Principal: Kenya Government Secretarial College (One Post) (No. 346/74)

Salary scale.—£1,866 to £2,334. PERMANENT or AGREE-MENT.

Applicants should be professionally trained graduates of a recognized university with not less than two years' teaching experience; or they should be of East African Certificate of Education standard or its equivalent with not less than four years' teaching experience at secondary school level. Preference will be given to candidates with Commercial teaching qualification.

Candidates should be of mature age with a wide experience in the running of a residential institution, preferably for girls.

The successful candidate will be responsible for administration and supervision of a large Kenya Government Secretarial College in Nairobi or Mombasa, and organize courses of instruction for the secretarial staff in conjunction with the Director of Personnel Management.

Kenya Institute of Administration:

Senior Lecturer (One Post) (No. 347/74)

Salary scale.—£1,866 to £2,334. PERMANENT or AGREE-MENT.

Applicants should hold a degree of an approved university and should have some training in linguistics plus substantial experience in teaching English and Kiswahili at an advanced level. They should also be familiar with modern teaching collection of common errors made in English by adult students, the writing up of remedial exercises and also the teaching of a wide range of English and Kiswahili language skills to students who mainly work in the Civil Service. It will be a great advantage to the applicant if he has had experience in the use and the preparation of materials for a language laboratory in both English and Kiswahili.

Government Press:

Printer Grade I (Linotype Operator) (Two Posts) (No. 348/74)

Salary scale.—£714 to £1,008. PERMANENT or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should have served recognized apprenticeship as Compositors and Linotype/Intertype Operators or have received equivalent training for five years. Those without the East African Certificate of Education should in addition have served for two extra years after qualification.

Candidates who have experience in Operating T.T.S. or photosetting keyboards will be considered for one of the posts if they are familiar with the Fairchild Multiface Perforator Keyboard.

The duties of the posts include operation of Linotype and Intertype linecasting machines for straight and tabular setting at an average speed of not less than 6,000 ens per hour, and, maintenance of the machines in working order.

T.T.S. Keyboard operators are expected to set at an average speed of not less than 8,000 ens per hour for straight setting and 600 ens per hour for tabular work.

Senior Agricultural Officer (Cotton Research) (One Post) (No. 349/74)

Salary scale.—£1,866 to £2,334. PERMANENT or AGREE-MENT.

Applicants must possess a degree in Agriculture or related science from a recognized university. They must also have post-graduate qualification preferably in plant breeding or agronomy. Applicants should be conversant with the problems of cotton research and production. They should also have some experience in the administration of a research station.

The successful candidate will be required to take over the technical direction of the cotton research station, Tebere and its substations.

Executive Officer II (Two Posts) (No. 350/74)

Salary scale.—£972 to £1,302. PERMANENT or AGREE-MENT.

Applicants must be civil servants of School Certificate standard of education with considerable Government experience and must have served as Executive Assistants for at least two years. They must have practical experience of Government regulations, office organization and Government accounting procedure. Ability to control staff and conduct correspondence is essential. Preference will be given to applicants who have successfully completed an executive course either at the K.I.A. or at the Government Training Institute, Maseno. The successful candidates must be prepared to serve in any part of the country.

They must have working knowledge of Government objectives and methods, curriculum development and current trends of teaching in adult education.

They must have adequate knowledge of Government regulations, financial orders and budgetary procedures. Preference will be given to qualified applicants with experience in administration of a senior residential training institution.

The Vice-Principal is responsible to the Principal of the College for planning, programming and guiding the training programmes at the college with a capacity of 200 students and about 20 academic staff and will be required to assist the Principal in the administration and discipline of the college. He will deputise for the Principal as required from time to time. Ability to get along well with colleagues is essential for success in this post.

Assistant Housekeeper (One Post) (No. 352/74)

Applicants should be of East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent plus a wide knowledge and experience in house hold management. They must be in possession of Diploma or Certificate in Institutional Catering and House-keeping from a recognized institution. The applicants must possess a high sense of responsibility, experience, personality and interest in looking after students and very important personnel (V.I.P.). The successful candidate who should be a mature woman will be expected to supervise staff working in the kitchen, dining hall and hostels and be prepared to reside in the college campus.

Applicants should have a minimum educational standard of Cambridge School Certificate or its equivalent with at least three years' suitable experience since leaving school. Duties entail the enforcement of Labour Laws, inspection of places of employment, industrial relations work, settlement of disputes and prosecutions.

Applicants must have a minimum qualification of a good pass in the East African Certificate of Education. Candidates with especially good marks in Mathematic and English are required. A general understanding of the various stages involved in a building construction project i.e. planning, design, tendering and construction would be a definite asset, although not essential.

The Building Development Programmer will be directly responsible to a Building Development Officer (BDO) for the collection, summarization and dissemination of accurate and up-to-date information on the planning, design, construction and financial status of building development jobs on the Ministry of Works Annual Works Programme. They will assist the Building Development Officers to prepare special reports and analyses for top management within Ministry of Works and the Client Ministries.

Candidates must possess the Certificate of Primary Education or its equivalent. They must possess the Proficiency Certificate (final level) of an approved apprenticeship.

Candidates with Grade I National Trade Test Certificates should have at least two years' practical experience as either Pipe Fitter or Plumber, preferably both. They should be able to gas or arc weld simple constructions such as pipe supports and anchors.

Applicants must be able to read and write in English to the extent of being able to understand instruction manuals, specifications and spare parts books. They should be able to read technical drawings, make simple sketches and prepare estimates of alterations and new works.


