THE TRADE DISPUTES ACT

(Cap. 234)

ORDER UNDER SECTION 36—COLLECTION OF
TRADE UNION DUES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Trade Disputes Act, the Minister for Labour hereby orders every employer who employs not less than five members of the Kenya Timber and Furniture Workers Union to—

(a) deduct every month—

- (i) the sum of four shillings from the wages of employees earning up to two hundred and forty-nine shillings per month;
- (ii) the sum of six shillings from the wages of employees earning between two hundred and fifty shillings and three hundred and forty-nine shillings per month;
- (iii) the sum of eight shillings from the wages of employees earning between three hundred and fifty shillings and four hundred and forty-nine shillings per month;
- (iv) the sum of ten shillings from the wages of employees earning between four hundred and fifty shillings and six hundred and forty-nine shillings per month;
- (v) the sum of twelve shillings from the wages of employees earning between six hundred and fifty shillings and eight hundred and forty-nine shillings per month;
- (vi) the sum of fourteen shillings from the wages of employees earning between eight hundred and fifty shillings and one thousand and forty-nine shillings per month;
- (vii) the sum of sixteen shillings from the wages of employees earning between one thousand and fifty shillings and one thousand four hundred and ninety-nine shillings per month;
- (viii) the sum of eighteen shillings from the wages of employees earning between one thousand and five hundred shillings and one thousand nine hundred and ninety-nine shillings per month;
- (ix) the sum of twenty shillings from the wages of employees earning two thousand shillings and over per month; in respect of Trade Union Dues by each of his employees who is a member of that union.

- (b) pay eighty-five per cent of the total sums so deducted in any month, not later than the tenth day of the following month, by a crossed cheque made payable into the account of the Kenya Timber and Furniture Workers' Union at the Standard Bank, Government Road, P.O. Box 72585, Nairobi;
- (c) pay fifteen per cent of the total sums so collected in any month, not later than the tenth day of the following month, by a crossed cheque made payable into the account of the Central Organization of Trade Unions (Kenya) Account No. 140793-7 at the Barclays Bank International Limited, P.O. Box 30120, Nairobi.
- (d) notify in writing that trade union and that organization before the end of each month of the total amount of any payments made into the account of that trade union and that organization in that month;
- (e) notify in writing the Registrar of Trade Unions before the end of each month the total amount of any payments made into the accounts of that trade union and of that organization in that month.

Issue in dispute.—Dismissal of John Deya.

1. The Amalgamated Union of Kenya Metal Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and D. T. Dobie (K) Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on 26th April and 11th and 31st May, 1977, and in addition to relying on their written and verbal submissions called the following witnesses to give evidence on oath:—

Claimants.—Mr. J. Deya.

Respondents.—Messrs. C. Sissey and N. Naitera.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 26th November, 1976, duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 24th January, 1977, along with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

Mr. J. Deya was a grade 7 mechanic working for the Respondents until 12th January, 1976, when his services were terminated summarily for stealing four spark plugs and four brake pads. The Respondents stated that they value good mechanics and therefore although Mr. Deya was uneducated in that he was not able to read or write he had been promoted to grade 7 because he was a good mechanic.

On 12th January, Mr. Deya signed a statement in which he is alleged to have admitted to have stolen the aforesaid spare parts and that he was found with them on his person by the security officer. This statement is witnessed by two persons, Messrs. D. Naitera and G. K. Nobala.

Mr. Deya was in due course charged with the offence of stealing by servant but on 11th May, 1976, he was acquitted by the Magistrate who stated as follows:—

"In this case both chief security officer and gate askari, P.W.1 and P.W.2 testified how they stopped and at the gate searched him and found spares in issue. P.W.3 and P.W.4 Assistant Personnel Manager and Personnel Manager alleged that the accused confessed to them that he admitted the theft. With respect original of the confession was not produced in court although it is alleged it was given to the police. Furthermore confession by accused can only be done before a police officer above of or above Inspector of Police or before a Magistrate. In this case the written confession was done by the Personnel Manager and his assistant. That confession was wrong in law and carry no weight under the Evidence Act. A photostat copy identified in court was not produced as exhibit. In view of this its contents cannot be considered. Accd. cast doubt on such case that he bought spares on 7th January, 1976, Ex. 1. Exhibit 1 read the spares were bought from Mwireri Auto Spares, P.O. Box 72217, Nairobi. Thereafter is dated 7th January, 1976, 5 days earlier than the date of alleged theft. In view of this, accused has cast doubt in Prosecution case and the benefit of doubt goes to the accused. This being the case I dismiss the charge against the accused and find him not guilty and acquit him of the charge. Cash bail of Sh. 500 to be refunded to the accused."

Once Mr. Deya was acquitted in the criminal court the Claimants took up the matter on his behalf and pressed for his unconditional reinstatement and payment of all salary from the date of his dismissal up to the date of his reinstatement. The Respondents rejected the demand and the matter was the subject matter of investigation by the Ministry of Labour. The Ministry's findings as conveyed to the parties on 19th November, 1976, were as follows:—

"Findings

The management have made their submission in a forthright and forceful manner and I see no reason to disbelieve them. It is evident that Mr. Deya and another co-worker were intercepted leaving the company's gate shortly after 2 p.m. and this was a little while after their return from lunch. This factor aroused suspicion and a watchman was instructed to stop and search the two employees. Mr. Deya was caught red-handed and admitted the offence of stealing. He pleaded for pardon which was denied on account of the gravity of the offence. Although Mr. Deya was acquitted by a court of law, the management had earlier taken the administrative action to dismiss him. There are legal technicalities which in several cases have made courts acquit persons who otherwise in the eyes of laymen are clearly guilty. Such an action by the court would not hinder the management from acting administratively and discretionally. The claim that Mr. Deya bought the items has not been proved either by Mr. Deya or the union.

Conclusion

In view of all the above facts I consider that the action taken by the management was justified."

The Claimants rejected the recommendations and the dispute is now before the Court.

The Claimants in their very brief written submission have argued that because the Magistrate in the criminal court had acquitted Mr. Deya of the alleged offence the Respondents had no option but to reinstate him unconditionally. The Claimants stated that the Respondents should have appealed to a higher court of appeal if they were not satisfied with the Magistrate's decision.

The Claimants further explained that Mr. Deya had bought these spare parts, which were found on his person, on 7th January, 1976, from Mwireri Auto Spares, P.O. Box 72217, Nairobi, and that on 12th January, 1976, he had taken the spare parts to his place of work because he was to meet his

friend outside the work place after which he was going to repair his car.

At the Claimants' request the Court asked for this receipt which was an exhibit in the criminal case to be produced before the Court for examination.

The Claimants further stressed that the so-called confession by Mr. Deya was obtained under threats and that in any case he was told that what he was signing was a statement by him that the spares belonged to him and that he had a receipt in respect of them when he purchased them from a certain shop in River Road.

The Respondents on the other hand strongly maintain that they were absolutely satisfied on the evidence of their witnesses that Mr. Deya had stolen these new spare parts from their workshop on 12th January, 1976, and that when he was about to leave the gate of the workshop soon after 2 p.m., he was detained by the watchman on duty, Charles Sissey, who on searching him had found these spare parts on his person. Mr. Deya had subsequently pleaded with him for forgiveness but the watchman refused to do so and the matter was handed over to the Personnel Manager. Mr. Deya again pleaded with the Personnel Manager and begged for forgiveness. In the Personnel Manager's office he produced another plug from his pocket and gave it to Mr. Naitera. After this his statement was recorded and read back to him and which he then signed in the presence of witnesses.

The Respondents emphasized that if at any time Mr. Deya had indicated to them on 12th January, 1976, that he had bought these spares from another firm in River Road and that he had a receipt in respect of such a sale then they would have made further inquiries instead of terminating his services summarily. They maintained that the fact of the matter is that Mr. Deya did not have any such receipt in his possession and that the said receipt was a fake which was produced to get Mr. Deya's acquittal in the criminal case. The Respondents added that they had made their inquiries about this firm but could not trace it either through the Registrar of Business Names or through their inquiries in the area where it is alleged to be carrying on business. In fact they stated that the P.O. Box 72217, Nairobi, belonged to someone different and not to the so-called Mwireri Auto Spares.

The Court had the benefit of Mr. Deya's evidence on oath and also of the Respondents' two witnesses who had found the spares on Mr. Deya's person on 12th January, 1976.

The Court cannot find any satisfactory explanation given by Mr. Deya as to why if he had bought these spares on 7th January, 1976, from the said firm of Mwireri Auto Spares he had to carry them to his place of work on 12th January, 1976, and which he was trying to take out from the workshop gate soon after 2 p.m. to meet a friend of his whose car he stated he had undertaken to repair on a friendly basis. Any reasonable person if he was going to help repair his friend's car with spares which he had purchased from another person besides his employer would not run the risk of taking such spares to his place of work. Mr. Deya's statement on this point leaves a lot to be desired particularly in view of the fact that there seems to be instructions given to the Respondents' employees that when they report for duty they have to declare all their personal property at the gate in order to avoid any trouble later on. Even if there were no such standing instructions any prudent person if he was carrying spares on his person when he reported on duty would surely take the necessary precaution of declaring the articles in his possession before resuming duty.

The Court has in the past pointed out that unlike criminal proceedings where the guilt of the accused has got to be proved beyond any reasonable doubt the Industrial Court has to come to a decision on a balance of probabilities. In criminal cases persons get acquittals on technical grounds and Mr. Deya no doubt got the benefit of that.

The Court has decided not to place any reliance on the so-called written statement of Mr. Deya's admission of guilt in coming to its finding. The Court, however, accepts the evidence of the Respondents' witnesses of the circumstances under which the aforesaid spare parts were found on the person of Mr. Deya and that Mr. Deya had asked and pleaded for forgiveness as against Mr. Deya's statement that he had told them that he had bought the spares and had got the receipt with him. The Court has grave reservations about the receipt which was produced as an exhibit in the criminal court and even if the Court was to give Mr. Deya the benefit of this receipt the fact would still remain that Mr. Deya had committed a misconduct in taking his own personal spares to his place of work without declaring them as per the standing instructions.

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court finds that Mr. Deya had committed a gross misconduct in that he was found with new spare parts on his person on 12th January, 1976, soon after 2 p.m. and he failed to offer a reasonable explanation as to how he had acquired them in that he did not at the time make any reference of these spares having been purchased by him from a firm in River Road or that he had a receipt for them. The Court is satisfied that Mr. Deya deserved a summary termination and the Claimants' demand is accordingly rejected.
