VACANCIES

APPLICATIONS are invited for the posts shown below. Completed application forms should reach the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, P O Box 30095, Nairobi, on or before 2nd June, 1978.

Civil servant applicants should complete Forms PSC 2A in triplicate (submitting the original through their Heads of Departments) and Cards PSC 25 and 25A. Other applicants should complete Forms PSC 2 in triplicate and Cards PSC 24 and 24A.

These documents are obtainable either from the Secretary or from other Government offices.

Originals of certificates and similar documents should not be submitted unless specifically asked for.

NOTE

Incremental credits will be granted to successful candidates who are not civil servants for approved previous experience provided the maximum salary is not exceeded. They will also be eligible for benefits and privileges enjoyed by civil servants in accordance with the existing Government Regulations.

Vacancies in the Ministry of Labour

Assistant Registrar (One Post) (No 164/78)

Salary scale—£1,170 to £1,554 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants must be gazetted fingerprint experts with at least eight years' experience in fingerprint work, two of which must be at Job Group "G". Ability to conduct correspondence, control staff and work independently is essential. Candidates must have a thorough knowledge of the Registration of Persons and National Social Security Fund Acts. Experience in court procedures will be in advantage.

Survey Assistant Grade III (Two Posts) (Re-advertisement)

Salary scale—£864 to £1,212 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants must be in possession of at least the East African School Certificate with good credits in Mathematics, Geography and English, or equivalent pre-Technicians Certificate with appropriate credits, they must have had three years' satisfactory service in surveying and must have finally been awarded the National Ordinary Technicians Diploma by the Kenya Polytechnic or possess other equivalent qualifications.

Duties will be related to project survey works, including supervision and taking charge of an independent survey team.

Senior Data Machine Operator (One Post) (No 166/78)

Salary scale—£642 to £900 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants must have wide and varied experience of all kinds of data preparation equipment, at least two years acquired on advanced data preparation equipment of the Key Edit type. They should be able to display knowledge of the functioning and capabilities of such equipment. Operators with an average speed of less than 8,000 key depressions per hour need not apply. Before qualifying for final selection applicants will be required to obtain a suitable standard in a Key Punching Proficiency test to be conducted by the Fund. Preference will be given to applicants of good character who will be able to assume supervisory responsibilities as necessary.

Salary scale—£642 to £900 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants must be civil servants of East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent with a minimum of five years satisfactory and appropriate clerical experience within the clerical cadre and must be serving in the grade of Higher Clerical Officer. Ability to control junior staff and conduct correspondence will be an advantage and a pass in the Proficiency Examinations for Clerical Officers is mandatory.

Senior Survey Assistant (Two Posts) (No 168/78)

Applicants must be civil servants of either East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent. They should have passed Survey of Kenya Occupational Test Grade I in Land Survey or hold a Technician Diploma from the Kenya Polytechnic. Applicants must in addition, have at least ten years of post qualification experience of which three years must have been at Survey Assistant I (Job Group "J") level.

VACANCIES—PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION—(Contd.)

The successful candidates will be responsible for the supervision and technical guidance of junior technicians in topographical, geodetic and cadastral surveys in the field. They will also be required to carry out random field checks of various tasks performed by survey technicians. Ability to handle staff is essential.

Cartographer Grade II (Three Posts) (No 169/78)

Salary scale—£1,170 to £1,554 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants must be Cartographers Grade III who have passed the Survey of Kenya Occupational Test Grade I in Cartography or equivalent grade. They must have a sound knowledge of cartographic work which includes procedure, materials, compilation, supervision and instruction of junior staff. They should in addition, be conversant with preparation of all types of maps and plans produced by the Survey of Kenya.

Preference will be given to the applicants with a working knowledge in photogrammetry.

Land Registrar Grade III (Three Posts) (No 170/78)

Salary scale—£864 to £1,212 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants must be civil servants preferably of School Certificate Standard of Education or its equivalent with not less than six years practical experience in Land Registration work in a District Land Registry. A thorough knowledge of laws relating to land registration and procedure is essential. Ability in handling correspondence and dealing with members of the public is essential. The successful candidates will be required to undertake the duties of Land Registrar III and to assist other Government Departments especially the Provincial Administration on land registration matters.

*Vacancies in the Ministry of Power and Communications**Assistant Chief Security Officer (Two Posts) (No 171/78)*

Salary scale—£1,446 to £1,938 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants should have police training with experience or experience of special investigations with Customs and Excise Department. The police applicants should not be below the rank of Chief Inspector and in case of the serving Airport Security Officers, the applicants should have served for at least two years as Security Officers, Job Group "H", in the Aerodromes Department.

Sound knowledge of Kiswahili, English and ability to co-operate with members of the public and press are essential. Preference will be given to applicants with knowledge of an extra foreign language.

- (f) Checking Airport Tax Stamps and controlling them

The successful candidates must be prepared to work on shift, and will be required to obtain the Adult First Aid Certificate of the St John's Ambulance Association within one year of appointment.

Executive Officer Grade II (One Post) (No 172/78)

Salary scale—£1,170 to £1,554 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT

Applicants must be civil servants preferably of School Certificate Standard of Education or its equivalent. They must have proven administrative ability and considerable experience in dealing with staff problems, maintenance of staff records and a thorough knowledge of Government Regulations and procedures.

Applicants must have served in the grade of Executive Assistants for a minimum period of three years.

The successful candidate will be appointed as the Officer-in-Charge of Wilson Airport, reporting the running of airport activities to the Director of Aerodromes. He will be responsible for the collection of landing and parking fees and co-ordination of activities pertaining to Security, Customs, Immigration, etc. He will also generally ensure proper cleanliness as well as smooth running of the airport.

The period for lodging notice of opposition may be extended by the Registrar as he thinks fit and upon such terms as he may direct. Any request for such extension should be made to the Registrar so as to reach him before the expiry of the period allowed

Formal opposition should not be lodged until after reasonable notice has been given by letter to the applicant for registration so as to afford him any opportunity of withdrawing his application before the expense of preparing the notice of opposition is incurred. Failure to give such notice will be taken into account in considering any application by an opponent for an order for costs if the opposition is uncontested by the applicant
