Applicants should be graduates in Agriculture from a recognized university with at least five years' experience in the field of extension. A relevant postgraduate qualification would be preferred.

The successful candidates will be responsible to the Provincial Directors of Agriculture for all crop production matters in the province, co-ordinating the implementation of crop policies, planning, programming, monitoring and guiding crop production programmes/projects, suggesting areas of crop research and liaising with research stations for the procurement of crop technological packages for field staff use. They will be posted to Central, Nyanza and Rift Valley Provincial Headquarters.

*Senior Agricultural Officer (Co-ordinators—Smallholder Crop*

*Loan/Large Group Farm Rehabilitation) (Two Posts) (No 371/77)*

*Salary scale*—£2,154 to £2,820 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants should be graduates in Agriculture from a recognized university with at least five years' experience in Agriculture Extension. They should be conversant with agricultural policy, farm data survey and analysis, project preparation and implementation. A relevant postgraduate qualification would be a definite advantage.

The successful candidates will be responsible to the Head, Integrated Agricultural Development Programme for the implementation and supervision of the large group farm rehabilitation/USAID Smallholder Production Services and credit projects, co-ordinating interagency activities, preparation of quarterly/annual reports guidance and liaison with heads of department/divisions in monitoring the projects. They will be stationed at the Ministry Headquarters, Nairobi.

*Agricultural Officer I (District Agricultural Officer) (Eighteen Posts) (No 372/77)*

*Senior Animal Husbandry Officer (One Post) (No 373/77)*

*Salary scale*—£2,154 to £2,820 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants should be graduates in Agriculture (Animal Production Specialization) from a recognized university with at least five years' experience in the field of extension. A relevant postgraduate qualification would be a definite advantage.

The successful candidate will be responsible to the Head, Animal Production Division, for the initiation and supervision of various animal production development projects in the country, providing technical advice and guidance to field extension staff on various aspects of animal production. He will be stationed at the Ministry Headquarters, Nairobi.

The successful candidate will be expected to deal with court matters, land transfers, mortgages, succession and inheritance, chattels mortgages, general contracts and preparation and custody of legal documents.

Applicants should preferably be civil servants of mature age of East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent with at least three years' experience in security duties in establishments which require concerted security control. Preference will be given to applicants from Police and Prison services who hold responsible positions. A sound knowledge of English and Swahili and ability to control and supervise a large number of cleaning staff and watchmen is essential.

## Issue in dispute —

Dismissal of Munyambo Nzazi

1 The Kenya Union of Commercial Food & Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Securicor Kenya Ltd shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents

2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on 8th November, 1977, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The Respondents also called William Nyakamba to give evidence on oath

## AWARD

3 The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 8th July, 1977, duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 27th August along with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner

M Nzazi was employed by the Respondents as a driver on 3rd August, 1971, and was dismissed on 14th January, 1975. At the time of his dismissal he was earning Sh 370 p.m. plus Sh 85 merit allowance

It is alleged that on 8th January, 1975, at 6 p.m. he was involved in an incident with a female employee at the Respondents' Thika branch. The accusation against him was that he accused Sergt Mary Anne Njoki of casting a bad look at him. He is said to have told the lady that he did not care about employment with Securicor and used a lot of abusive language. Mary asked him why he was behaving in that manner but received no answer. She decided to make an entry in an Occurrence Book about the incident. When she started doing this Nzazi got hold of her and pulled her hair. He wanted to slap her but was prevented from doing so by two other employees of the Respondents who were present there.

The Respondents' Branch Manager who gave evidence on oath stated that in the evening of 8th January, 1975, Sergt Mary and two other employees came to his house and reported that Nzazi had assaulted her. The Branch Manager along with them went to the Respondents' offices but found that Nzazi was out on duty. The next day in the morning the Branch Manager recorded statements from all the persons concerned with the incident and asked Nzazi also to make a statement giving his version of what happened but Nzazi refused to answer his questions and said that Mary being a woman should not despise him and added that "you are all fools you don't know what you are doing" after which he banged the door and went out.

The Branch Manager then consulted the head office in Nairobi and was told that he should issue a warning letter to Nzazi. After about two days he summoned Nzazi and wanted to give him the warning letter but he refused to take it and said the same words which he had uttered the previous day and after banging the door went out. He was then suspended by the Branch Manager and on advice from the head office Nzazi was dismissed. The Branch Manager stated on oath that he had no grudge against Nzazi on any point and added that until this incident he was a good employee and had no warnings.

The Claimants have based their case for the maximum compensation to be awarded to Nzazi along with all other dues on the ground that he had suffered a wrongful dismissal. They have relied mainly on, according to their own words, an informal investigation by the District Labour Officer, Thika, who had written to the Respondents' Personnel Manager on 17th March, 1975 stating that —

"After listening to the verbal submissions from both sides and after cross examination of the three witnesses who were present on the day of alleged fighting or assault, all the three witnesses denied before me of having seen the complaint fight or even harass Miss Mary

The evidence which was given voluntarily persuaded me to come to the conclusion that Nzazi was wrongfully dismissed perhaps as a result of personal hatred between him and the Branch Manager. As good industrial relations cannot be fostered on hatred, I have to rule that Nzazi be paid one month's notice and all his leave and since I cannot order his reinstatement, I further award that he be paid 15 days' pay for loss of employment."

The Claimants have further relied on the findings of a Ministry of Labour Investigator which were in their favour. The Investigator had found that the Respondents' story that Nzazi had some problem with the lady in her office is flimsy as no motive had been adduced as to why he should choose to visit the lady's office and start causing trouble. The Investigator further referred to the District Labour Officer's investigation and recommended that his dismissal should be reduced to normal termination and he be paid his terminal benefits. He also recommended three months' wages as compensation for loss of employment.

The Claimants did not call Nzazi to give evidence on oath but made an allegation on his behalf that he had been victimized for his under-cover investigation which he was carrying out on behalf of the head office particularly as far as the petrol consumption at the branch was concerned. They stated that the Branch Manager, Thika, had been tipped off by the Nyeri Branch Manager where Nzazi had completed his investigation.

and as a result the Branch Manager had cooked up a story regarding the "Mary incident" in order to get rid of Nzazi

In this dispute the Court is confronted with a situation where it is required to make an award on a dismissal dispute which started in January, 1975. This most undesirable situation has been brought about to begin with by the Claimants themselves who did not report a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour until February, 1976. They tried to explain this delay by saying that there was a change in branch officials at Thika which resulted in this delay. The Court finds this excuse to be very flimsy and not acceptable. Then there is further delay at the investigation in the Ministry of Labour level as the Investigator's report was not handed out to the parties until sometime in January, 1977. All this resulted in the dispute being referred to the Court on 27th August, 1977. The Court would like to draw the attention of the authorities concerned to this delay in the hope that an inquiry will be made thereinto so that such delays in future may be eliminated. The Court would like to emphasize that dismissal disputes should be tackled urgently both by the trade unions and the employers and the Ministry of Labour so that they find their way to the Industrial Court within the shortest possible time to enable the Court if necessary to make appropriate awards without being inhibited with such factors as delays running into years during which time the whole picture has altered.

The other very unfortunate part of this dispute as far as the Claimants are concerned is that although Nzazi was present in Court during the hearing of this dispute they did not call him to give evidence on oath and the Respondents were thus denied the opportunity of cross examining him. This means that the Claimants have failed to prove the allegations which they made against the Respondents on behalf of Nzazi as the Court cannot understand the reason why he did not give evidence if what he alleges was true. The Court is forced by this to come to the conclusion that the Claimants' story about Nzazi being an under-cover investigator on behalf of someone at the head office to be mere unsubstantiated allegations and no more. Further if what he said was true then surely the head office would have protected him but there is absolutely no evidence at all to show that.

On the other hand the Respondents' Branch Manager who gave evidence on oath during the hearing impressed the Court to be a truthful witness. The Court is not surprised at all that the parties were not in a position to call other witnesses because it has taken nearly three years for the dispute to find its way to the Court.

The Court has carefully considered the District Labour Officer's informal investigation and finds that one very vital aspect in the dispute did not receive his attention and that is the behaviour of Nzazi when he was to be served with a letter of warning due to the "Mary incident". The Court would like to state for the guidance of the workers in future that the proper course for them if they feel aggrieved at a warning letter is for them to take up the matter officially with the management with the assistance of their trade union. It does not help them to behave in a manner which amounts to gross misconduct and can amount to insubordination and insolence.

In this dispute if Nzazi had accepted the letter of warning and then challenged it through his trade union in all probability he would still be working for the Respondents. But unfortunately for him he misbehaved very badly when the Branch Manager was about to give him the letter of warning. His behaviour at that time clearly amounted to gross misconduct and insubordination which justified the Respondents dismissing him.

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court rejects the Claimants' demand and makes a nil award.

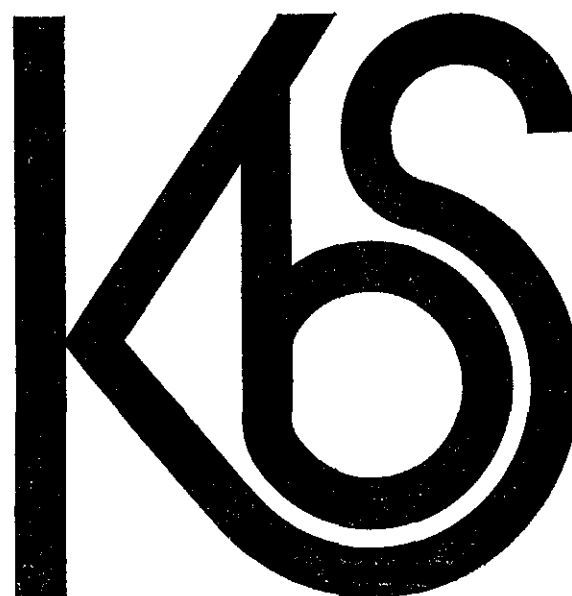
