1 No buildings shall be erected on the land nor shall additions or external alterations be made to any buildings otherwise than in conformity with plans and specifications previously approved in writing by the Commissioner of Lands and Local Authority. The proposals are such as to develop the land adequately and satisfactorily

2 The grantee shall within 6 calendar months of the actual registration of the grant submit in triplicate to the Local Authority and the Commissioner of Lands plans (including block plans showing the positions of the building and a system of drainage for disposing of sewage surface and sullage water) drawings and specifications of the buildings the grantee proposes to erect on the land and shall within 24 months of the actual registration of the grant complete the erection of such buildings and the construction of the drainage system in conformity with plans

Issue in dispute

Dismissal of Mrs Naomi Mararo

1 The Domestic and Hotel Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Social Service League shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents

2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 10th day of May, 1978, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The Respondents also called P K Mwai to give evidence during the hearing

AWARD

3 The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 28th November, 1977, duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 8th March, 1978, along with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner

Mrs Naomi Mararo started working for the Respondents on 1st December, 1961, as a cleaner. Her services were summarily terminated on 10th September, 1976

Her dismissal was prompted by the fact that she was absent from duty on 6th September, 1976, and it is alleged that she failed to explain to the management the reason for her absence and that she had not even bothered to explain to the Respondents' Labour Officer why she had remained absent. This alleged absence without any justification coupled with the previous three warnings that had been issued to her in 1976 led to her dismissal

The Claimants stated that the previous warnings were not proper because they had not been served on their member and further they have not been copied to them as required under the collective agreement. The Court, however, is satisfied that not only the three warnings in 1976 were issued to her but several other prior to that year were also issued. She, however, refused to accept these warning letters and the Court is inclined to believe the Respondents when they say that their employees had a tendency not to accept any letters from the management as they suspected that they were warning letters. This may well be due to the fact that their messenger at the hospital is a shopsteward representing the Claimants!!

During the hearing the Claimants produced a medical certificate dated 6th September, 1976, issued by a doctor, I Gatumbi, and it reads that Naomi Mararo had a serious illness on 6th September and had treatment at the doctor's surgery

P K Mwai, the Respondents' Labour Officer, stated in his evidence that Mrs Mararo was absent on 6th September and did not explain her absence the next day until she was called later in the afternoon at 3 p.m. She then told him that she was sick and he asked her for the sick sheet but she could not produce any document. He added that if she had produced the medical certificate before 10th September he would have advised the management not to dismiss her

In the letter of 7th September written by Mr Mwai to Mrs Mararo he has not recorded anywhere that he asked her to produce a medical certificate and that she failed to do so

The Court cannot understand why Mr Mwai forgot to mention this extremely important point in his letter because in that letter after referring to the relevant clause re-warning procedure and referring to the three previous warnings issued to her in 1976 he wrote —

"Your fourth offence was committed on 6th September, 1976, when you remained absent without permission or reasonable cause. You also failed to explain to the management the reason why you remained absent. You did not even appear before the Labour Officer to explain him why you remained absent. I am therefore left with no alternative but to recommend your summary dismissal."

The Court is inclined to believe that he did not ask her to produce a medical certificate. Had he done so the medical certificate which was produced in Court during the hearing

would have been produced to him even though it may not have been issued on the day in question. The fact remains that Mr Gatumbi has certified that this lady had a serious illness on 6th September and had treatment at his surgery. So she was absent with justification on that day

The Respondents were not quite happy with the medical certificate but in the absence of any evidence to the contrary the Court has no alternative but to accept it

The Respondents produced in Court a circular which was issued by their Executive Officer to all nursing and domestic staff in which he advised them that no sick sheets from outside doctors or nursing homes will be entertained by the management unless the sick sheets are from consultants only and this again will be at the discretion of the management. In the parties' collective agreement which was in force at the time it is provided in clause under medical treatment and sick leave that the Respondents shall provide free out patient medical treatment as available at any of their hospitals to an employee and his/her family, but under the heading of sick leave it is stated that an employee shall not be entitled to sick leave with pay unless he/she produces to the League a certificate of incapacity covering the period of sick leave claimed, signed by a registered medical practitioner in charge of a dispensary or medical aid centre or by a person authorized by him in writing and acting on his behalf. The circular issued by the Respondents' Executive Officer therefore was contrary to the provisions of the collective agreement and is not binding on the employees. If the Respondents wish to change the relevant clause in the collective agreement then they should amend it in consultation with the Claimants

The Court would now like to refer to an alleged agreement which the Respondents' Labour Officer made with a senior representative of the Claimants, Z Kitari, on 30th September, 1976, under which Mrs Mararo was to be reinstated to her duties without loss of benefits. Mr Mwai in his evidence denied having made any such agreement but unfortunately again there seems to be no denial of this alleged agreement in writing by Mr Mwai

The Court has carefully considered the Respondents' submissions that they had properly applied clause 14 (c) of the collective agreement because Mrs Mararo was absent from work on 6th September without a valid reason which entitled them to summarily terminate her services. The Court, however, cannot accept that Mrs Mararo was absent without a valid reason. The Court has come to the conclusion that she was absent because she was not well and this fact is supported by the doctor's certificate

The result of the Court's finding is that Mrs Mararo did not commit the fourth offence as alleged by the Respondents and she has therefore suffered a wrongful dismissal

The Court has very carefully considered the question of her reinforcement but in view of her previous record leading to the various warning letters issued to her which she had refused to accept the Court finds that she does not deserve a reinstatement. The Court has therefore decided to award her compensation only for the wrongful dismissal that she has suffered

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court finds that Mrs Mararo suffered a wrongful dismissal and awards her five months' pay by way of compensation for the wrongful dismissal that she has suffered. The Court would like to add that in addition to this compensation she will also be entitled to gratuity under clause 18 of the collective agreement as she has served the Respondents for 15 years

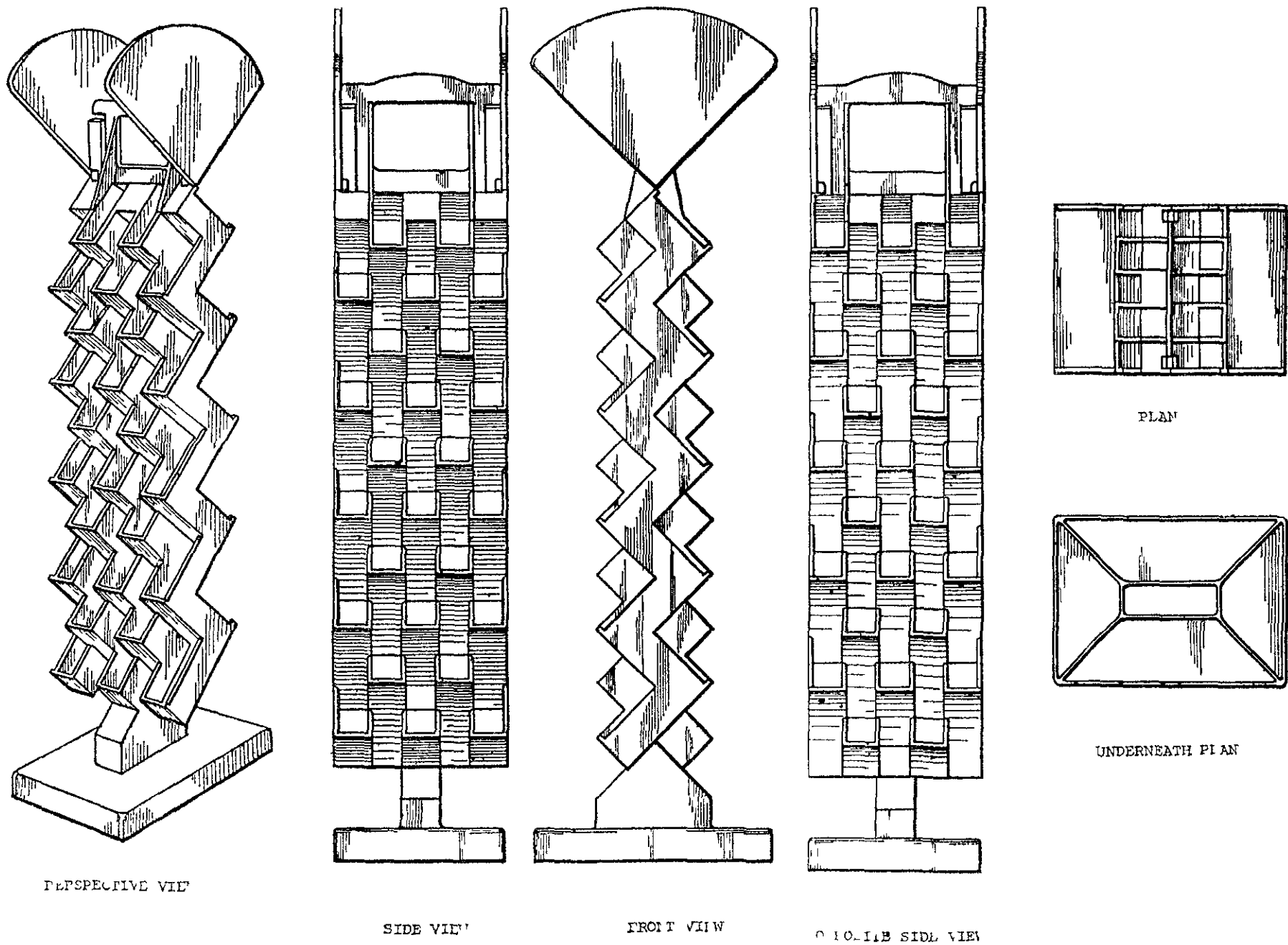

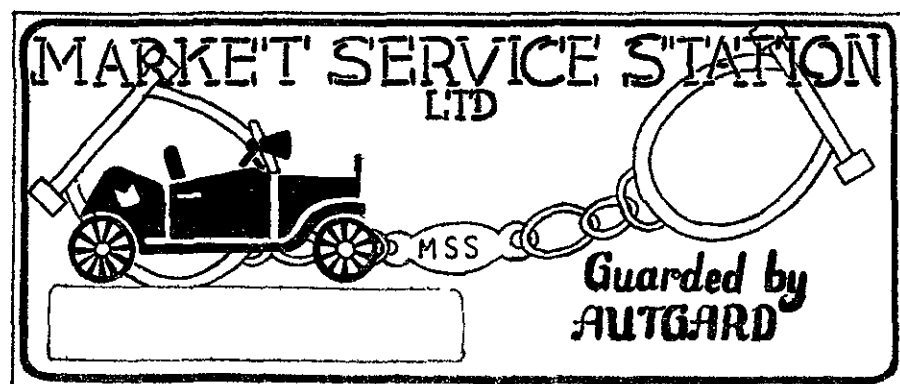

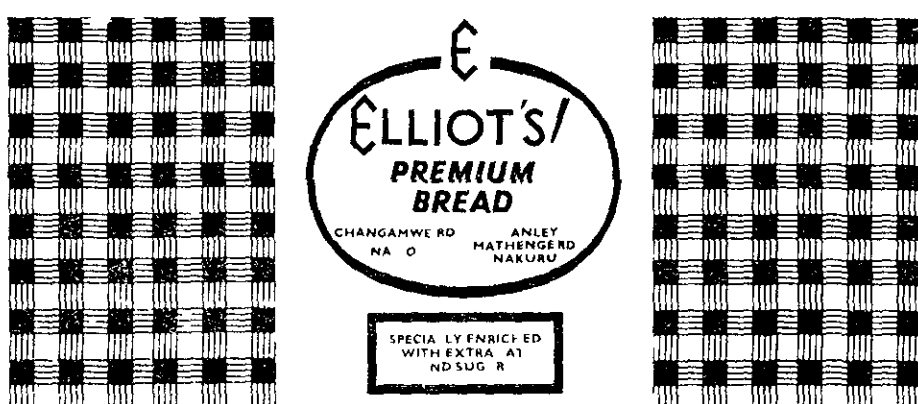
