THE Court announced its award in the above dispute on 28th March, 1978 The last two paragraphs of the Court award read as tollows —

'It is a fact that in the past when several collective agree ments had been negotiated and which had since expired the Claimants and the Respondents have had two salary scales only for section Heads and for Clerical Staff. The latest of such collective agreements is effective from 1st April, 1977 for a period of two years. In these circumstances the Court finds that it would not be desirable to introduce another salary scale for the Check Clerks during the lifetime of the current collective agreement The Court however, finds that the Check Clerks are entitled to higher remuneration than the Clerks and awards that with effect from 1st April, 1978 all the Check Clerks should get Sh 175 pm over and above their monthly remuneration. The parties will be at liberty if they so wish to work out a new scale for the Check Clerks on the expiry of the current collective agreement

In making this award the Court has paid particular attent ion to the Respondents' plea that this could be a dangerous precedent but the Court having set out reasons for its award is of the view that if a category of workers are performing higher duties than the category in which they are placed then they are entitled to be paid higher"

Both the parties have come forward with then own inter pietation of the Court award

The Respondents maintain that the Sh 175 which has been awarded to the Check Clerks by the Court is a special allowance to be paid to them separately and is not to be incorporated into their salaries

The Claimants on the other hand are of the opinion that the Sh 175 awarded by the Court should be incorporated into the salaries of the Check Clerks and should not be paid sepa rately is an allowance as interpreted by the Respondents

After an exchange of correspondence between the parties the Respondents made an application to the Court for an interpretation of the Court award and the parties were heard by the Court on 12th May when they made their submissions in support of their respective interpretations

The Court cannot accept the Respondents' interpretation of the Court award and finds that the Claimants' interpretation is the proper interpretation of the Court award

The Court would like to point out that it found that the Check Clerks were entitled to higher remuneration than the Clerks and awarded that with effect from 1st April, 1978 all the Check Clerks should get Sh 175 pm over and above their monthly remuneration. The Court then proceeded to add the words "the parties will be at liberty if they so wish to work out a new scale for the Check Clerks on the expiry of the current collective agreement'

The Court would like to clarify that the Sh 175 awarded to the Check Clerks is to be part of their salary and it will be up to the parties either to continue their salary on this basis or to work out a new scale as mentioned by the Court in its award on the expiry of the current collective agreement. The Court has left the parties with two options of either paying the Check Clerks salaries higher than the other Clerks by a certain amount which to begin with the Court has assessed at Sh 175 pm or. if they so wish, to work out a new salary scale for the Check Clerks when the current collective agreement expires

After careful consideration of the parties' submissions and tor the foregoing reasons the Court confirms that the Claimants' interpretation of the Court award is correct
