ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICERS' EXAMINATION, 1977

IT IS notified for general information that this year's Administrative Officers' Examination will be held on Wednesday, 17th, Thursday, 18th and Friday, 19th August, 1977, in accordance with the provisions of Personnel Circular No. 6 of 4th April, 1970.

SCHEME OF THE EXAMINATION

2. The examination will consist of the following six test papers, held over three days as follows:—

First Day-Wednesday, 17th August, 1977

- (i) Law (Parts I and II) (3 hours), 9 a.m. to 12 noon.
- (ii) Government Organization and Practice (3 hours), 1.45 p.m. to 4.45 p.m.

Second Day-Thursday, 18th August, 1977

- (iii) Civil Service Regulations (3 hours), 9 a.m. to 12 noon.
- (iv) Public Financial Management and Control (formerly Financial Control and Procedures) (3 hours), 1.45 p.m. to 4.45 p.m.

Third Day-Friday, 19th August, 1977

- (v) General Knowledge of East African and World Affairs (3 hours), 9 a.m. to 12 noon.
- (vi) Applied Logic and Report Writing (3 hours), 1.45 p.m. to 4.45 p.m.

SYLLABUSES

3. There is no change to the syullabuses given in Appendix "B" to the Personnel Circular No. 6 of 1970, apart from increasing the time allowed for each test paper—as indicated in paragraph (2) above.

ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

4. The examination will be open to Administrative Officers serving with the Kenya Government, either as Administrative Officers in the Provincial Administration (as defined in Appendix to the Personnel Circular No. 6 dated 7th June, 1974—the New Scheme of Service for Administrative Officers—Provincial Administration), Asistant Secretaries in the Ministries, or Second/Third Secretaries in the Foreign Service.

EXEMPTIONS

- 5. (a) Candidates who attempted this examination previously and passed in one or more subjects have been credited with those subjects passed. They will (this year and perhaps in future) have to re-sit only those subjects in which they failed in order to achieve a full pass in this examination, i.e. when they have passed in all the six subjects, including any exemptions.
- (b) Serving officers with legal qualifications, from accredited universities may, on application to the Registrar, High Court of Kenya, be exempted from sitting for Part I of the Law Paper. Similarly, Law Graduates from the East African Universities, including serving officers who have obtained a pass in the Police Law Examination "B", can, on application, be exempted from the entire Law Paper of this Examination. All applications for exemption under this provision should be made through the candidates' Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Departments to the Registrar, High Court of Kenya, giving details of the legal qualifications held, and enclosing thereto photostat copies of the relevant documents to support their claims. Exempted candidates must quote reference numbers of their letters of exemption when they submit their entry forms for registration.

REGISTRATION FEES

6. Each candidate will be required to pay a Registration Fee of K.Sh. 20 only, regardless the number of subjects to be attempted. The fees should be paid in either Crossed E.A. Money Orders, E.A. Postal Orders, or cash. Personal cheques

will not be accepted. The Money Orders, etc., should be made payable to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, Nairobi, and should be attached to the appropriate Entry Form. The fees will not be refundable in any event.

EXAMINATION ENTRY FORMS

7. Candidates are required to complete the Entry Form in TRIPLICATE, as set out at the "Apendix" to this Circular Letter. The forms should be reproduced and cyclostyled by each Ministry/Department as necessary, as no supplies will be obtainable from this office. The completed entry forms, accompanied by the correct Registration Fees, should be submitted through the Permanent Secretary, Office of the President, Harambee House, Nairobi, to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, so as to reach him not later than Wednesday, 22nd June, 1977. Under no circumstances will late entries be accepted.

The Permanent Secretary, Office of the President, is requested to ensure that all entry forms are properly filled in, are from eligible officers only, in accordance with paragraph (4) above, are certified correct by him at Part "C" as required, and are transmitted to this office by the closing date. This will save us a great deal of time, usually wasted in returning the entry forms to him for corrections or endorsement.

EXAMINATION CENTRES

8. All Provincial Headquarters in Mombasa, Nyeri, Embu, Nairobi, Nakuru, Kakamega, Kisumu and Garissa will be the Centres for this Examination. Centres outside Kenya may be established for those intending and eligible candidates in the Foreign Service.

EXAMINATION TEST PAPERS AND STATIONERY

- 9. (i) Arrangements for the issue of Examination Test Papers and stationery, appointment of invigilators, arrangements for examination venues and submission to this office of candidates' answer scripts in respect of each Provincial Centre, will be made by the Provincial Education Officer in charge of the Centre, acting on behalf, and on the directions of the Public Service Commission of Kenya. No special stationery other than the ordinary writing foolscap to be supplied by this office, will be required for this examination. All candidates will, however, bring with them their own rulers, pens and ink.
- (ii) Law Books.—Candidates may also bring their own Law Text-books to be referred to during Part II of the Law Paper, if they are sitting for the Law Paper. The Provincial Education Officers are, however, requested to ensure that the relevant Law Books (Volumes of the Laws of Kenya, the Constitution of Kenya, etc.) are available at their Centres for the use of the candidates during Part II of the Law Paper. The books should not be used at all in answering Part I of the Law Paper.
- (iii) Answer Blue Covers.—It has been decided that from now on, candidates for all Government Examinations conducted by the Public Service Commission of Kenya, will not be allowed to write their names or their Ministries/Departments on the Answer Blue Covers, as has been the practice in the past. It will be necessary, however, for each candidate to write clearly the following—
 - (a) Name of the Examination;
 - (b) Subject's Title;
 - (c) His/Her Examination Index No. and
 - (d) His/Her Examination Centre,

as asked for on the Answer Blue Cover provided for each paper.

- 4. 28 days leave due
- 5. Sh. 50 leave travelling allowance."

"I, Joshua Wambua Mangao No. 161 of D. T. Dobie & Co. (K) Ltd. acknowledge receipt of the sum of Sh. 4,520 in full and final settlement and discharge of all sums due to me, and also certify that I have no further claims whatsoever against this company."

The matter was discussed at a local negotiating committee meeting held on 31st May, 1976 under the chairmanship of Mr. W. J. Argent and between Messrs. Onyango, Orawo and Oduor (all shopstewards) and Mr. Kariuki, the Personnel Manager. At this meeting the termination of services of Mr. Wambua was discussed; minutes of this meeting were produced as an appendix to the Respondents' submission. More than once it is stated in these minutes that the shopstewards had not received any complaints about Mr. Wambua regarding his termination and in fact there had been no contact between Mr. Wambua and them. In these minutes there is no record of any deadlock having been declared regarding the termination of Mr. Wambua and the minutes concluded with the words—

"In these circumstances, the Personnel Officer told Mr. Wambua that he would be better to terminate his employment with the company and accept his full dues. Wambua not only accepted this decision but refrained from making any complaint to the Management or to the shopstewards and also asked if he could have a Certificate of Employment, all of which was duly prepared and given to him the following day."

The Claimants at their national level pursued the matter and it was discussed at a Joint Industrial Council meeting where a deadlock was recorded on it.

The case was eventually investigated by an official of the Ministry of Labour and the Investigator's findings and recommendation were as follows—

"In this case the Management's submission is as balanced as it is truthful.

Mr. Wambua was arrested by the police on 11th January, 1976 along with others and charged for theft of a Mercedes Benz 230 No. KQK 217. He was placed in custody and released on 20th January, 1976. On reporting to the company he was dismissed for absenteeism. Having regard to the long period Mr. Wambua had served the company, the Management accepted the shopsteward's request to reinstate him. This in itself was a very good gesture on the part of the Management for which they should be commended.

Some key blanks and a note book in which some registration car numbers were recorded were found in Mr. Wambua's office drawer while he was away. When he was informed of the fact that these were handed over to the police, he elected to have his services terminated. He was afraid that he would be rearrested and might lose his benefits. In the event, he chose to be paid his benefits after voluntarily opting for termination. He was paid his benefits through a cheque on 13th February, 1976. The Union requested the Managing Director to have the cheque open to enable Mr. Wambua to cash it easily and this was done.

I accept the version that Mr. Wambua voluntarily opted to be terminated for the reason already stated. Equally, it is clear that the Union was in the picture. The ciaim by the Union that Wambua was desperate for money to pay his children's school fees and meet other needs is far-fetched and at best, an afterthought. In the nature of things, the Management's explanation must be the only plausible one.

Conclusion

After carefully considering all the evidence in this case, I conclude that Mr. Wambua consented to the termination and made no immediate complaint against the action and all this was within the knowledge of the Union and the question of wrongful dismissal does not arise."

During the hearing the Claimants made a strong submission that the Respondents had terminated Mr. Wambua's services without any justifiable cause in that either Mr. Wambua should have been summarily dismissed for gross misconduct or he should have been terminated under the warning clause. Since the Respondents had not pleaded either of the two the Claimants felt that the Court had no alternative but to reinstate Mr. Wambua without any loss of privileges.

The Respondents on the other hand stated that this was a case of mutual agreement to terminate the employment between Mr. Wambua and themselves. Further no complaints had been made at the shop floor level and it was unfortunate that a termination on which there had been no dispute should have found its way to the Industrial Court.

The background to the dispute is that Mr. Wambua along with four other persons was picked up by the police in connection with the loss of a Mercedes car KQK 217 on 11th January, 1976. All five of them were charged in a criminal court but the case against three of them including Mr. Wambua was withdrawn by the State under section 87 (a) of the C.P.C. In the meantinme the Respondents had terminated his services on 20th January on the ground that he had absented himself and had not reported on duty for the last nine consecutive days.

On 9th February, 1976, however, the Respondents reinstated him but four days later the aforesaid letter of termination was issued to him on 13th February, 1976.

In these circumstances the Court has to decide whether the Respondents' version regarding his termination is true or whether the Claimants' contention that his services had been terminated without any justifiable cause is true.

There are two important points which merit attention in this dispute. They are firstly that while Mr. Wambua was absent because of the criminal case some key blanks and a note-book in which some registration car numbers were recorded were found in his office drawer. The entries were made in Mr. Wambua's handwriting and both items were handed to police. Mr. Wambua was not required in the course of his job to have or keep the information contained in the note-book. When Mr. Wambua was reinstated he was told about this and when he came to know that the documents and the key blanks were in possession of the police he appeared greatly disturbed. Secondly Mr. Wambua who is an educated person with 16 years' service with the Respondents signed the aforesaid document on the date of the termination of his service wherein he acknowledged receipt of the sum of Sh. 4,520 in full and final settlement and discharge of all sums due to him and has certified that he has no further claims whatsoever against the Respondents.

On top of that Mr. Wambua applied for and was given a certificate of employment by the Respondents dated 14th February, 1976.

In the aforesaid circumstances the Court does not find the Claimants' submission to be logical when they state that Mr. Wambua had received Sh. 4,520 because his children were starving and that it had been agreed between them and the Respondent's Managing Director that this amount was being given to him without prejudice to his other claims. The receipt signed by Mr. Wambua is quite clear and it is not stated anywhere that the amount he received was a part payment or that it was "without prejudice" to his other claims.

The Court is satisfied that Mr. Wambua anticipating further trouble after he was told that some key blanks and a note-book as stated above were found in his drawer decided to get his services terminated so that he would be paid his terminal benefits. As a matter of fact Mr. Wambua was paid Sh. 5,050 less deductions leaving a balance of Sh. 4,520 for which he had signed the aforesaid receipt in full and final settlement.

In the absence of any evidence to the contrary the Court has no alternative but to find that Mr. Wambua had agreed mutually with the Respondents for the termination of his services and the Claimants' demands on his behalf are an afterthought and as such without any merit.

The Court accordingly rejects the Claimants' demand.
