3 The term of the grant will be for 99 years from the 1st day of the month following the issue of the letter of allotment

Special Conditions

1 No buildings shall be erected on the land nor shall additions or external alterations be made to any buildings otherwise than in conformity with plans and specifications previously approved in writing by the Commissioner of Lands and the local authority. 
