They should be conversant with agricultural policy, farm data and project preparation. Post-graduate qualification in the relevant field would be a definite advantage.

The successful candidate will be responsible to the Head, Land and Farm Management Division, for the day-to-day operations and to Head, Integrated Agricultural Development Programme, for co-ordination of all matters related to the programme in respect of Land and Farm Management Division. He will be stationed at the Ministry Headquarters, Nairobi.

Senior Agricultural Officer (Officer-in-Charge Farm Management Branch) (One Post) (No. 260/77)

Salary scale.—£2,154 to £2,820 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should be graduates in Agriculture from a recognized university with at least five years' experience in the field of extension. A relevant post-graduate qualification would be a definite advantage.

Applicants should have served a recognized apprenticeship in Mechanical Engineering followed by at least five years' experience in inspection and repairs of hoists and lifts, chains, ropes and lifting tackle, cranes and other lifting machines, steam boilers, steam receivers and steam containers, and air receivers as required by Kenya Laws, the Factory Act (Chapter 514). They should also have a knowledge of workshop costing, stores procedure, machine shop operations, maintenance of air compressors and a knowledge of vehicles. Preference will be given to applicants who are of the East African Certificate of Education standard or its equivalent.

Inspector (Mechanical Handling) (One Post) (No. 264/77)

Salary scale.—£864 to £1,212 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should be mature persons preferably of East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent and should have undergone an apprenticeship in Mechanical Engineering. They should also have the knowledge for the repairs and services of the cranes in this Ministry's various workshops throughout the country; and make them ready for normal inspections as required by the Kenya Laws, the Factory Act (Chapter 514). A knowledge of machine tools, workshop costing and stores procedure is desirable and ability to train junior mechanics is essential.

Executive Officer I (One Post) (No. 265/77)

Applicants should be civil servants of East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent and must have served in the grade of Executive Officer II for not less than three years. Issue in dispute: —

- 1. Wage increase.
- 2. Effective date and duration.

RULING ON INTERPRETATION APPLICATION

This is an application by the Amalgamated Union of Kenya Metal Workers for interpretation of the Court award in the above dispute. This union has succeeded the Kenya Motor Engineering and Allied Workers' Union who were the Claimants in this dispute.

F. E. Omido, the General Secretary of the Amalgamated Union, was also the General Secretary of the Kenya Motor Engineering and Allied Workers' Union.

The part of the Court award which is the subject matter of this interpretation application reads as follows:—

"After a careful consideration of all the submissions the Court awards a Sh. 50 p.m. wage increase to all employees for the first year and a similar increase for the second year based on the following minimum monthly rates for the various grades which the parties had agreed on 13th September, 1974.

Grade Sh. 409 I ... II ... 458 Ш ... 507 IV ... 585 v ... 673 ... VI ... 760 ... VII ... 838 VIII ... 916

The Court further rules that the method of wage payment made on hourly rates should continue as had been agreed by the parties previously.

The Court further awards that the effective date should be 1st October, 1974 and that it should remain in force for a period of two years from that date."

As is obvious from the above the Court award expired on 30th September, 1976.

This interpretation application which was made on 15th December, 1976 has come after the Court award has expired. This is not the only surprising feature of this interpretation application because the parties entered into a comprehensive collective agreement effective from 29th April, 1976 for a period of 24 months from that date although the Court award was to continue up to 30th September, 1976. So the parties in fact varied the Court award some five months before it was due to expire. There has also been a further development in that the parties have entered into another wage agreement effective from 1st October, 1976 to remain in force for a period of 12 months from that date.

To begin with the Court would like to make one point very clear and that is that the result of this interpretation application will apply to the Court award for the period 1st October, 1974 to 29th April, 1976 only because after that date the parties are bound by their own collective agreements as stated hereinabove.

On behalf of the Claimants it has been argued that the Court award as set out hereinabove had not been properly implemented by the Respondents in that the minimum monthly rates had not gone up as follows:—

The Court has been asked to order the Respondents to pay the workers arrears due to them as the result of the misinterpretation of the Court award by them.

The Respondents on the other hand have stated that they had implemented the Court award and increased the minimum monthly rates as follows:—

The Respondents felt that the Court intended that the minimum monthly rates quoted on page 4 of the Court award were to prevail with effect from 1st October, 1974 and that the Sh. 50 increase was to apply to the basic wage rates for the various grades.

The Respondents drew the Court's attention to the two collective agreements stated hereinabove and argued that it confirmed that the Claimants had accepted their interpretation of the Court award to be true.

The Respondents further raised a technical point in that the original Claimant was the Kenya Motor Engineering & Allied Workers' Union and the application had been made by the Amalgamated Union of Kenya Metal Workers and questioned the propriety of this in addition to pointing out that not only had the Court award expired but that one of the original Court members was no longer a member of the Court.

The Court is satisfied that the interpretation application is properly before the Court because the Amalgamated Union has taken over both the Kenya Motor Engineering & Allied Workers' Union and the Kenya Electrical Workers' Union. It is obvious that the Amalgamated Union has inherited all the agreements and Court awards from these two unions. Moreover, the Notification of Dispute Form "A" in this dispute was signed by F. E. Omido as the General Secretary of the Kenya Motor Engineering & Allied Workers' Union and he continues as the General Secretary of the Amalgamated Union and has signed the interpretation application. Further notwithstanding the fact that the then Deputy to the Judge is no longer a member of the Court, the Judge and the other member are competent to hear and determing this application.

The Court award as set out hereinabove is very clear and the Court must express its very great surprise that the Respondents chose to interpret it differently. There is no ambiguity in the Court award which means that the workers were to get a Sh. 50 p.m. increase on the rates for the various grades specified on page 4 of the Court award which are as follows:—

In these circumstances the Court's hands are tied by a situation which has been created by the Claimants themselves in that they have varied the Court award.

Section 10 subsection (6) of the Trade Disputes Act reads as follows:—

"Subject to the provisions of this section, an award shall, as from the date that the award has effect, be an implied term of every contract of employment between the employers and employees to whom the award relates, so that the rate of wages to be paid and the terms and conditions of employment to be observed under the contract shall be in accordance with the award until it is varied by a subsequent award, or by agreement."

In view of the above subsection the Court award in this dispute continued in force until 29th April, 1976.

The Court would like to refer to the last paragraph of its award in a dispute between Kenya Motor Engineering & Allied Workers' Union and the Respondents in Cause No. 33/74—

"After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court awards that the parties should embark on fresh negotiations in order to establish the basic wage rate for all the unionizable grades in the Respondents' undertaking. Once the basic wage rates are established the Respondents will be at liberty to operate an incentive scheme in order to ensure higher productivity. In other words the guaranteed basic wage rates should be established below which no worker should get in any grade and the Respondents may operate over and above that a payment by results scheme for such department as they deem necessary."

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court rules that for the duration between 1st October 1974 to 30th September, 1975 no employee was to get less than the following minimum monthly rates:—

Having made the above interpretation the Court directs the Chief Industrial Relations Officer to ensure that the workers are paid their arrears if any, in accordance with this ruling for the period between 1st October, 1974 to 29th April, 1976.

The Court would like to emphasize that the workers will not be entitled to any benefit as a result of this Court ruling after 29th April, 1976 because their union from that date has entered into another collective agreement with the Respondents which has further been amended with effect from 1st October, 1976 as set out hereinabove. If they feel aggrieved then they have no

one to blame except themselves or their union leaders at the material time as the Court was not moved soon after the Respondents had misinterpreted the Court award which was announced on 15th April, 1975 and further they had entered into a collective agreement with the Respondents effective from 29th April 1976 whereby the minimum monthly rates are lower than what the Court had awarded. This collective agreement has further been amended effective from 1st October, 1976.

Terminal benefits to Uba Bakari.

- 1. The Transport & Allied Workers Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Esmail Abdalla shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents.
- 2. The dispute was originally fixed for hearing on 9th May, 1977 and the Respondents were required to submit their memorandum on or before 28th April, 1977.

On 9th May, 1977 when the Court assembled for the hearing of the dispute neither the Respondents nor their representative was present in Court at 10.00 a.m. The Respondents had also not filed their written submission by then. The Court accordingly adjourned the hearing to 23rd June, 1977 and ordered that the Respondents should file their memorandum on 24th May, 1977. Later on that day i.e. 9th May the Respondents' advocate, H. Y. Jiwaji appeared before the Judge at 11.00 a.m. and stated that he was late in appearing before the Court as the train had been held up just outside Nairobi and he had to find his way to the Court in a taxi. He brought the Respondents' submission with him.

On 23rd June, 1977 the hearing of the dispute took place with the Claimants and the Respondents making their respective submissions. In the course of the proceedings the Claimants asked for adjournment stating that their member Uba Bakari was not present in Court and that he was probably held up somewhere. The Respondents objected to the adjournment on the ground that they had seen Mr. Bakari in Mombasa only two days back. After further discussion the parties sought an adjournment which was granted.

As a result of the discussions between the parties during the adjournment after the dispute had been part heard by the Court, they requested the Court to make an award by consent as they had agreed to settle to dispute.

AWARD

3. At the request and by the consent of the parties the Court awards that the Respondents should pay a sum of Sh. 2,650 to Uba Bakari on an ex-gratia basis in full and final settlement of all his claims against the Respondents.

The Court further directs that the aforesaid amount of Sh. 2,650 should be paid by the Respondents to Uba Bakari through the Provincial Labour Officer, Mombasa.


