Dismissal of Joseph Ojiem

'1 The Amalgamated Union of Kenya Metal Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Hughes Ltd shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents

2 The parties were heard in Nairobi on 30th and 31st May and 16th June, 1978, and in addition to relying on their written and verbal submissions called the following witnesses to give evidence during the hearing -

Claimants -Joseph Ojiem

Respondents --- Mrs Lucy J Loveday

Award

3 The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 28th February, 1978, duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 3rd April along with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner

Joseph Ojiem started working for the Respondents in August, 1970, as a stores clerk and was dismissed on 5th November, 1976, because it is alleged he left his place of work without permission At the time of his dismissal he was earning Sh 1,285 per month and was stationed at Nakuru branch of the Respondents

Ojiem was the Nairobi Branch Chairman of the Claimants at the time and was also the Second National Vice-Chairman of his union In addition to these two offices he also held a much higher position in the labour movement as he was also COTU (K) Nairobi area Chairman

In February, 1976, he was sent to Nanyuki on relief duty but was told later that he was there on permanent transfer and in June, 1976, he was transferred from Nanyuki to Nakuru The Claimants have played a lot on these transfers and alleged that they were meant to keep Ojiem away from Nairobi so that he would not be able to perform his duties as their Nairobi Branch Chairman satisfactorily and would be forced either to resign or be ousted by the workers The Claimants put forward a very strong submission that the Respondents' Personnel Manager was in league with the then claimants' Deputy General Secretary and was doing all this at his behest against Opem

The Respondents stated that these were normal transfers but from the details of the jobs which Ojiem was required to do at these places the Court is inclined to believe that there was more to it than meets the eye To begin with the post of a cashier was created specially for him at Nanyuki when he was told that he was to stay there permanently Then he was transferred to Nakuru in June, 1976, just four months after his posting to Nanyuki and was given the duties of a costing clerk

From the documentary evidence which was produced during the hearing the Court has little doubt that there was a serious a coincidence that while there was a power struggle going on in the trade union the Respondents started Opem's transfers at the same time It may well be that the Respondents were caught unwittingly in this struggle of trade union leadership as probably they were not aware of what steps were being taken to remove Open from his office of the Chairman of the Nairobi branch The Court, however, understands and appreciates the Claimants' very serious allegations against the Respondents having conspired with the Deputy General Secretary in making it extremely difficult for Onem to discharge his functions as the Nairobi Branch Chairman They cannot be blamed for drawing this inference from the facts that were within their knowledge but which may or may not have been known to the Respondents As far as the Claimants were concerned they made very lengthy submission on this aspect of the dispute but the Court would not like to go any further than what has been stated heremabove on this particular point The Court would now like to deal with the immediate incident which led to the sacking of Ojiem

Ojiem told the Court that on 25th October, 1976, he had asked for permission which was given for him to attend a meeting in Nairobi and when he appeared at the meeting which was concerned with the election of shop-stewards his rivals were very surprised and angered He suspected that they then complained to the Respondents' Personnel Manager, who in turn had "fired" the Nakuru Administrative Officer, Mrs Loveday, for letting Ojiem come to Nairobi She is alleged to have told him that he will not be given permission in future "as the Personnel Manager had fired her"

The Claimants were to hold a Central Council meeting on 6th November, during which a date for a special conference of their union was to be fixed In view of what had happened between Mrs Loveday and Ojiem in anticipation of leave being refused had made arrangements for the General Secretary to obtain permission for him from the head office As a result the General Secretary had contacted the Managing Director of the Respondents in Nairobi and it is alleged that the Managing Director promised that Ojiem would be released in time for the meeting

On 4th December, the General Storetary wrote a letter to the Respondents' Managing Director on the subject of Ojiem's dismissal and contained the following three paragraphs —

"You will remember that I telephoned and spoke to you on Wednesday, 3rd November, 1976, when I asked you to give Ojiem permission to attend a meeting of the Central Council of the union on 6th November, 1976 I told you also that Ojiem was the Second National Vice-Chairman and that he would be attending the meeting as such You promised that Ojiem would be released in time for the meeting These facts you confirmed during my meeting with you on the afternoon of 10th November, 1976

On 4th November, 1976, Mrs Ojiem telephoned me and said that her husband had telephoned her and asked her to get in touch with me and inquire whether I had obtained permission for him to attend the meeting the following day She said that her husband had been trying to contact me on telephone without success I then informed her that I had spoken to you and you had agreed to release Ojiem for the meeting This information was then conveyed to Ojiem by his wife and subsequently Ojiem arrived in Nairobi on Friday, in readiness for the meeting at 9 a m, the following day Ojiem attended the meeting However, on his return to Nakuru and upon reporting for duty on Monday, 8th November, 1976, he was summoned to the Manager's office and

struggle going on between a group led by the then Deputy General Secretary and Ojiem and his supporters for union leadership The Respondents, however, all along maintained that they were not interested in refuting the allegations that they had at the request of the Claimants' then Deputy General Secretary acted in the manner alleged against Ojiem because for one thing it was not relevant to the dispute and secondly it was not true in any case The Respondents maintained that they were not interested in any manner in the power struggle in the Claimants' ranks

The Court was given copies of letters which were not challenged which clearly show that the Deputy General Secretary at the time was showing more than normal interest about Ojiem and his transfers. In fact attempts were made also at the Registrar of Trade Unions office to have the name of Ojiem removed as the Chairman of the Nairobi branch but without success

The Court while not accepting all the way the Claimants' forceful submission that the Respondents' Industrial Relations/ Personnel Officer had conspired with the Deputy Secretary-General of the Claimants finds that it is somewhat more than told that his services had been terminated for leaving his place of work without permission

This was a complete surprise to us as it indicated that although you assured me over the phone that Ojiem would be given permission to enable him to attend the meeting you had a second thought and refused to grant the permission and you decided not to let me know about your change of attitude so that I could convey this change to Ojiem "

The Court was not informed of any reply from the Managing Director to this letter

The Court is satisfied that arrangements were made in Nairobi between the General Secretary and the Respondents' Managing Director for Operatory to be given permission to come to Nairobi on 5th November and this was conveyed to Operatory has wife but what transpired between the Respondents' head office and the Nakuru branch is rather obscure. The fact, however, remains that the General Secretary was not told that the Respondents have had second thoughts and that Opern would not be given permission to leave Nakuru

No.

In Nakuru Ojiem claims that he had told the Administrative Officer that permission had been obtained for him to attend the meeting from the Managing Director in Nairobi and she had asked him to finish any pending work that he had before proceeding to Nairobi He said he finished the work and then told the Administrative Officer that he was going to Nairobi and she said "okay" He reported back on 8th November and was summoned to the Manager's office where to his surprise the Administrative Officer denied having given him any permission to go to Nairobi He said he was tricked as the Respondents wanted a reason to dismiss him

Mrs Loveday, the Administrative Officer, on the other hand stated that Ojiem came to her on 4th November for leave application for two days which she rejected as she had nobody to replace him as two other employees were not available, one attending a refresher course and the other, Evans, was to go to the Nairobi meeting She added that Ojiem also had some work to finish

This witness stated that she saw Ojiem report for duty as usual in the morning on 5th November and she saw him hanging around in the showroom and told him to go back and do his work Later she passed his office and found that he was not there and on making inquiries was told that he had taken his bag and had gone She had then telephoned the Industrial Relations/Personnel Manager and told him what had happened The Personnel Manager did not tell her that Ojiem had been granted any leave

There are certain aspects of Mrs Loveday's evidence which are rather unsatisfactory and affect her evidence The Court is not prepared to believe that she did not know what Ojiem's position was in the trade union. The Court finds that she knew perfectly well that he was an active trade union official This fitness admitted at a Local Negotiating Committee meeting held on 28th January, 1977, that in October, 1976, she had permitted Ouem to go to Nairobi and she got "firing" from the Personnel/ Industrial Relations Officer for having given Ojiem permission to attend a shopstewards meeting in Nairobi during working hours In Court she professed not to have known anything about Opem's trade union activities She also said in Court that she did not know why Ojiem wanted leave for two days yet in the minutes of the Local Negotiating Committee it is recorded that Mrs Loveday stated that Open had approached her for permission to attend a union meeting at Nairobi which was to be held on 6th November, 1976 These contradictions certainly iffect her credibility as a witness

The Court must further examine the attitude of the Claimants' then representatives at the JIC meetings held on 19th January and 1st March, 1977, and the Local Negotiating Committee meeting held on 28th January, 1977 It is quite clear going through the minutes of these meetings that the Claimants' representatives were in a hurry to capitulate on the issue of Oper's dismissal and to treat the matter as closed This sort of attitude on the part of the trade union officials is almost unheard of in such disputes The least the Court can say as far as the Respondents are concerned is that they must have indeed been pleasantly surprised on this attitude on the part of the Claimants' representatives At the meeting of 19th January of the JIC, Harding, the Managing Director, is reported to have said that while he agreed with what the General Secretary had said in his letter it was also true that when he found out another person had been given leave of absence from the Nakuru branch, Operative of the operation of the second sec sent to the union on the same day cancelling Ojiem's leave The cancellation of Ojiem's leave was accepted by either Wamalwa or Sakwa, because Omido could not be contacted The Court notes that it is alleged that Messrs Wamalwa and Sakwa were the two persons engaged in the power struggle against Ojiem

Sakwa echoed this, as he could not support the suggestion of deferring the discussion

The Chairman said that this difference on the part of the union had put the other members of the **JIC** in an embar rassing situation However, he saw no reason to refuse the suggestion to defer the discussion on this "

The Local Negotiating Committee meeting which was held on 28th January, 1977, was held in most unusual circumstances and the Court is satisfied that the union representatives did not put forward the point of view of Oµem sufficiently strong for the reason best known to them Further Oµem was not even asked to come and give his version at this meeting of what had transpired on the day in question

The Court has very carefully considered the evidence of Ojiem and Mrs Loveday as to what happened in the morning of 5th November, 1976, and the Court has come to the conclusion that Ojiem's evidence appears to be more accurate, truthful and consistent with the whole background to the dispute

The Court finds it proved that the General Secretary of the Claimants obtained permission for Ojiem to attend the union meeting on 5th November, 1976, and that Ojiem was informed from Nairobi by the trade union through his wife that leave for him had been approved The Court further finds that Open informed Mrs Loveday of what had happened and that he had been given permission to proceed to Nairobi on that day The fact that Harding withdrew his permission and conveyed the withdrawal either to Wamalwa or Sakwa does not have a serious effect on the matter because this withdrawal for some reason or the other was not conveyed to Omido or to Ojiem or even to the Nakuru management who should have been clearly told that although Harding had originally approved Ojiem's leave he had subsequently decided to cancel it and the management should then have told Oper this very clearly Instead the Nakuru management professed to have had no knowledge of what was going on in Nairobi If this had been done and Open had then proceeded to Nairobi then he would have done so at his own risk

Under the aforesaid circumstances and after a careful consideration of all the submissions the Court has come to the conclusion that Ojiem had been a victim of circumstances not of his own making and that he has indeed suffered a wrongful dismissal

The Claimants have asked for a deterrent award against the Respondents for having sided with one faction of the union against the other but the Court is not inclined to give in to their request on those lines for the simple reason that since 11th May, 1977, Ojiem started earning a sum of Sh 2,050 p m after being given an important job by the Claimants in their own organization and since February this year his salary has gone up to Sh 2,800

The Court would like to add that the investigation carried out by the Ministry of Labour also came to the conclusion that Ojiem had been wrongfully dismissed and it was recommended that he should be paid in addition to his other benefits ten months' salary as part of compensation for wrongful dismissal

The Court, however, cannot accept that ten months' salary by way of compensation is warranted in this dispute because Onem is already in an employment at a salary which is more than what he was earning when his services were terminated

Then there is another cryptic paragraph in the minutes of the JIC meeting held on 1st March, 1977, on this matter where Omido is alleged to have said the following —

"Omido said that in view of what Harding had said at the last meeting that there was something he (Harding) would like to say in the presence of Wamalwa, and in view of the need to know why L N C was held when it had been agreed to by-pass it, he would like the present discussion deferred until Harding was back from his leave and able to attend another J I C

Wamalwa said that he wanted it recorded that 'he was not i party to the matter being deferred' After careful consideration of all the submission the Court awards that Ojiem should be paid six months' salary by way of compensation for the wrongful dismissal that he has suffered at the hands of the Respondents




