AWARD

3 The parties having agreed to settle the dispute the Court awards as follows as per the parties' agreement —

Nganda Kieti

That the Respondents shall pay him the following benefits in full and final settlement of the claims made by him in this dispute

- 1 Five months' pay
- 2 Three months' housing allowance
- 3 Cash for days worked, if any
- 4 Cash in lieu of leave due, if any
- 5 Cash for overtime worked, if any

David Thumbi

That the Respondents shall pay him Sh 2,000 in full and final settlement of all his claims in this dispute

Issue in dispute — Council's failure to pay acting allowance to Messrs Alphonse Lusichi, Robert Manyasa and Misoga Angana

1 The Kenya Local Government Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and the Kakamega County Council shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents

2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 25th day of November, 1977, and relied on their written and verbal submissions

AWARD

3 The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 26th May, 1977, duly signed by both parties was received by the Court on 30th September along with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner

The Claimants are claiming acting allowance on behalf of their three members on the ground that they had all on diverse dates performed duties in higher grades

The details of the claims are as follows —

Robert Manyasa — The Claimants stated that while he was a Revenue Assistant he was appointed by the Respondents to act as a Cashier in salary scale 6 and he acted in that post from 5th December, 1974, until 17th February, 1975

Henry Misoga Angana — He was also a Revenue Officer in August, 1975, and was appointed to act as Accountant in salary scale 3, one scale above his substantive post and it is claimed he acted as an Accountant from 6th August to 2nd October, 1975

Alphonse Lusichi — He was a Committee Clerk in salary scale 6 and he was appointed to act as Clerk to Council on 1st March, 1973, in salary scale 1 and he acted as Clerk to Council until 24th April, 1973

The Claimants are demanding payment of acting allowance to all the aforesaid officers in accordance with Rule 7 of the Terms and Conditions of Service for Salaries Grades which states —

"Acting allowance

- (a) An officer shall be entitled to be paid an acting allowance if he is temporarily appointed by the Establishment Committee to act for a period of at least one month in salary 1-10
- (b) An acting allowance shall be half the difference between the minimum of the officer's substantive salary scale and the minimum of the salary scale appropriate to the post in which he acts
- (c) Where a post is vacant and an officer is appointed to act for a period of at least three months he shall be paid the whole difference between the minimums of the two scales"

The Respondents have opposed these claims on the ground that the Local Government Regulations, 1963 are very clear on acting appointments and acting allowances. They submit that no Local Authority can carry out an acting appointment or pay acting allowance except with the prior approval of the Minister for Local Government

The Respondents also referred the Court to a circular which had been issued by the Ministry of Local Government on 7th March, 1974, addressed to all Town Clerks and all County Clerks/Treasurers. This circular pointed out that in view of the deteriorating financial position of Local Authorities the Ministry had decided that no acting/responsibility allowances shall be granted to officers of Local Authorities unless prior approval has been given by the Ministry. This circular also referred to "merit" increments and warned that this practice should be discontinued forthwith

The Respondents referred to clause 3 of the Terms and Conditions of Service which stated that in the event of a conflict between the Local Government Regulations and the Terms and Conditions of Service, the Local Government Regulations, 1963 shall prevail

For the foregoing reasons the Court was asked to reject the claims

The Court notes that at a meeting of the Finance/Staff and General Purposes Committee held on 29th November, 1975, Messrs Manyasa and Angana along with some other officers were recommended for acting allowances in accordance with the Staff Rules subject to the Ministry of Local Government's approval. These minutes were produced by the Claimants during the hearing along with other documents in support of their claim. The Court would like to point out that the relevant minute makes it quite clear that the payment of acting allowances was subject to the Ministry of Local Government's approval.

Apparently either the approval of the Ministry of Local Government was not sought or it was not forthcoming because on 4th February, 1976, the Acting Clerk/County Treasurer to the Respondents wrote to the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Local Government, on this matter in which he referred to Minute No. 57 of 1975 regarding the payment of acting allowances and towards the end of the letter stated —

"As I have been discharging both duties attached to the post of County Treasurer and County Clerk since February, 1974, it was not possible for me to redistribute the work among other officers from the time the Accountant took his leave and other officers. Before authorizing the acting appointment I was satisfied with the circumstances and I recommend that the acting allowances of Sh. 3,921.45 be approved before payment is made."

There seems to be no evidence of a further reply from the Ministry of Local Government on this matter so the inference is that the approval of the Minister has not yet been granted.

As far as A. Lusichi is concerned it is not disputed that at a meeting of the Finance and General Purposes and the Establishment and Terms of Service Committee meeting held on 9th March, 1973, he was appointed to act as Clerk to Council with effect from 1st March, 1973. At that meeting it was resolved that in view of the fact that the Clerk was now on leave Mr. Lusichi, the Committee Clerk, be appointed Acting Clerk to Council until the Clerk resumed duty on 25th April, 1973.

The Court finds it rather strange that on 2nd April, 1973, Mr. Lusichi wrote to the Respondents' Treasurer claiming acting allowance for the month of March and stating in that letter that the members had not felt it necessary to seek the Minister's approval on this appointment since it was going to last only two months of March and April. The Treasurer, however, did not give in but on 16th April, 1973, he wrote to the Provincial Local Government Officer asking for written approval to pay Mr. Lusichi acting allowance in accordance with regulations 112 and 114 of the Local Government Regulations, 1963.

Here again the Ministry of Local Government's approval has not been given.

There is obviously no dispute on the fact that the three officers did perform duties which entitled them to claim acting allowances in accordance with their terms and conditions of service as agreed between the parties. However, unfortunately for them their own Code and the Local Government Regulations make it clear that any such payments are subject to the Local Government Regulations which in any case prevail over an inter-party agreement.

The Court feels that if employees have carried out lawful instructions given to them by their employers then there is no reason why they should not be paid their dues. The Court, however, cannot order the Minister for Local Government to give his approval as for one thing he is not a direct party to this dispute.

The Court has taken note of the fact that the Claimants are actively pursuing the matter of circulars which are issued by the Ministry of Local Government which erode the benefits which the Claimants have won for their members working for the Local Authorities. The Court hopes that something fruitful will come out of these endeavours for the benefit of the Local Authorities and their workers.

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court finds that it cannot help the Claimants any more than to make a finding that although their members are entitled to their claims of acting allowances those claims cannot be paid until such time as the Minister for Local Government gives his approval to the same. In these circumstances the Court cannot make an award in favour of the Claimants but hopes that the Minister for Local Government will see it fit to give his approval to what appear to be genuine claims rendered due to the exigencies of the service.



All "copy" submitted for publication should be prepared on one side of a foolscap sheet no matter how small the notice or Act, each page being numbered, and should be typewritten with double spacing. Copy should be clear, legible, and contain a minimum of alterations

Particular attention should be paid to the following points —

- (i) Signatures must be clarified by means of rubber-stamping or typing the name of the signer in capital letters
- (ii) Dates must be correct and filled in where necessary
- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings to notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya

EXTRACT FROM THE CODE OF REGULATIONS, SECTION D—**Kenya Gazette**
