3 The Notification of Dispute Form A' dated 20th March, 1978 duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 25th April along with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner

The Respondents are a garment manufacturing concern and joined the Mass Production Group—Clothing and Shirt Industry on 23rd March, 1976 Prior to that they were bound by the relevant statutory order regarding wages and terms and conditions of their employees

It is not disputed that from 23rd March 1976 the collective agreement between the Claimants and the Mass Production Group was applicable to the Respondents' employees

One of the Respondents' employees, Paul Ogola, had been screed with two letters of warning dated 16th February, 1976 and 4th March, 1976. The Court notes that when giving evidence Paul Ogola admitted having received these two warning letters. The first warning was in respect of his absence from work without permission and the second warning stated that he had performed his work negligently and carelessly and had not sought the supervisor's guidance and help as a result of which he ruined one whole piece of a garment which was rejected. He was also alleged to have been rude and insulting towards his supervisor.

At the end of March 1976 the Respondents prepared the wages of their employees and as far as Paul Ogola was concerned the Respondents worked out his wages at Sh 321. The Managing Director of the Respondents stated in evidence that he had instructed his pay clerks not to pay Ogola the minimum wage of Sh 376 but to pay what he had actually earned Paul Ogola naturally refused to accept his wages with the result that the shopsteward and the Federation of Kenya Employers and the Claimants' Nairobi branch were then involved in this dispute. It was agreed that the matter of Ogola's wages for the month of March would be discussed at a meeting of 13th April 1976 at 11 a m.

On 13th April at 8 30 in the morning Mr Ogola went to the pay clerk and started discussing the payment of his March wages and while he was talking another Director of the Respondents, K K Shah, came to the factory and asked them what they were discussing Mr Ogola demanded from him immediate payment of his March wages there and then and when K K Shah asked him to come to the office Mr Ogola started shouting loudly and it is alleged that he used abusive language and repeated that he must have his pay on the spot On hearing this all the employees numbering about 90 left their work and came and surrounded the three of them The Respondents' watchman on seeing this came up but was pushed and beaten by another employee Mr Francis with the result

that the watchman ran from there to the outer gate. The Respondents then summoned the police who asked them to fetch them from the Industrial Area Police Station which the Respondents did

The police picked up Paul Ogola and Mr Francis and as they were taking them to the Police Station all the other employees left their work and wanted to follow them Despite the Police Officer telling them that they were not needed, they all followed them to the Industrial Area Police Station The police charged eight of them, all of whom are involved in this dispute, for creating disturbance in a manner likely to cause a breach of the peace and Mr Francis was also charged for having assaulted the watchman thereby causing him actual bodily harm They were, however, acquitted and discharged in the criminal Court

The Claimants have brought this dispute on behalf of all these employees claiming full pay for the days when they were on suspension between 13th April to 21st July, 1976 pending the outcome of the criminal cases and in respect of Paul Ogola they are isking for his reinstatement without loss of any wages on the ground that all their members had been penalized for having done nothing

The Respondents on the other hand maintain that after the aforesaid incident they had a meeting with the Claimants under the Chairmanship of R Kombo, the Chief Executive Officer of F K E where it was agreed that Mr Ogola be dismissed and the other seven employees be suspended without pay pending the outcome of their criminal cases. In view of this and the behaviour of the persons concerned in the above incident the Respondents stated that they were justified in not paying them anything for the days they were on suspension and were not prepared to take back Paul Ogola as he had caused all the trouble

The Court has carefully considered the various aspects of this dispute and has come to the conclusion that the Respondents were clearly at fault in making arbitrary deductions from the wages of Paul Ogola for the month of March It is not proper for an employer to start punishing a worker by deducting the worker's wages. The proper thing for the employer to do is to resort to the warning procedure laid down in the collective agreement. As a matter of fact the Respondents were acting on the right lines in that they had already given two warnings to Mr. Ogola but instead of exhausting the warning procedure they resorted to a deduction of wages. So to begin with Mr. Ogola did have a grievance against them at the end of March 1976.

The Respondents when confronted by Mr Ogola's refusal to accept his reduced wages for the month of March then decided to consult the Federation of Kenya Employers and the Claimants in order to determine this question. A meeting was arranged to take place on 13th April at 11 am. The shopsteward and Mr Ogola knew about this meeting The Court therefore must find that Mi Ogola's behaviour in the morning of 13th April when he demanded the payment of his proper wages by 830 in the morning before the meeting could take place was not consistent with what had been arranged between the Respondents, the FKE and the Claimants The Court appreciates the plight of a worker who has been without any wages for 13 days and has a family and children to support but Mr Ogola had only to wait another three or four hours before the matter of his March wages was sorted out, but instead he decided to be rude and insulting to his employers

Even then the matter would not have been so bad had Mr Ogola's behaviour not prompted all Respondents' employees to come and surround them which resulted in one of them assaulting the watchman. The Court has no doubt that this incident had all the trappings of a very ugly situation. The Court must point out that the behaviour of the other Respondents' employees was unwarranted because if they had continued with their work and had left the matter to be sorted out between Mr Ogola, the Respondents, the FKE and the Claimants in all probability they would not have had to face a criminal case and suffer suspension from their work and Mr Ogola would not have lost his employment

The Court must stress that one of the things that an employer can expect after recognizing a trade union is predictable behaviour on the part of the workers under certain situations. The workers must realize that all their grievances have got to be settled through the laid down machinery by the Government which is working with such a great success and they are not expected to take matters in their own hands and create situations which can easily lead to serious consequences for all the parties concerned

The Court having found that the employers erred in arbitrarily deducting Mr Ogola's wages for the month of March and

having found that subsequently Mr Ogola misbehaved on 13th April and keeping in view the proved fact that Mr Ogola's work performance had deteriorated as he had received two warnings which he admitted, the Court has come to the conclusion that Paul Ogola's reinstatement should be rejected. The Court has, however, decided that his summary dismissal should be reduced to normal termination and the Court further directs that he should be paid his wages and benefits under a normal termination in accordance with the collective agreement between the Claimants and the Mass Production Group

As far as the remaining workers are concerned with the exception of Francis Ashiringwa, the Court awards that they should be paid half the salary for the period they were on ses pension as the Court has come to the conclusion that they were clearly at fault in leaving their work and behaving in a

manner which prompted the authorities to charge them in a criminal Court

As far as Francis Ashiringwa is conceined the Court finds that the fact that he had as aulted the watchman is a justifiable leason to treat him to have been on suspension without pay





- D41 (1) Communications for the Kenva Gazette should reach the Government Printer not later than 12 noon, on Tuesday of the week that publication is desired. The Government Printer will not publish communications received after that hour until the next subsequent issue of the Gazette.
- (2) It will facilitate work at the Press if Permanent Secretaries will forward Gazette notices to the Government Printer when ready

It is emphasized that these notes are for guidance only, but it is requested that persons submitting copy for publication first satisfy themselves that such copy is complete in every respect

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
