2 A plan of the plots may be seen at the Public Map Office, situated in the Lands Department Building, City Square, Nairobi, or at the office of the Clerk, Central Rift County Council, or may be obtained from the Public Map Office, P.O. Box 30089, Nairobi, on payment of Sh 3 post free

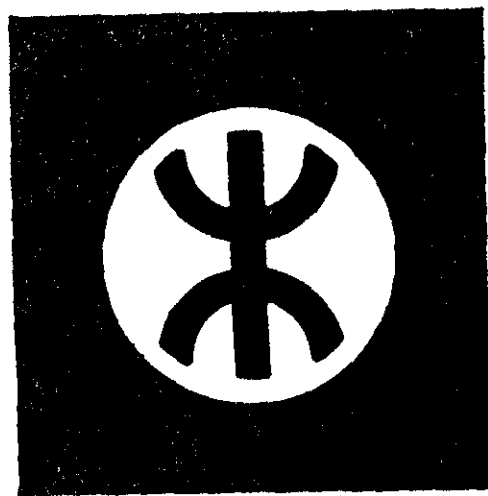

- (b) the washing of motor vehicles or any other kind of vehicle with water flowing from an open tap, pipe or other fitting,
- (c) the washing of utensils, implements or any other thing with water flowing from an open pipe or other fitting

(2) That the Town Clerk be authorized to suspend this Order as and when necessary and that he also be authorized to reimpose the Order on conservation and prohibition of the use of water as and when he considers it necessary

Any person who acts in contravention of by law 451 of the aforesaid by laws shall be liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding one thousand shillings (Sh 1,000)
