ORDER UNDER SECTION 36—COLLECTION OF TRADE UNION DUES

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Trade Disputes Act, the Minister for Labour hereby orders every employer who employs not less than five members of the Mombasa Dockworkers' Union to—

(a) deduct every month—

(i) the sum of seven shillings from the wages of workers in manual grades including checkers, and

(ii) the sum of ten shillings from the wages of clerks, supervisors and foremen of any grade,

in respect of trade union dues from the wages of each of his employees who is a member of that trade union,

(d) notify in writing that trade union and that organization before the end of each month of the total amount of any payments made to the accounts of that trade union and of that organization in that month, and

(e) notify in writing the Registrar of Trade Unions before the end of each month of the total amount of any payments made into the accounts of that trade union and of that organization in that month

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36 (2) of the said Act, the order made under Gazette Notice No 2789 of 4th August, 1967 is hereby revoked

- (d) notify in writing that trade union and that organization before the end of each month of the total amount of any payments made into the account of that trade union and that organization in that month, and
- (e) notify in writing the Registrar of Trade Unions before the end of each month of the total amount of any payments made into the accounts of that trade union and that organization in that month

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36 (2) of the said Act, the order notified by Gazette Notice No 2143 of 24th June, 1975 is hereby revoked

1 The Kenya Chemical Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Didy Pharmaceutical Ltd shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents

2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 14th day of June, 1978, and relied on their written and verbal submissions

AWARD

3 The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 30th December, 1977, duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 20th April, 1978, along with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner

The Respondents are a small family concern and formerly used to trade under the name of D D Patel & Co Ltd, which name they changed in February, 1975, to the present one

The Claimants and D D Patel & Co Ltd had appeared before the Industrial Court in Cause No 31 of 1974 on most of the issues which are in dispute now before the Court In its award in that cause number the Court awarded the Respondents' employees a wage increase of 15 per cent with effect from 1st August, 1974, and a further wage increase of another 15 per cent from 1st August, 1975

There is no dispute that the employees have not received any wage increase since then

The Claimants demanded a revision of the collective agreement and submitted their proposals to the Respondents on 2nd March, 1976, some five months before it was due to expire Unfortunately the matter dragged on so much that the parties

signed the Notification of Dispute Form "A" on 30th December, 1977 The Court finds this most surprising but from the documentary evidence that was produced before the Court, the Court is satisfied that the Respondents had adopted a very rigid approach during negotiations and the Claimants did their best in order to resolve the matter out of Court

At the final deadlock in December, 1977, the Claimants had demanded 15 per cent wage increase for the first year and a similar increase for the second year with the Respondents offering them half of that amount, i.e. 7.5 per cent for each year

The Respondents have pleaded a decline in their profits from 65 per cent in 1974 to 31 per cent in 1977 and an additional increase in the importation costs of their raw materials The Respondents have also suffered the loss of Uganda and Tanzania markets

The Claimants have very strongly put forward that the Respondents are amongst the lowest paying employers in their industry and that all the difficulties that they had put forward were applicable to all other employers too There was no reason therefore why the Respondents should get away by paying such low wages to their very long serving employees who they claimed had been working for the Respondents for not less than 15 years with some of them having served more than 24 years

The Court was informed that the Respondents' five employees are paid as follows —

The Court has very carefully gone into the Claimants' demand on the issue of job grading but has come to the conclusion that such an exercise is not warranted in the Respondents' undertaking for the time being The circumstances have not changed since the last Court award In fact they are static and since the Court rejected this demand at that time the Court feels that it should be rejected again

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court has decided to make the following award on the various issues —

1 *Wages and job grading*—As pointed out above the Court rejects the demand for a job grading exercise and on the issue of wages the Court awards that the Respondents' employees should get a wage increase of 8 per cent with effect from 1st August, 1976, and that the resultant wage should thereafter be increased by 15 per cent from 1st August, 1977, and the resultant wage should thereafter go up again by 15 per cent with effect from 1st August, 1978

2 *Annual paid leave*—The Court feels that the present entitlement should continue without any change

3 *Leave allowance*—The Court awards that the workers should be paid a leave allowance of Sh 60 when they proceed on annual leave

4 *Sick leave*—The Court proposes no change on the present entitlement which should continue

5 *Safari allowance*—The Court awards a safari allowance of Sh 50 as indicated below —

Supper	7 50
Night stop	30 00

6 *Gratuity/service benefits*—The Court rejects the Claimants' demand for various of the present entitlement under this item and rules that the existing provisions should continue

7 *Effective date and duration*—The issue of effective date has been given very anxious thought by the Court and the Court has come to the conclusion that since the workers in Kenya have been told to follow the laid down machinery for settling their industrial disputes and they are expected to be patient and not to resort to strike action it would under these circumstances be most unfair to impose any wage standstill on them. If the Court does not award the effective date to be 1st August, 1976, then the workers would be forced to suffer a wage standstill and the Court is not prepared to do that for the foregoing reasons and because of the prevalent inflationary trends

The Court therefore, while fully appreciating that this will involve a very long backdating which would ordinarily offend principles of natural justice has come to the conclusion that in this dispute the effective date should be 1st August, 1976

The Court further awards taking into consideration the long delay before the dispute was referred to the Court for final adjudication that it should continue in force for a period of three years from 1st August, 1976

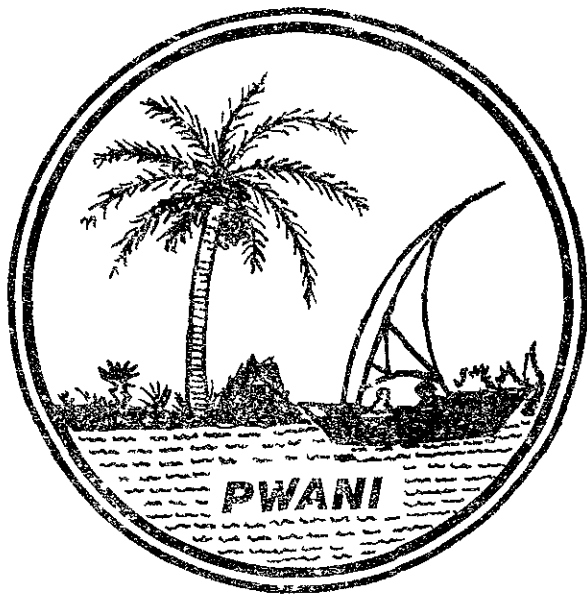
