- 5. Applicants must enclose with their applications their postal order or banker's order for K.Sh. 1,000 as a deposit, (N.B.—Personal cheques are not acceptable) which will be dealt with as follows:—
 - (a) If the applicant is offered and takes up and pays for the plot within a period of seven days as required in paragraph 5 below, the deposit will be credited to him.
 - (b) If the applicant is unsuccessful the applicant's deposit will be returned to him.
 - (c) If the application is successful but the applicant fails to take up and pay for the plot offered to him within a period of 14 days as required in paragraph 5 below of the general conditions, the Council may declare the deposit forfeited and the applicant shall have no further claim thereto.

Ordinary Conditions

- 1. The Ordinary Conditions applicable to Township Grants of this nature except as varied hereby shall apply to this grant.
- 2. The grant will be made under the provisions of Trust Land Act (Cap. 288) of the Laws of Kenya, and the title will be registered under the Registration of Titles Act.

5.
