## VACANCIES

## NOTE

Incremental credits will be granted to successful candidates who are not civil servants for approved previous experience provided the maximum salary is not exceeded. *Vacancies in the Ministry of Water Development*

*Senior Superintending Engineer (Two Posts) (No 387/77)*

*Salary scale—£2,712 to £3,540 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT*

Applicants should have a recognized university degree in Civil or Mechanical Engineering or equivalent full membership of a recognized professional institution. They should have had at least ten years' post-qualification relevant professional practice with not less than five years in Water Supply Engineering of which two years must have been at a senior level equivalent to Superintending Engineer in the Water Department. Preference will be given both for experience on the operation and maintenance side and also for service in a Government Department. Proven managerial ability is essential. The successful applicant will head the operation and maintenance division of the Water Department.

*Senior Superintendent (Electrical) (One Post) (No 388/77)*

Applicants should be civil servants of East African Certificate of Education standard. They must have approved electrical training, preferably City and Guilds' Electrical Engineering Technical Certificate, Final Grade, with endorsement (full technological certificate) or its accepted equivalent. Seven years' satisfactory post-training experience in the installation, operation and maintenance of large H T Electrical machinery of which at least five years must have been connected with water supply including borehole submersible generators and control, the design of electrical machinery installations including specification and estimates preferably related to water supply. They must have served as Superintendent (Electrical) for at least three years and be in possession of Electrical "A" Licence and have extensive administrative ability and thorough knowledge of the current electrical regulations.

*Senior Superintendent (Mechanical) (One Post) (No 389/77)*

*Salary scale—£1,734 to £2,334 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT*

Applicants should be civil servants of at least East African Certificate of Education standard. They should have had approved training equivalent to that of Ministry of Works, Inspector (Mechanical) course covering the maintenance of diesel and petrol engined cars and lorries and heavy tractors. They must have seven years' satisfactory post training experience in the maintenance of motor vehicles and machines of which three years should be in the grade of Superintendent (Mechanical).

Proven high level administrative and accounting ability will be necessary.

*Senior Superintendent (Water) (Four Posts)—Coast Province Water Branch (No 390/77)*

*Salary scale—£1,734 to £2,334 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT*

Applicants should be civil servants of at least East African Certificate of Education standard and must have successfully completed Water Department three years' course for Water Supply Inspectors or approved equivalent. They must have had seven years' satisfactory post training experience in Water Supply

or Irrigation Administration, Operation, Maintenance and Construction of which three years must be in the grade of Superintendent (Water). Proven ability in administration and organization are essential.

*Chemist Grade I (Water) (One Post) (No 391/77)*

*Salary scale—£1,734 to £2,334 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT*

Applicants should be civil servants who are graduates in Chemistry from a recognized university or an equivalent qualification. They must have had satisfactory post-graduate experience of five years in the routine examination and analysis of water from ground and surface sources.

The successful candidate will advise and make recommendations on the chemical aspects in the design and operation of water treatment works, carry out examination and analysis of sewage effluents, organize and plan suitable courses for instruction of Water Supply Operators and Sewerage Works Supervisors.

*Executive Officer I (One Post) (No 392/77)*

*Salary scale—£1,446 to £1,938 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT*

Applicants must be civil servants of East African Certificates of Education. They must have considerable knowledge and experience of Government Regulations, personnel, office, stores and accounting procedures, and must have served as Executive Officer II for at least two years.

Preference will be given to applicants who have successfully completed office or Personnel Management courses at Government Training Institute, Maseno or Kenya Institute of Administration, Kabete.

*Executive Officer Grade II (One Post)—Coast Province Water Branch (No 393/77)*

Applicants should have had a good general education, preferably East African Certificate of Education. They should have had approved training equivalent to that of the Ministry of Works Inspector (Mechanical) course covering the maintenances of diesel and petrol engined cars and lorries or heavy tractors. They must have had at least three years' post-training experience in the maintenance of these vehicles and machines at a level of responsibility equivalent to Inspector (Mechanical) in the civil service. Preference will be given to candidates with the experience in the maintenance of Water Supply Machines.

*Security Officer (Two Posts)—Coast Province Water Branch (No 395/77)*

*Salary scale—£864 to £1,212 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT*

Applicants should be mature persons and must be ex service men in the Police or Armed Forces. They must have good command of English Language and be able to speak Swahili fluently. They must have wide experience in exercising control over subordinate staff. Duties include the supervision of subordinate staff, security, cleanliness and orderliness of departmental premises and responsibility for equipment, fixtures and fittings.

*Senior Inspector of Factories (Industrial Health Officer) (Two Posts) (No 397/77)*

*Salary scale—£1,446 to £1,938 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT*

Applicants must be Kenya Citizens and holders of a degree in Engineering from a recognized university. Applicants must show ability to prepare clear and concise correspondence, reports and documentation, initiative, maturity of judgment and ability to maintain harmonious working relationship. Duties attached to these posts include —

- (a) Carrying out regular and systematic inspection of factories and other premises to which the Factories Act and subsidiary legislations apply
- (b) Investigating accidents and other occupational hazards occurring in factories and other premises to which the Factories Act and subsidiary legislations apply, reporting and recommending measures to prevent recurrence

*Salary scale—£1,170 to £1,554 p a PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT*

Applicants must be Kenya citizens and holders of a degree in a Scientific Discipline, preferably Chemistry, Physics or/and Mathematics from a recognized university. Applicants must show ability to prepare clear and concise correspondence, reports and documentation, initiative, maturity of judgment and ability to maintain harmonious working relationship. Duties attached to these posts include —

- (a) Carrying out regular and systematic inspection of factories and other premises to which the Factories Act and subsidiary legislations apply
- (b) Investigating accidents and other occupational hazards occurring in factories and other premises to which the Factories Act and subsidiary legislations apply, reporting and recommending measures to prevent recurrence

Applicants should have a recognized degree in Commerce or in Arts with Economics, Accounting or Auditing as a major field of study with at least three years' post qualification experience in Government or in a large commercial organization. Consideration will also be given to serving officers who hold the East African Certificate of Education and have obtained a pass in CPA Part II or its equivalent and possess not less than four years auditing and accounting experience in a responsible position.

Duties include examination, inspection and auditing of books of accounts and other business records of registered manufacturers and other dealers as assigned from time to time, verification of Sales Tax Returns, tax payments and liabilities, credits, refund claims, deductions, etc., and accuracy of purchases made under tax exempt conditions and also advising registered manufacturers in the most appropriate manner of maintaining Sales Tax records.
