### THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

Cause No 56 of 1973

Parties —

Transport and Allied Workers' Union

and

Annal Cropsprayers (EA) Limited

Issue in dispute—Refusal by the management to recognize the Union

- 1 The Transport and Allied Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Airial Cropsprayers (EA) Ltd shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents
- 2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 1st day of February, 1974, and relied on their written and verbal sub missions

### **A**WARD

3 The Notification of Dispute Form 'A" dated 28th September, 1973, with the issue as specified hereinabove and signed by both the parties was received by the Industrial Court on 18th November, 1973, with the statutory certificate from the Labour Commissioner in accordance with section 9 (9) (e) of the Trade Disputes Act

The Claimants had a Recognition Agreement with a firm carrying on business under the name of Airspray (EA) Ltd in Nairobi with which firm they had also entered into a Collective Agreement which was effective from 1st January, 1968, for a period of two years from that date. From the submissions made during the hearing of this dispute it appears that one of the directors of this firm acquired all the shares and decided to carry on the business of aerial spraying from Njoro where he had already a business under the name of Airial Cropsprayers (EA) Ltd

It is not disputed that Airspray (EA) Ltd terminated the services of all their employees and paid them their redundancy benefits, further they offered fresh employment to some of these employees who were prepared to leave and work for them at Njoro

The Claimants maintained that the nature of business activity of both these firms is the same, i.e. aerial spraying on contractual basis for the various farmers in the country. The Respondents, however, stated that while Airspray (EA) Ltd did undertake the work of aerial spraying, they also ran the business of charter hiring aircraft. The Court, however, has taken note of the Respondents' submission whereby it was stated that the director in question had acquired all the shares in Airspray (EA) Ltd because of the competition between that firm and the Respondents

There is also no dispute that the Respondents' employees pilor to 13th February, 1973, were Claimants' members. In fact documentary evidence was produced before the Court showing that a check off system was in operation whereby the Claimants were receiving their dues up to 21st February, 1973.

The Court is satisfied from the documentary evidence that was produced that the Respondents' employees since their resignation from the Claimants' membership had been extremely unhappy in that they were left without any union representation. The Court has taken into consideration the Respondents' submission that all these employees had voluntarily and without any inducement or threat resigned from the Claimants' membership but the force of this submission is considerably reduced from the tenor of the various letters which were forwarded by these employees to the Claimants' General Secretary in April and May, 1973. The fact however remains that the Respondents' employees are now not the Claimants' members although they are extremely anxious that the Claimants should somehow represent them

At one stage prior to this dispute being referred to the Industrial Court the Kenya Plantation and Agricultural Workers' Union was seeking the right to represent the Respondents' employees on the ground that their union was the proper union to represent them This was towards the end of September/October, 1972, and the parties on 10th October, 1972, decided to refer the matter to the Demarcation Committee This Committee, however, did not meet and on 28th June, 1973, the Kenya Plantation and Agricultural Workers' Union decided not to pursue the right to represent the Respondents' employees and asked the Claimants that they should take over their representation. The rivalry between the two unions having been settled, the dispute now concerns simply the Respondents in that whether or not they should recognize the Claimants and grant them the right to represent the Respondents' employees

The Respondents are resisting this demand mainly on the ground that since none of their employees are Claimants' mem bers they should not be granted recognition. The Court is satisfied in view of the historical background leading to this dispute that the Claimants are the proper Union to represent the Respondents' employees and the Court has very carefully considered the Respondents' submission that since at present none of their employees are Claimants' members they should not be asked to recognize them However, after careful consideration of all the facts and submissions, particularly in view of the very serrous allegation that the Claimants had made that the Respondents had forced all their employees to resign from the Claimants' membership under the threat of dismissal, the Court feels that the Claimants' demand for recognition should not be rejected on this ground without further investigation having been made into the matter

The Court awards that the Claimants are entitled to be recognized by the Respondents as a trade union to represent the interest of their unionizable employees provided that a reasonable number of their employees ioin the Claimants' membership within a month of the date of the award. The Court further directs that a Labour Officer from Nakuru should personally carry out an investigation on the spot and interview the various employees with a view to determine whether or not the employees wish to join the Claimants' Union and to be represented by them. If the investigations result in a reasonable number of employees opting for the Claimants then they should join the Claimants within a period of two weeks from the date of the award to enable proper recognition agreement being diawn up in terms of the Court award

### THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

Cause No 58 of 1973

Parties -

Kenya Local Government Workers' Union

and

### Murang'a County Council

Issue in dispute —Council's refusal to pay Elias Kamau Benson his Provident Fund

- 1 The Kenya Local Government Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Murang'a County Council shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents
- 2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 14th day of February, 1974, and relied on their written and verbal submissions

### AWARD

- 3 On 30th November, 1973, the Court received the Notification of Dispute Form "A" with the issue as specified hereinabove along with the statutory certificate from the Labour Commissioner in accordance with section 9 (9) (e) of the Trade Disputes Act
- Mr E Kamau started working for the Respondents on 21st November, 1961, and his services were terminated on 14th December, 1971

The letter of termination read as follows ---

"I am directed to inform you that the Council has decided to terminate your services with effect from 14th December, 1971

Your salary has been calculated up to 13th December, 1971, plus one month's salary in lieu of notice

I am accordingly enclosing your Cheque No 275989 for Sh 861/05 calculated as above "

Mr Kamau was surprised at the termination of his services and wrote to the Respondents inquiring for the reasons which had led to the Respondents terminating his services after ten years of loyal service

On 27th January, 1972, the Respondents' clerk informed Mi Kamau that his services had been terminated in accordance with the agreed principles and that he is given one month's pay in lieu of notice

Subsequently after further exchange of letters necessary documents were prepared in respect of Mr Kamau's Providend Fund claim and gratuity Both sides admit that a gratuity of Sh 99/50 was paid to Mr Kamau in October, 1972, and that although Form PF 4 should have been filled in relation to the Provident Fund Scheme, through an error on the part of the Respondents' Treasurer, Form PF 5 was filled This form was duly signed by the Respondents' Treasurer and Mr Kamau and showed that the balance standing to the contributor's account on 31st December, 1971, was Sh 4,785/25 The reason for closure as given on this form is "terminated by giving one month's salary in lieu of notice", and the relevant section of the Act is quoted as section 14 (c)

The Court was informed that when this form was submitted to the Secretary, Local Authorities Provident Fund, the Board prepared Form PF 5 and submitted it to the Respondents for signature by their Treasurer When Form PF 5 was referred to the Board for further action the Board required the Respondents to state specifically the grounds leading to his termination of service. The Respondents alleged that at this stage an agreement was reached between the Board and themselves that under the circumstances of termination they would enter "inefficiency" as the cause

The second Form PF 5 was not signed by Mr Kamau and the Respondents during the hearing admitted that the original Form PF 5 which technically should have been Form PF 4 did not materially alter the situation

The Court notes that sometime in October, 1969, cash amounting to Sh 63,646/55 was lost from the Respondents' offices At that time Mr Kamau was arrested and detained for a few days but the police dropped the case for lack of adequate evidence. The Respondents have stated in their submission that although the police had dropped the case they were not satisfied by the explanation given by Mr Kamau as to the circumstances under which the aforesaid amount was lost and they therefore decided to terminate his services on 14th December, 1971, by giving him one month's notice

The Court must express its very great surprise at this very unusual way of handling this matter by the Respondents. The Court agrees with the Respondents' spokesman in the Court that the whole case had been handled very carelessly by certain officers on behalf of the Respondents. No reason was given in Court as to why the services of Mr. Kamau, if in fact they were terminated because of the loss of Sh. 63,646/55, were terminated some two years after the event. Further, there is no mention at all of this incident of any other act of misconduct or inefficiency in the letter terminating his services. The Court is left with only one conclusion and that is that Mr. Kamau's services were terminated under normal circumstances and not for any reason of misconduct or inefficiency.

The Court accepts the Claimants' General Secretary's statement in Court that no agreement was reached between the Local Authorities Provident Fund Board of which he, Mr Karebe, is the Chairman, and the Respondents, to the effect that the word 'inefficiency' should be entered as the cause of termination of service on Form PF 5

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court awards that Mr Kamau has not forfeited any part of his balance lying to his ciedit in the Providend Fund account and he should accordingly be paid the sum of Sh 4,785/25 The Court directs the Respondents to take the necessary steps to pay this amount to Mr Kamau without any further delay
