post) (No 311/73)

Salary scale—£936 to £1,254 PENSIONABLE

Applicants must be Pharmaceutical Technicians with a minimum of two years of field experience. Teaching and administrative experience will be an advantage. The candidates must be interested in teaching and students' welfare. Duties include the teaching of Pharmaceutical Technicians, organization and supervision of laboratory practical work of students

Senior Certified Clinical Officer (One Post) (No 312/73)

Salary scale—£936 to £1,254 PENSIONABLE

Applicants must be qualified Certified Clinical Officers who have also done post basic course at the Medical Training Centre followed by at least three years of wide field experience. Administrative experience will be an advantage. Duties include teaching and students' clinics, etc

Inspector of Drugs Grade II (One Post) (No 313/73)

Salary scale—£936 to £1,254 PENSIONABLE

Applicants should preferably be civil servants of School Certificate standard of education or its equivalent, with at least five years' Police experience or similar enforcement work. A good knowledge of investigation, collection of evidence and court prosecution procedure is essential, as is ability to learn and apply the Laws of Kenya. A technical knowledge of drugs would be an advantage

The successful candidate will initially be posted to the Ministry Headquarters for a short period of familiarization before being posted to enforce drug laws in a Province within the Republic

*Vacancies in the Ministry of Agriculture**Senior Veterinary Officer (Two Posts) Veterinary Services Division (No 314/73)*

Salary scale—£1,866 to £2,334 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants must possess a BVSc (EA) degree or an equivalent qualification registrable in Kenya, with not less than four years' field experience. They should be conversant with Government procedures, the implementation of the Animal Diseases Act and related legislation, and the diagnosis and control of animal diseases.

Successful candidates will be required to formulate and implement development projects in the Veterinary field including artificial insemination schemes. They must also be able to supervise and direct professional and technical staff engaged in the control of animal diseases.

One of the successful candidates will be posted to North Eastern Province in the first instance but may be posted to other Provinces.

Zoologist (Two Posts), Veterinary Services Division (No 315/73)

Salary scale—£1,212 to £1,614 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants must possess an Honours degree in Zoology and Botany. Post graduate qualification, as proof of ability will be an advantage.

The duties of the post will involve Tsetse Bionomy and diagnosis of trypanosomia and the implementation of control measures. The duties will also include administration and training of staff and will entail long periods of safari under canvas.

Technical Officer Grade III, Central Agricultural Board (Six Posts) (No 316/73)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE

Applicants must be mature persons with good standard of education. They must also have large scale farming experience as well as some knowledge of current agricultural regulations and procedures. A good Diploma from Egerton College is essential.

The duties call for a highly experienced mature officer with ability to control a busy office, supervise staff, attend regular Board and Committee meetings, prepare minutes and take the necessary follow up action.

The successful candidates will be liable for posting anywhere in Kenya to work as Executive Officers to the District Agricultural Committees.

Community Development Officer (One Post), Ministry of Co-operatives and Social Services (No 317/73)

Salary scale—£936 to £1,254 PENSIONABLE

Applicants must possess a degree in Social Sciences from an approved University. Applicants without a degree but have had training in Community Development or Social Work and in addition, have had at least five years' field experience in Community Development work in Kenya will also be considered.

The successful candidate will be posted to one of the Districts in the country to supervise Community Development work.

Executive Officer Grade II (One Post), Ministry of Lands and Settlement (No 318/73)

Salary scale—£936 to £1,254 PENSIONABLE

Applicants must be civil servants, preferably of Cambridge School Certificate standard of education with considerable experience of Government office organization and control, including the supervision of staff. They must have served for not less than one year at the level of Executive Assistant. The successful candidate will be required to serve at the Ministry Headquarters and be in charge of three large registries. He will be responsible for matters related to Accounts, Personnel and Stores. Successful completion of an Executive course either at the Kenya Institute of Administration, Kabete, or the Government Training Institute, Maseno, will be advantageous.

Draughtsman Grade III (One Post), Signals Branch of the Kenya Police, Vice-President's Office and Ministry of Home Affairs (No 319/73)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE

Applicants, preferably of Cambridge School Certificate standard of education, should have a minimum of four years' drawing experience. Experience in diesel/electrical and telephone cable layouts and knowledge of technical library records would be an advantage.

The successful candidate must be able to prepare working technical diagrams, circuit and electronic equipment layouts from rough sketch plans and should also know how to prepare site plans and simple building designs.

Fire Officer Grade III (One Post) Ministry of Power and Communications (No 320/73)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE

Applicants should be of East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent with at least five years' fire-fighting experience, three of which should have been spent in a supervisory capacity. They should have a sound technical and administrative knowledge of Aerodrome Fire Service matters. Possession of a current valid certificate of competence in driving is essential.

The successful candidate will be responsible for the running of shift watches at station level.

Senior Mechanic (Two Posts) Kenya Army, Ministry of Defence (No 321/73)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants must have served a recognized apprenticeship in Motor Vehicle Engineering or furnish proof of having acquired a high standard of training and experience elsewhere. They must possess a Kenya Government Grade I Trade Test Certificate for Vehicle Mechanics. Possession of additional Trade Test certificates will be an advantage. They must also possess a valid driving licence for vehicles up to and including five tons, be conversant with the repair and overhaul of all types of motor vehicles and stationary power plants and be fully capable of running a workshop without supervision. They must have a good knowledge of stores accounting, stock control and ability to compile inspection reports and deal with routine workshop correspondence in English.

*Vacancies in the Voice of Kenya Ministry of Information and Broadcasting**Traffic Supervisor (Television) (One Post) (No 322/73)*

Salary scale—£936 to £1,254 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants should possess a BA degree with a major in English or Linguistics from a recognized University. Alternatively they must have a sound educational background preferably School Certificate, or better, East African Advanced Certificate of Education, with at least three years' experience in television programme and commercial traffic work with a full knowledge of commercial contracts booking, availability and preparation of transmission logs. Duties will include supervision of the Traffic Section in all commercial bookings, transmission logs, and public services promotion work, production of voice overs for commercial and supervision of availability and timing of commercial schedules.

Film Editor (Two Posts) (No 323/73)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants should possess School Certificate or preferably East African Advanced Certificate of Education. They must have at least three years' experience in cinematography, carrying out such duties as filming in 16 mm, negative processing and editing for both news and feature films.

They should have a wide knowledge of current affairs. Duties will include editing news reels, documentaries in both negative and positive films, magnetic and optical sound, single and double system. They should be able to give comprehensive reports on the films, give constructive criticism and advice on filming and processing.

Executive Assistant (Transport) (One Post) (No 324/73)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE

Applicants must have at least five years' experience in a supervisory capacity in the handling of transport, conveying a wide variety of equipment, baggage and furniture. They must also be capable of organizing transport for the collection and delivery of personnel on shift duties. They should be able to submit claims for shortages and losses, maintain and have responsibility for the department of the V.O.K.'s fleet of vehicles. The duties of the post will include the control of funds, stores and expenditure, and the co-ordination and planning of the department's transport.

A good knowledge of oral and written English and Swahili, and possession of a valid driving licence will be essential.

Production Assistant I (Radio) (One Post) (No 325/73)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE

Applicants should be of Cambridge or Higher School Certificate standard of education. Fluency in both oral and written Swahili and English is essential.

They must have performed Programme Assistants Grade II duties, or similar duties in other studios, for at least one year. They must be able to do research, write scripts, do continuity work and interview artists, and work independently without supervision.

They should be sociable and have ability to organize artists. Interest in music or drama will be an asset. They must be prepared to work at odd hours, and on Sundays and Public Holidays.

News Reporter (Two Posts) (No 326/73)

Salary scale—£690 to £972 PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants should possess a Diploma in Journalism from a recognized Institution, with at least one year's experience in reporting of News in the field either for News Agencies or Newspapers, or editing of News for Radio and Television. However, those with a good educational background with a minimum of School Certificate or its equivalent, with at least four years' experience in the fields mentioned above will be considered.

Fluency in both oral and written Swahili and English is essential.

Licence Investigation Assistant (Two Posts) (No 327/73)

Salary scale—£489 to £690 PENSIONABLE

Applicants should possess School Certificate or its equivalent, with at least two years' relevant experience and must be fluent in Swahili and English languages. A knowledge of other vernaculars would be an advantage, and ability to deal tactfully with members of the public is essential. Successful candidates must be prepared to serve anywhere in Kenya and to travel extensively.

(b) East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent with a pass in Division I and II with credits in English Language and Mathematics plus a good pass in one of the following: History, Geography, General Science. Knowledge of the French Language will be an advantage.

Applicants with the qualifications shown in (b) above should should either have—

(i) at least two years' experience either in the Government Service or in the Commercial Field, or

(ii) a Higher School Certificate or its equivalent.

Physical—Applicants must be over the age of 21 years and not older than 25 years of age. Vision and hearing normal without aids, athletic and of good physique. All candidates will be required to pass a Government Medical Examination.

Male candidates—Height of 5 feet 8 inches or over. Chest measurement deflated 32 inches, or over.

Female candidates—Height 5 feet 6 inches or over. The appointment is considered to be suitable only for single females as successful applicants are liable to be posted anywhere in the Republic.

Successful candidates will be posted to the Kenya Police College, Kiganjo, for a period of six months where instructions will be given in all aspects of Police Work. After successful completion of the training and subject to a satisfactory course report, candidates will be posted out to Police Units for duty.

Salary—The salary scales applicable to the post are —

(b) For non-graduates K£690 by £24 to £714 by £30 to £864 by £36 to £972 per annum

Successful candidates will enter the appropriate scale at the lowest point. On first appointment a free issue of uniform is made, and thereafter an allowance of K£50 per annum is payable for up keep.

Acceptance into the Permanent and Pensionable Establishment is subject to the satisfactory completion of a probationary period of two years, and a pass in all subjects in the Police Inspectorate Examination. Subsequently, promotion to the senior ranks of the Force depends upon an officer's personal ability.

2 Applications must be sent to the Commissioner of Lands not later than noon on Friday, 14th September, 1973

3 Applicants must enclose with their applications a sum of Sh 1,000 in cash or send a postal order, money order or banker's order made payable to Commissioner of Lands as deposit. No cheques will be accepted. The deposit will be dealt with as follows —

(a) If the applicant is offered and takes up and pays for the plot within the period of 14 days as required by Condition No 5 below, the deposit will be credited to him

(b) If the application is unsuccessful the applicant's deposit will be returned to him

(c) If the application is successful and the applicant fails to take up and pay for the plot offered to him within a period of 14 days as required by Condition No 5 below, the Commissioner of Lands may declare the deposit forfeited and the applicant shall have no further claim thereto

4 Each application should be accompanied by a statement indicating—

(a) the amount of capital it is proposed to spend on the project,

(b) the amount of actual capital available for development with a banker's letter, or other evidence of financial status in support,

(c) the manner in which it is proposed to raise the balance of the capital required for development, if any,

(d) full details of the proposed trade(s) should be submitted,

(e) whether the applicant runs an established business or whether it is proposed to start a new business or sell/sublet premises

5 The successful allottee of the plot shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands within 14 days of notification that his application has been successful, the stand premium and proportion of the annual rental together with survey, conveyancing, stamp duty and registration fees, contribution in lieu of rates and provision service charges. In default of payment within the specified time the Commissioner of Lands may cancel the allotment and the applicant shall have no claim to the plot.

General Conditions

1 The grant will be made under the provisions of the Government Lands Act (Cap 280 of the Laws of Kenya), and title will be issued under the Registration of Titles Act (Cap 281).

2 The grant will be issued in the name of the allottee as given in the letter of application and will be subject to the Special Conditions set out below.

3 The term of the grant will be for 99 years from the first day of the month following the issue of the letter of allotment.

Special Conditions

1 No buildings shall be erected on the land nor shall additions or external alterations be made to any buildings otherwise than in conformity with plans and specifications previously approved in writing by the Commissioner of Lands and local authority. The Commissioner shall not give his approval unless he is satisfied that the proposals are such as to develop the land adequately and satisfactorily.

2 The grantee shall within six months of the commencement of the term submit in triplicate to the local authority and the Commissioner of Lands, plans (including block plans showing the position of the buildings and a system of drainage for the disposal of sewage, surface and sullage water), drawings, elevations and specifications of the buildings the lessee proposes to erect on the land and shall within 24 months of the commencement of the term complete the erection of such buildings and the construction of the drainage system in conformity with such plans, drawings, elevations and specifications as amended (if such be the case) by the Commissioner.

Provided that notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained or implied by the Government Lands Act, if default shall be made in the performance or observance of any of the requirements of this condition, it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Lands or any person authorized by him on behalf of the President to re-enter into and upon the land or any part thereof in the name of the whole and thereupon the term hereby created shall cease but without prejudice to any right of action or remedy of the President or the Commissioner of Lands in respect of any antecedent breach of any condition herein contained.

3 The grantee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and condition all buildings at any time erected on the land.

4 Should the grantee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that he/she/they is/are unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid, the Commissioner of Lands shall (at the grantee's expense) accept a surrender of the land comprised herein.

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given (1) within 12 months of the commencement of the term, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to grantee 50 per centum of the stand premium paid in respect of the land, or (2) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee 25 per centum of the said stand premium. In the event of notice being given after the expiration of the said building period no refund shall be made.

5 The land and buildings shall only be used for light industrial purposes with ancillary offices and stores.

6 Accommodation not exceeding 100 sq ft may be provided for a caretaker or night watchman.

7 The buildings shall not cover a greater area of the land than that laid down by the local authority in its by-laws.

8 The land shall not be used for the purposes of any trade or business which the Commissioner of Lands considers to be dangerous or offensive.

9 The grantee shall not subdivide the land.

1 The Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and the Twentieth Century Fox Organization (E A) shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents

2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 26th day of June, 1973, and relied on their verbal and written submissions

AWARD

3 The parties had entered into a collective agreement effective from 1st September, 1969, for a duration of two years and although the Claimants forwarded their proposals for revising it on 6th October, 1971, the Respondents refused to start negotiations because of one year's standstill under the Tripartite Agreement. Accordingly the Claimants contacted the Respondents in September, 1972, to commence negotiations

During negotiations the parties reached agreement on all items except four on which the Claimants reported a trade dispute. A conciliator was appointed but conciliation meetings failed to resolve the dispute on the four items and the parties signed the Notification of Dispute Form "A" on 16th March, 1973, which was received by the Court on 8th May with the Labour Commissioner's certificate dated 7th May, 1973

1 Minimum wage

The parties have reached an agreement on three grades and further have also agreed on the minimum wage for grades I and III, they are, however, in disagreement on the minimum wage for grade II which the Claimants propose should be Sh 450 and the Respondents want it to be Sh 425

The Claimants have further raised the question of classification of grades and made submissions on that, but the Court agrees with the Respondents' submission that the classification of grades is not an issue before the Court as otherwise it would have clearly appeared as a separate issue on the Notification of Dispute Form "A"

The Court has carefully considered the submissions on the issue of minimum wage for grade II and awards that it should be Sh 425. The minimum wage for the three grades therefore is —

	Sh
Grade I	300
Grade II	425
Grade III	550

2 Wage increase

The Claimants demand the following wage increase for the various employees in the three grades —

	Per cent
Grade I	20
Grade II	15
Grade III	15

The Respondents have offered a 15 per cent increase for grade I with 10 per cent increase for grades II and III with a duration period of three years from the agreed effective date of 1st September, 1972. The Claimants' demand, however, is based on an 18 month duration period

The Claimants have based their demand on the enormous increase in the cost of living and their efforts to raise the standard of living of their members

The Respondents have pleaded loss of revenue due to the opening of a new cinema in Nairobi and foresee that this trend would continue. They also stressed that their offer taken in conjunction with the adjustments in respect of minimum wages would constitute an average increase of 20 per cent for all employees. This they considered to be fair and reasonable under the circumstances

The Court notes that both parties are agreed that the workers will not benefit twice under issues 1 and 2 but that the workers would be granted the increase which is the better of the two, i.e. under the wage adjustment due to grading and the wage increase. It is also not denied that many workers will get substantial increases as a result of grading and the fixation of minimum wages in respect thereof

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court awards the following wage increase for all employees in the respective grades —

	Per cent
Grade I	15
Grade II	10
Grade III	10

The Court further awards that the employees shall get another wage increase after 18 months as follows —

	Per cent
Grade I	10
Grade II	7
Grade III	7

This award is subject to the parties' own agreement that workers will not get a double benefit as a result of fixation of minimum wage and the demand for a wage increase. The Court, therefore, rules that no worker will get a lower increase than the increase awarded under issue 2 for the first 18 months

3 Annual leave

The Claimants demand the existing annual leave clause to be amended as follows —

- (a) Employees with five years' service—24 consecutive days
- (b) Employees with over five years up to 15 years' service—26 consecutive days
- (c) Employees with over 15 years' service—30 consecutive days

The Respondents submitted that they regarded annual leave of 24 to be reasonable and did not see any reason to change this in view of Ndegwa Commission and Omani Commission reports

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court awards that the existing arrangement should be varied to the extent that employees who have completed more than five years' service should be entitled to 26 consecutive days' annual leave

4 Period of agreement

The Respondents submitted that in view of the increases offered by them a three-year duration period was reasonable and the Claimants demanded an 18 month duration period but they were prepared to accept a longer duration if the workers were granted annual wage increases

The Court notes that the parties have agreed on the effective date to be 1st September, 1972

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court awards the period of agreement to be three years from 1st September, 1972
