PROFICIENCY EXAMINATION FOR CLERICAL OFFICERS
1977

YOUR attention is invited to the Personnel Circular No. 10 dated 5th December, 1973, in which the syllabus for the above-mentioned Examination was published.

2. In this connexion, it is notified for general information that this year's Proficiency Examination for Clerical Officers (only) will be held on Thursday, 15th and Friday, 16th December, 1977.

3. SCHEME OF THE EXAMINATION

The Examination will consist of the following eleven subjects, seven (7) of which will be taken by all candidates and the remaining four (4) will be Optional Subjects from which each candidate will be required to choose only one of them related to his/her normal official duties, making a total of eight (8) subjects to be taken by each candidate:—

Paper I.—General Paper.

(This paper will comprise of four separate papers)

- (a) English Language (1 hour).
- (b) Organization and Functions of Government (40 minutes).
- (c) Current Affairs (40 minutes).
- (d) Elementary Economics (40 minutes).

Paper II.—Civil Service Regulations (2 hours).

Paper III.—Clerical Procedures (2½ hours).

Part I.—Compulsory for all candidates.

- (a) Office Practice (½ hour).
- (b) Business Calculations (½ hour).

Part II (Optional).—Any one subject only related to officers's duties.

- (a) Accounts (1½ hours) or
- (b) Stores (1½ hours) or
- (c) Personnel (1½ hours) or
- (d) General Office Services (1½ hours).

4. ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

The Examination will be open to Civil Servants only, who are serving as Clerical, Higher Clerical or Senior Clerical Officers, and who have completed at least four (4) years continuous service in the cadre. However, Clerical Officers who were appointed at a starting salary of K£435 per annum and above by virtue of their educational qualification or approved experience may enter the Examination after completion of two years' service. Junior Clerical Officers, Copy Typists, etc., are not eligible to enter the Proficiency Examination for Clerical Officers.

5. CONDITIONS FOR OBTAINING A PASS

Every candidate will be required to enter for and pass in all the three main papers (see paragraph 3 above) at one and the same sitting. No partial passes will be allowed.

6. EXAMINATION REGISTRATION FEES

Every candidate entering this Examination will be required to pay a Registration Fee of K.Sh. 10 only for the whole examination. The Registration fee which will be non-refundable, will be payable to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, in either crossed Inland Money Order, Postal Order or cash. Personal cheques will not be accepted.

7. ENTRY FORMS

Candidates must complete and submit the examination entry forms in triplicate as set out at "Appendix" to this Circular Letter, copies of which can be reproduced and cyclostyled by each Ministry/Department, as required, and the completed entry forms, duly certified correct by the candidates' Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Department and accompanied by the Registration Fees of K.Sh. 10 per candidate, should be submitted to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, National Housing Corporation House, Aga Khan Walk, off Harambee Avenue, P.O. Box 30095, Nairobi, so as to reach him on or before Friday, 14th October, 1977. Late entries and/or incomplete, uncertified or wrongly completed entry forms and entries not accompanied by the correct Registration Fees, will automatically be rejected.

8. EXAMINATION CENTRES

The examination will be held in all Provinces at Mombasa, Nyeri, Embu, Nairobi, Nakuru, Kakamega, Kisumu and Garissa Centres. The actual examination venue at each Provincial Centre will be notified to the candidates in due course.

9. GENERAL CONDUCT OF THE EXAMINATION

Candidates will not be allowed to consult any books, files, notes, magazines, etc., during the examination. Any infringement of this rule will result in immediate disqualification from the whole examination, and may also lead to disciplinary action being taken against the offenders. Examination papers and stationery will be supplied by this office to the Provincial Education Officers who will be in charge of the Examination Centres, and who will be responsible for the distribution of the papers and stationery to the candidates at their centres, appointment of invigilators, arrangement of the examination venues, and return to this office of the candidates' answer scripts when the examination is concluded, as directed by the Public Service Commission of Kenya, will be the responsibility of the Provincial Education Officers.

10. FINAL DECISION

All in all, the decision of the Public Service Commission of Kenya will be final in all matters related to this examination.

VACANCIES FOR DIRECT ENTRY INSPECTORS

APPLICATIONS are invited for suitably qualified men and women for Direct Entry into the Kenya Police in the rank of Inspector.

2. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

(a) *Educational qualifications.*—Applicants must be graduates with degrees from recognized universities and preference will be given to holders of degrees in Criminology, Law, Public Administration, Sociology and Psychology.

(b) *Physical Requirements*

Male Candidates:

- (i) Must be between 20 and 25 years of age;
- (ii) must be 1 metre 73 cm. (5 feet 8 inches) or over in height;
- (iii) chest measurement deflated 73 cm. (32 inches) or more;
- (iv) medically fit;
- (v) intelligent, of good vision and hearing without aids and of good physique.

Female Candidates:

As in (i), (iii), (iv) and (v) above. However, they must be 1 metre 16 cm. (5 feet 6 inches) or over in height. The appointment is considered suitable only to single girls as successful candidates are liable to be posted anywhere in the Republic of Kenya.

3. Successful candidates will be required to undergo a six (6) months' formal training at the Kenya Police College, Kiganjo. On successful completion of the training, officers will be posted to various Formations for duty. Subject to satisfactory performance, and on passing the Inspectorate Examination, the Inspector will be eligible for confirmation in his/her appointment and admission to the Permanent and Pensionable Establishment after two years' service on probation. Advancement to higher ranks will depend on individual's performance and ability.

4. SALARY SCALE

- (i) *Job Group "H".*—K£1,170 by £42 to £1,254 by £48 to £1,494 by £60 to £1,554.

5. UNIFORM

Free uniform will be issued on first appointment and thereafter an annual allowance of K£50 is payable for up-keep.
