The issue in dispute stated on this form was "refusal by the Council to reinstate D. S. Okumu as recommended by the Ministry of Labour".

The Court proceeded to make arrangements for the parties' submissions and fixed the hearing date to be 5th April, 1977. The Claimants, however, requested that as the General Secretary

would be away for a month or so the hearing be rescheduled. The hearing was accordingly fixed for 5th and 6th July, 1977 on which day Mr. O. Otieno, advocate, applied for permission to represent the Claimants which permission was granted and the hearing proceeded. During the opening submissions, however, it was discovered that the Claimants in fact had brought the dispute on the issue of dismissal of D. S. Okumu, Assistant Administrative Officer, and the Court accordingly advised the parties that a new Notification of Dispute Form "A" should be signed in order to reflect the proper issue in dispute. The parties agreed to this.

On 6th September, 1977 the Court received a fresh Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 6th July, 1977 along with the statutory certificates from the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner and proceeded to hear the dispute on the following dates: 6th, 7th, 8th, 30th September, 2nd November, 1977 and 12th, 13th January, 1978. AWARD

3. D. S. Okumu started working for the Respondents as an Administrative Assistant II on 4th December, 1972 and he was promoted in September 1973 to be an Administrative Assistant 1.

On 25th June, 1975 he was served with a letter informing him that the Finance Committee at its meeting on 23rd June had decided that he should be given days off between 25th June until the full Council meeting shall have made a decision on a recommendation of the Finance Committee.

On 9th July, 1975 he was summarily dismissed because he had unlawfully used a Council vehicle No. KDT 360 on 31st May, 1975, an act of gross misconduct within the provisions of section 25 (e) of the Council's Terms and Conditions of Service applicable to him. The Town Treasurer was directed to pay him all his dues for all the days he had worked including 8th July, 1975.

The alleged incident which resulted in the summary dismissal of Mr. Okumu started on 31st May, 1975 which was a Saturday when Mr. Okumu is said to have gone to the Respondents' works yard shortly after 12 p.m. It is stated that at the yard he introduced himself to a refuse lorry driver N. Njoroge as one of the "big bosses" from the Town Hall and told him that he was to use lorry No. KDT 360. The driver then signed the log book and drove out of the yard with Mr. Okumu sitting in the lorry. From there they went to Nyawita Quarry where they loaded ballast and from there they took the load to Otonglo Market near which Mr. Okumu was in the process of erecting a building. After discharging the load there it is alleged that they drove to Kodiaga from where a load of sand was collected and brought back to Otonglo after which another load of sand was brought from the Lakeshore. Thereafter they proceeded to collect more sand to Karateng' near Lela Market. After the transportation of sand they collected timber and after unloading timber the lorry proceeded to Daraja Mbili with Mr. Okumu for collecting more ballast. It was during this trip when they were between Kisian and Otonglo that the engine sustained a knockout.

The Respondents allege that on 1st June Mr. Okumu went to the house of another refuse driver employed by the Respondents and asked him to tow KDT 360 with his lorry KDT 564 to the Respondents' works yard in Kisumu. Ali Noor seeing that Mr. Okumu was a very senior officer complied with his instructions.

The Court was told that the total amount of damage to the lorry amounted to Sh. 13,000 coupled with the loss of use of the lorry during the time it was being repaired.

Mr. Okumu's version of the incident is that he had the permission from the Medical Officer of Health to use the lorry

in question although he admits that he did not formally make a written request and that on the Saturday in question he had telephoned the works yard to find out if KDT 360 was available for him to hire as arranged. At about 12.30 he had gone to the yard where he found one Mr. Alanyo waiting for him with instructions to show him the driver who was to drive the lorry for him. The driver signed the log book at the gate and from there they proceeded to Nyawita Quarry. The number of trips he made on the lorry appear in Appendix "F" of Claimants' memorandum.

During the hearing Mr. Okumu gave evidence on oath and confirmed that he had permission to hire the lorry from the Medical Officer of Health and that he had been victimized because shortly before this incident he had refused to oblige the Deputy Mayor of the Respondents by issuing a licence to one of his friends.

It was further submitted on his behalf that all along he was a hirer of the Respondents' lorry KDT 360 and that at that particular time he was not acting in his capacity as an employee. Therefore if the lorry broke down during the hiring assignment then he was not in any way responsible for it.

In any case it was argued on his behalf that he should have been dealt with under clause 29 of the Terms and Conditions of Service which reads:

"Loss or damage to council property:

Where loss of or damage to Council property occurs, including loss of money, through the careless, negligent or malicious act or omission of an officer he shall be required to meet the whole or part of the cost of such loss or damage as determined by the Treasurer and the Head of Department concerned."

The Claimants further submitted that Mr. Okumu had been a victim of conspiracy hatched and executed by the Respondent's senior officers who came from South Nyanza who were determined to get rid of Mr. Okumu as he had been appointed in preference to a candidate from South Nyanza when he was originally employed.

The Claimants vigorously argued that the Respondents had violated all the principles of natural justice in terminating the service of Mr. Okumu because he had no idea that his services were going to be terminated or that he was required to defend himself before the Finance and General Purposes Committee meeting held on 23rd June, 1975. They maintained that as far as Mr. Okumu was concerned he was only required to attend this meeting to clear the air. Yet the meeting had proceeded to conduct a full inquiry into the incident and had denied Mr. Okumu the right to defend himself or to cross-examine the persons who gave statements relating to this incident. The notice about this meeting which was given to Mr. Okumu was totally inadequate as he was informed of it on that very day.

The Claimants also made a reference to the fact that the relevant minute of the Finance and Purposes Committee was headed "illegal use of the vehicle" which implied that the Committee had already decided that Mr. Okumu was guilty of the illegal use of KDT 360. They further alleged that the minutes of this Committee meeting had been altered to suit the ends of the offices who wanted to get rid of Mr. Okumu. They also made a strong submission suggesting that the Medical Officer of Health had tried to get himself out of having to foot the bill of Sh. 13,000 being the damage to KDT 360 as he had hired out this lorry to Mr. Okumu without consulting the Town Engineer.

The Respondents' submissions in brief are that Mr. Okumu had taken KDT 360 along with the driver without proper permission or authority on 31st May, 1975 and that his subsequent actions over the week-end amounted to gross misconduct. They maintained that Mr. Okumu knew fully well what the hiring procedure was and he did not follow it. They denied that the Medical Officer of Health or the Conservancy Superintendent had given him any authority for use of this vehicle, neither had the Town Engineer.

The Respondents suspected that Messrs. Okumu and Odera were in a conspiracy and this had resulted in unauthorized use of two lorries and two drivers by Mr. Okumu over the said week-end and that the big damage of Sh. 13,000 had aggravated his offence.

The Respondents questioned the conduct of Mr. Okumu in not reporting the break-down of KDT 360 to any of the chief officers and instead, of going to the house of driver Ali Noor and asking him to tow KDT 360 back to the works yard.

The Respondents rejected the charges of conspiracy on the part of some of the senior officers from South Nyanza to get rid of Mr. Okumu and pointed out that the composition of the Finance and General Purposes Committee showed that

there was only one member from South Nyanza on that Committee and that at the meeting of the full Council there were only two members from South Nyanza.

The Respondents also rejected the charges against the Deputy Mayor that he had an interest in this matter and that he should have declared it as refusal of licence as alleged by the Claimants had nothing to do with this incident.

The Respondents submitted that they had not violated any principles of natural justice and that Mr. Okumu knew well before 23rd June, 1975 that he would be required to explain and absolve himself regarding the damage to KDT 360. Finally the Respondents maintained that Mr. Okumu's services had been properly terminated for justifiable reasons.

In addition to the written and verbal submissions the Court had the benefit of hearing the evidence on oath of four witnesses called by the Claimants and six by the Respondents. The Court will be commenting on the evidence of some of the witnesses in due course.

The Court would first of all like to refer to a letter written by Mr. Okumu on 16th June, 1975 to the Medical Officer of Health in which in the second paragraph he writes:

"During the time I sought permission from you to use a vehicle from your Department, you told me that you were going to instruct the Conservancy Superintendent to allow me the use of the vehicle when and only when the said vehicle is free from Council's duties. I went to the Conservancy Superintendent to seek the hire of the said vehicle on Thursday 29th May, 1975 to carry for me two trips of ballast from Nyawita Quarry to Otonglo Market. As far as he is concerned, the vehicle would be free to do any other work on Saturday 31st May, 1975 after it had performed the normal conservancy duties that morning."

A careful study of the aforesaid paragraph leads the Court to believe that at some stage Mr. Okumu had a general talk with the Medical Officer of Health regarding the hiring of a lorry from the Conservancy Section. It certainly does not contain an allegation that the Medical Officer of Health had authorized the use of KDT 360 on that particular week-end. All that it amounts to is that the Medical Officer of Health had agreed in principle to Mr. Okumu hiring a lorry after which it was up to Mr. Okumu to comply with the hiring procedure as established by the Respondents. The Court is satisfied that the next step which Mr. Okumu should have followed was to strictly comply with the hiring procedure of which he was fully aware as he had hired another 7 ton Tiper from the Respondents on 24th January, 1975 for which he had made a written request to the Town Engineer but unfortunately for him he did not do so on this occasion.

The Conservancy Superintendent, Mr. Ochieng, gave evidence in a straightforward manner and impressed the Court as a truthful witness. He clearly stated that he remembered that on 29th May in the morning Mr. Okumu had telephoned him asking if he could use KDT 360 but he had told Mr. Okumu that his lorry was engaged in an essential service and therefore he could not release it. This witness stated that after that conversation Mr. Okumu had not got in touch with him again.

Mr. Ochieng categorically stated that he did not authorize the hire of KDT 360 to Mr. Okumu and added that if Mr. Okumu had the necessary authority he would have released the lorry only if there was no Council work.

This witness also explained that he had not instituted any disciplinary proceedings against the driver N. Njoroge because he felt that the driver had no alternative but to carry out instructions from a senior officer from the Town Hall who had approached him at that time.

The Court having found that Mr. Ochieng was a truthful witness it follows that Mr. Okumu did not get any authorization from him for the use of KDT 360.

The Claimants called Mr. Odera and N. Adhola to corroborate the evidence of Mr. Okumu that he had telephoned and spoken to Mr. Ochieng on 29th May and that Mr. Ochieng had agreed to the hiring of KDT 360 by Mr. Okumu. The Court finds the evidence of both these witnesses to be unreliable because Mr. Adhola was in fact proved to be a liar during the cross-examination as it was proved to the satisfaction of the Court that at the material time when he claimed he was at the works yard he was on leave during that time. When he was confronted with irrefutable evidence on this point he was obviously shocked and when the Court resumed the hearing of the dispute on 2nd November Mr. Adhola tried to salvage the evidence and his reputation by saying that he remembered that he was on leave on 29th May, 1975 but he was in the office because he had gone to make sure that some of the workers had repaid some loans to a money lender. The Court

totally rejects this explanation by Mr. Adhola and finds him to be untrustworthy.

The Court was not particularly impressed by Mr. Odera's evidence either and finds that his credibility was shaken. This witness had made a statement on 29th June and in that statement he stated that on 30th May, 1975 Mr. Okumu had telephoned at the works yard and wanted to speak to Mr. Ochieng and as Mr. Ochieng was out he spoke to Mr. Okumu but before he could tell him what his problems were Mr. Ochieng had come. In this statement this witness does not make any mention of hearing Mr. Ochieng uttering the words "I will arrange" as he alleged in his evidence during the hearing. He also does not say in this statement that Mr. Okumu had spoken to Mr. Ochieng about a vehicle or that Mr. Okumu had told him what his problems were whereas during the evidence on 29th May, 1975 asking about a vehicle.

The Court must express its views rather strongly when parties call witnesses to tell lies on their behalf. The Court does not hold the Claimants' advocate in any way responsible for this state of affairs but cannot help finding that Mr. Okumu is the person who must have arranged all this fictitious evidence particularly of Mr. Adhola. This has seriously dented the credibility of Mr. Okumu as well.

The Court is satisfied that Mr. Okumu after having had a general talk with the Medical Officer of Health about the hire of a lorry from the Conservancy Department had proceeded to the works yard on 31st May around 12.30 p.m. and had introduced himself to N. Njoroge as a senior officer from the Town Hall and persuaded him to go with him in the lorry on his assignments without any proper authority.

This particular point is corroborated by Mr. Alanyo who gave evidence on behalf of the Respondents who stated that he had seen Mr. Okumu come to the works yard at 12.20 and had gone straight to KDT 360. He also explained that he had earlier spoken to Mr. Okumu over the telephone at about 11.30 when Mr. Okumu had inquired if KDT 360 had come back to the yard from its rounds and he had told him that the vehicle was still out on Council duty and he told him to inquire at about 12 noon. This witness denied that he had been instructed to introduce Mr. Okumu to Mr. Njoroge and stated that he was at the works yard at that time doing his normal duties of a messenger—cleaning, locking up, etc.

The Court has viewed this witness's evidence in the light of the Claimants' submission that he had since been promoted to be a clerk and finds that notwithstanding this promotion his evidence generally fits in with the truth of the matter which is that Mr. Okumu had not obtained any permission for the use of KDT 360.

The Court finds the evidence of the driver, Ali Noor, to be truthful when he stated that Mr. Okumu had come to his house on 1st June and had asked him to take his lorry KDT 564 and go and tow KDT 360 from the place where it had broken down to the works yard. His evidence contradicts Mr. Okumu's evidence on this point.

The Court has carefully considered the allegations of a conspiracy on the part of the chief officers who come from South Nyanza against Mr. Okumu but finds that there is no truth in this allegation and that Mr. Okumu is just making these allegations in order to save himself.

The Court cannot understand the Claimants' submission that the Deputy Mayor should have declared his interest in this matter. Even if the Deputy Mayor did have a grudge against Mr. Okumu, and the Court very much doubts it, it is extremely naive for the Claimants to expect any person in such a position to say that he had a grudge against him and therefore he would not take part in the proceedings. Is this the sort of interest that the Claimants expect the Deputy Mayor to have declared? The Court finds that there is no merit in this argument.

After careful consideration of the submissions and the evidence the Court finds that Mr. Okumu used Respondents' vehicle KDT 360 without any authority on 31st May, 1975.

The Court having made the above finding must now determine if the Respondents' subsequent actions in terminating his services were proper and in conformity with the Terms and Conditions of Service relating to salaried grades for Committee No. 2.

It is quite obvious that the Respondents did not choose to deal with this matter under clause 29 which has been quoted hereinabove relating to loss or damage to Council property but instead proceeded to summarily dismiss Mr. Okumu under clause 25 (e) which reads as follows:—

"(e) Where an officer admits to the commission of an act of gross negligence, gross misconduct or insubordination or

any act or omission that would justify summary dismissal without notice under the law relating to master and servant he may be summarily dismissed by the Town Clerk without notice."

The Court finds that Mr. Okumu did not at any stage admit to the commission of an act of gross negligence, gross misconduct or insubordination or any act or omission, and that it was only the finding of the Finance and General Purposes Committee meeting of 23rd June, 1975 that he had used KDT 360 without authority. In these circumstances the Respondents are clearly in the wrong for having terminated his services under clause 25 (e).

The Court must also comment on the fact that Mr. Okumu's only official notice of the meeting of 23rd June, 1975 was that he was required to clear the air regarding the circumstances that led to the break down of KDT 360 and that he should be present at the Committee meeting in case the Committee wanted to hear from him personally. Having given this, a few hours', notice to Mr. Okumu the Committee had then decided to proceed not only to investigate the circumstances leading to the damage to KDT 360 but also to recommend the summary dismissal of Mr. Okumu. Further Mr. Okumu was not given an opportunity of cross-examining the other persons who had made statements before the Committee.

In the aforesaid circumstances the Court while finding that Mr. Okumu fully deserved a termination of his services further finds that the Respondents had not gone about doing it properly and they had followed a wrong procedure and finally had terminated his services under a wrong clause of the Terms and Conditions of Service. In these circumstances the Court awards that Mr. Okumu's services should have been terminated under clause 25 (b) which reads as follows:—

"In the case of an officer in salary scales 1 to 9 inclusive by three months' written notice over the signature of the Town Clerk on the authority of the Council or three months' salary in lieu thereof or by three months' written notice given by the officer to the Town Clerk or three months' salary in lieu thereof."

The Court accordingly directs that Mr. Okumu should be paid three months' salary in lieu of notice as stipulated above.

The Court would like to state that the Respondents have not declared an issue on the question of recovering Sh. 13,000 damages from Mr. Okumu and further they had not resorted to clause 29 of the Terms and Conditions of Service, neither did they make any request to the Court in regard thereto. The Court therefore finds that it should not concern itself with this question.

The Court accordingly directs that Mr. Okumu's dues under the Court award should be paid forthwith.
