THE Commissioner of Lands on behalf of the President of the Republic of Kenya gives notice that the plots at Likuyani Township, Soy Settlement Scheme, as described in the Schedule hereto are available for alienation and applications are invited for the direct grants of the individual plots

- 2 A plan of the plots may be seen at the Public Map Office situated in Lands Department building, City Square, Nairobi, or at the office of the District Commissioner or at the office of the Clerk to Council, Kakamega, or may be obtained from Public Map Office, PO Box 30089, Nairobi, on payment of Sh 4
- 3 Applications should be submitted to the Commissioner of Lands, through the District Commissioner, Kakamega

Applications must be on prescribed forms which are available from Lands Department and at the office of the District Commissioner, Kakamega, or Clerk to County Council's Office

- 4 Applications must be sent so as to reach the District Commissioner, Kakamega, not later than 12 noon on Tuesday, 30th May, 1978
- 5 Applications must not be sent direct to the Commissioner of Lands
- 6 Applicants must enclose with their applications cash of Sh 400 as deposit which will be dealt with as follows
 - (a) If the applicant is offered and takes up and pays for the plot within a period of seven days as required in para graph five below, the deposit will be credited to him
 - (b) If the application is unsuccessful, the applicant's deposit will be returned to him
 - (c) If the application is successful and the applicant fails to take up and pay for the plot offered to him within a period of 14 days as required in paragraph five of the General Conditions, the Commissioner of Lands may declare the deposit forfeited and the applicant shall have no further claim thereto

General Conditions

- 1 The ordinary conditions applicable to township lease of this nature except as varied hereby, shall apply to this lease
- 2 The lease will be made under the provisions of the Registered Land Act (Cap 300 of the Laws of Kenya)
- 3 The lease will be issued in the name of the allottee as stated in the letter of application and the names must be in full
- 4 The term of the lease will be for 99 years from the first day of the month following the notification of the approval of the allocation of the plot

Special Conditions

- 1 No buildings shall be erected on the land nor shall additions or external alterations be made to any buildings otherwise than in conformity with plans and specification previously approved in writing by the Commissioner of Lands and the Local Authority The Commissioner of Lands shall not give his approval unless he is satisfied that the proposals are such as to develop the land adequately and satisfactorily
- 2 The lessee shall within six calendar months of the actual registration of the lease submit in triplicate to the Local Authority and the Commissioner of Lands, plans including block plans showing the position of the buildings and a system of drainage for disposing of sewage, surface and sullage, water, drawings and specification of the buildings, the lessee proposes to erect on the land, and shall within 24 months of the actual registration of the lease complete the erection of such buildings and the construction of the drainage system in conformity with plans, drawings, elevations and specifications as amended (if such be the case) by the Commissioner of Lands

Provided that, notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in or implied by the Government Lands Act if default shall be made on the performance or observance of any of the requirements of this condition it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Lands or any person authorized by him on behalf of the President to re-enter into and upon the land or any part thereof, in the name of the whole and thereupon the term hereby created shall cease but without prejudice to any right of action or remedy of the President or the Commissioner of Lands in respect of any antecedent breach of any condition herein contained

- 3 The lessee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and conditions all buildings at any time erected on the land
- 4 Should the lessee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that he/she/they is/are unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid the Commissioner of Lands shall (at the lessee's expense) accept a surrender of land comprised herein

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given (1) within 12 months of the commencement of the term, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the lessee 50 per centum of the stand premium paid in respect of the land or (2) at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period, the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the lessee 25 per centum of the said stand premium. In the event of notice being given after the expiration of the said building period no refund shall be made.

- 5 The land and the buildings shall only be used for shops and residence (excluding the sale of petrol or motor oils)
- 6 The buildings shall not cover more than 50 per centum of the area of the land or such lesser area as may be laid down by the Local Authority in its by-laws
 - 7 The lessee shall not subdivide the land
- 8 The lessee shall not sell, transfer, sublet, charge or part with the possession of the land or any part thereof, except with the prior consent in writing of the Commissioner of Lands No application for such consent (except in respect of a loan required for building purposes) will be considered until Special Condition No 2 has been performed
- 9 The lessee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such sum as the Commissioner may estimate to be the proportionate cost of constructing all roads and drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land and shall on completion of such construction and ascertainment of the actual proportionate cost either pay within seven days of demand or be refunded the amount by which the actual proportionate cost exceeds or falls short of the amount paid as aforesaid
- 10 The lessee shall from time to time pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such proportion of the cost of maintaining all roads and drains serving or adjoining the land as the Commissioner may assess
- 11 The lessee shall pay such rates, taxes, charges, duties, assessments or outgoings of whatever description as may be imposed, charged or assessed by any Government or Local Authority upon the land or the buildings erected including any contribution or other sum paid by the President in lieu thereof
- 12 The President or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purposes shall have the right to enter upon the land and lay down and have access to water mains, service pipes and drains, telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains of all description, whether overhead or underground and the lessee shall not erect any buildings in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing alignments of main, service pipes, telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains

Termination of Hashamali Mohamedali's services without just and reasonable cause

- 1 The Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Freight Forwarders Kenya Ltd shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents
- 2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on 30th March and 18th and 19th April, 1978, and in addition to relying on their written and verbal submissions called the following witnesses to give evidence on oath —

Claimants — Hashamalı Mohamedalı

Respondents - Amirali K Somji

Award

3 The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 7th October, 1977, duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 6th February, 1978, along with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner

Hashamali is a retired employee of the Mombasa Municipal Council where he had worked in the revenue section as the officer-in-charge. He is getting a pension of Sh. 500 pm and at the date of his retirement on 28th February, 1974, was 56 years old.

He told the Court that since then he had been a freelance accountant and from the various assignments he got he earned every month between Sh 1,000 to Sh 1,500

He started working for the Respondents on 22nd September, 1975 He claims that in the first place he was interviewed by the manager of Diamond Trust, Mombasa, who had told him that the Respondents wanted a fully experienced man on permanent basis and they wanted a person who would not leave the country As he is a Kenya citizen he was found to be acceptable and although he had asked for a monthly salary of Sh 3,000 he started working for Sh 2,750 on permanent basis He was asked to work, according to him, under the chief accountant

The Respondents, however, maintain that he was introduced to them by S K Anjarwalla, a Mombasa advocate The Respondents produced an affidavit dated 17th April, 1978, sworn by Anjarwalla stating that Hashamali was well known to him and at his request he had found him a job with the Respondent which, however, was a temporary job to last six to seven months Further that Hashamali had accepted the ofter of this job

The Respondents' managing director, Somji, while giving evidence stated that both the manager of the Diamond Trust and Anjaiwalla had recommended Hashamali to him for a job

On 30th July, 1976, as Hashamali wanted to go to UK to attend his son's wedding he applied for leave He received a letter from the personnel manager stating that his 21 days' leave had been approved with effect from 9th August, 1976 to 1st September, 1976, and that he should report back for duty on 2nd September, 1976 This letter is dated 30th July, 1976

On 31st July, 1976, he was served with a letter of termination which lead

"Further to our conversation on 30th July, 1976, this is to confirm that your services are terminated from 1st September, 1976, and that you will be paid a month's salary in lieu of this notice

You may proceed on 21 days leave from 9th August, 1976

We thank you for your services and wish you the very best in the future"

Supprisingly on 5th August, 1976, the Respondents' personnel manager wrote to Hashamali stating that he was not an employee of the Respondents since the personnel manager did not have any records and he was therefore unable to grant him any leave since he is not an employee of the Respondents

The dispute regarding Hashamali's termination without just and reasonable cause was investigated by the Ministry of Labour and the Chief Industrial Relations Officer suggested to the parties that he should be paid one month's salary in compensation for the loss of his job in addition to any other terminal benefits to which he may be entitled

The Claimants have submitted that Hashamali was a permanent employee of the Respondents and was not oftered a temporary job for performing specific duties. They alleged that he had been victimized because he had decided to join them whereas all other Asian employees of the Respondents had been intimidated by the Respondents with the result that although they had all first wanted to join the Claimants later on they decided against it with the exception of Hashamali

The Claimants selt that since their member had been wrongfully dismissed as there was no reason for the Respondents to terminate his services he should get full compensation as laid down under the Trade Disputes Act

The Respondents on the other hand maintained that Hasham ali was offered a temporary job lasting between 6 to 8 months during which he was required to carry out special duties which were the reconciliation of disbursements of the Respondents, Reynolds & Co, Kenya General Agencies and Wafco Ltd as all these firms had merged together to form the Respondents' company Hashamali was required to sort out the mess in the reconciliation of accounts of all these companies

The Respondents stated that when Hashamali had applied for leave they had decided that as he had nearly finished the work for which he was engaged on temporary basis there was no need for him to continue in employment and they had decided to terminate his services. The managing director while giving evidence stated that he had decided to give Hashamali four weeks' notice of termination plus three weeks' leave so that in these seven weeks he could find alternative employment.

The Court must say that it finds the Respondents' behaviour in this dispute, to say the least, most odd. To begin with during the Ministry of Labour's investigations they had maintained that Hashamali had never been their employee but was a personal employee of the managing director, Somji and that he had been given a specific job in connection with Somji's old and now dissolved company, Kenya General Agencies. The Respondents therefore did not have any responsibility for him. Then when Hashamali applied for leave the Respondents' personnel manager approved his leave and the next day on 31st July, 1976, the managing director of the Respondents had proceeded to termin ate his service with the Respondents. To make matters worse for them on 5th August, 1976, the personnel manager informed Hashamali that as he was not an employee of the Respondents he could not be granted any leave

All these contradictions certainly do not help the Respondents in this dispute and it appears that either they are completely confused over this matter or they are deliberately trying to get out of their responsibilities and obligations towards Hashamali

The Court is satisfied that whatever the reason that prompted the Respondents to employ Hashamali, the fact remains that they employed him on a monthly basis at a salary of Sh 2,750 pm and that he was not a personal employee of the Respondents' managing director, Somji

The Court has further come to the conclusion that had Hashamali not applied for leave his services probably would not have been terminated so soon

Having made these findings the Court notes that Hashamali had not been issued with a letter of appointment although he was promised that he would get one in due course and S K Anjarwalli's affidavit stating that Somja had told him that Hashamali could be employed on a temporary job to last six to seven months

The Court, however, is of the view that even if Hashamali was taken on temporarily he was subsequently treated to all intents and purposes as a regular employee and his duties as allocated by the financial controller were as follows—

- '(a) Reconciling the freight and miscellaneous disbursement accounts
- (b) Any special duty
- (c) Standby for any other duty as directed by the accountant "

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court finds that Hashamali has indeed suffered a wronglal dismissal but as the Claimants have dropped their demand for his reinstatement the Court has to decide what compensation, if any, to award Hashamali The Claimants are demanding a sum of Sh 33,000 being Hashamali's 12 months salary Keeping all the circumstances of this dispute in mind the Court awards that Hashamali should be paid a sum of Sh 5,500 being two maths' salary by way of compensation for the wrongful dismissal that he has suffered in addition to the month's notice and three weeks' leave which was offered to him by the Respondents
