1 The Amalgamated Union of Kenya Metal Workers shall hereinaster be referred to as the Claimants and National Panel Beaters shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents

2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on 1st and 17th February and 22nd March, 1978, and in addition to relying on their written and verbal submissions called the following witnesses to give evidence on oath —

Award

3 The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 21st June, 1977, duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 17th October, along with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner

The Respondents are a small family business engaged in the business of panel beating and other related jobs. The business was started in 1969 by a father and his son with one foreman and since then they have gradually increased the number in their employment From the long historical background which was given by the Claimants on the question of their recognition by the Respondents it seems that the Claimants approached the Respondents for recognition soon after they started business From then on until the recognition agreement which was signed on 19th July, 1977, but implemented in December of the same year is a long history of repeated representations of the Claimants for recognition and constant refusal on one ground or the other by the Respondents to do so

The Claimants have also alleged that about eight of the Respondents' employees were sacked on various dates due to their union membership

With this background the Court was required to look into the alleged wrongful termination of Harry Shikuku's services by the Respondents Shikuku was employed by them in April, 1972, as a trainee panel beater and after in service training he was appointed on the permanent establishment on 1st July, 1975

As part of the historical build-up of the recognition dispute the Court was told that in October, 1976, the Respondents' employees had once again joined the Claimants and on 28th of the same month they sent a fresh demand for recognition to them after the workers had elected Shikuku as their shopsteward

Shikuku's services were terminated on 5th November, 1976, and in his letter of termination he was informed that in view of his gross insubordination on that day his services were terminated as from 6th November, 1976 The Respondents informed him that they had forwarded to the District Labour Officer, Industrial Area, a sum of Sh 642 50 made up as

In the same letter in the end Shikuku was reminded that this was the third instant of gross insubordination on his part within a short period

The dispute regarding Shikuku's termination of services was the subject matter of investigation by the Ministry of Labour and the investigator's findings and recommendation were as follows ---

"Findings—

From the submissions and investigations carried out by the investigator it is established that the employer did not favour trade union membership of his employees

Shikuku, on the other hand, developed an attitude that as long as he belonged to the union he could afford to disobey lawful orders. It has also been established that Shikuku insulted his employer before other employees. This was confirmed by other employees when interviewed. Shikuku himself admitted this fact. It has not been substantively proved that Shikuku was dismissed for joining the union. It has, however, been proved that he disobeyed an order which it was his duty to obey and that he used abusive language against his employer.

Recommendation-

In these circumstances I consider the termination of services of Shikuku to have been justified"

Fred Omido, the Secretary-General of the Claimants, stated in Court while appearing on behalf of the Claimants that the investigator had made certain errors in the findings because although Omido was present throughout the investigation he could quite confidently state that Shikuku did not at any time admit having insulted his employer Omido said that the state ment by the Investigator that Shikuku himself admitted this fact was therefore not true

The Claimants have submitted that Shikuku had been victimized for his trade union activities and denied that Shikuku was either insubordinate or had insulted his employer as alleged by them. They asked for his reinstatement and salary for all the months that Shikiku had been out of employment along with compensation for the wrongful dismissal

The Respondents on the other hand denied that this was a case of victimization of a trade union official and stated that Shikuku had been given a spec fic job to do on 4th November, 1976, which he should have finished in an hour but Shikuku did not even stait working on it till about 11 am 5th Nov ember, 1976 When their foreman asked him the reason for his non-performance of the job given to him it is alleged that Shikuku told him and one of the proprietors that they should do the job themselves as he would not do it and added that he could not be ordered around otherwise he would report them to the union It is further alleged that he was very discourteous to his superior officers and used abusive language to them

The Respondents denied that they were at any time aware that Shikuku was a shopsteward but in any case maintained that a refusal to obey a lawful order by an employee amounts to gross misconduct giving the employer the right to summarily dismiss the employee

The parties called their witnesses as stated hereinabove

The Court finds it most odd that in the notice of termination issued to Shikuku by the Respondents they have not mentioned that he had also abused his superiors whereas their two wit nesses in Court stated that Shikuku had used very insulting language towards one of the partners in the business. If that was true then suicely the Respondents would have taken care of including this particular misbehaviour on the part of Shikuku in the letter of termination. Not only this, but if true, it would have entitled them to summarily dismiss him. Instead, the Respondents offered him one month's salary in lieu of notice along with his other benefits. This omission in the letter of termination certainly shakes the credibility of the Respondents' witnesses.

On the other hand the Court is inclined to believe that Shikuku did linger on the job that he was given to do on 4th November, 1976, but for this sort of behaviour he deserved a letter of warning rather than termination of employment

The Respondents' two witnesses did not particularly impiess the Court It appeared that they were not entirely truthful in certain respects particularly on the question of the abusive language that Shikuku is alleged to have used on 5th November, 1976 One of these witnesses was the Respondents' foreman and the other, a very young man, who at that time had been in employment for a couple of months only

In view of the strained relationship between the Claimants and the Respondents which started about nine years ago the Count cannot entirely overlook the fact that possibly Shikuku's termination was prompted by his trade union activities. The Court believes that Shikuku was elected a shop-teward in October, 1976, and a fresh recognition demand was presented to the Respondents. On 5th November, Shikuku was served with a letter of termination. The Court does not find this to be a coincident and has come to the conclusion that Shikuku's services were indeed terminated because of his trade union activities.

The fact, however, remains that Shikuku although being a shopsteward did not perform his job as an efficient worker in that he did not finish a job given to him on 4th November until he was confronted by the management on 5th November at about 11 am, even up to that time he had not made satisfactory progress in his assignment. The Court would like to emphasize that first and foremost the shopstewards are employees and they are expected to set a good standard of work per formance for their fellow workers. The shopstewards should not consider themselves to be beyond discipline and they should at all times behave properly in the course of their duties as employees.

Keeping all the aforesaid points in view the Court having found that Shikuku suffered a wrongful dismissal has decided to award his reinstatement only and the Court does not award him any compensation for the wrongful dismissal that he suffered because he also contributed to a large extent to the situation in which he finds himself

The Court appreciates the fact that the small businessmen who operate small scale industries play an important and vital role in the economy of the country as for one thing they generate employment but this does not mean that they should stay shy of the trade unions. The recognition of a trade union by such small scale enterprises would not lead to their liquidation or other difficulties as feared by them as both of them the employer and the trade union have to play their own clearly defined role. In the event of deadlock all the necessary machinery exists to settle the disputes

The Court accordingly awards that Shikuku should be reinstated to his job with the Respondents with effect from 1st May, 1978, but he should be paid no compensation Further a first waining should be entered in his employment record for having deliberately delayed completing a job that had been given to him


