##### 4 ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

## ATHI RIVER TOWN—INDUSTRIAL PLOTS FOR ALIENATION

THE Commissioner of Lands invites applications for the plots described in the Schedule herebelow, which are available for direct alienation.

2 The plan of the plots may be inspected at the Public Map Office, situated in the Lands Department Building, City Square, Nairobi or purchased therefrom at Sh 4 per copy, post free.

3 Applications should be submitted to the Commissioner of Lands, through the Clerk/Treasurer, Athi River Urban Council, stating the plot required, but not direct to the Commissioner.

4 Applications must be submitted so as to reach the Clerk not later than noon on 16th October, 1978.

5 Applicants must enclose a bank cheque for Sh 1,000 as deposit which will be dealt with as follows —

(a) Credited to a successful applicant

(b) Refunded to an unsuccessful applicant

(c) Forfeited if a successful applicant fails to accept formally an offer of a plot made to him within the stipulated time, and the applicant who fails to take such offer within the prescribed time, shall have no further claim thereto.

6 Each application should state the estimated amount to be spent on the project, and a banker's letter or other financial evidence be submitted to show that the applicant is capable of developing the plot.

*General Conditions*

1 The ordinary conditions applicable to urban grants of this nature except as varied hereby shall apply to this grant.

2 The grant will be made under the provisions of the Government Lands Act (Cap 280 of the Laws of Kenya) and title will be issued under the Registration of Titles Act (Cap 281).

3 The grant will be issued in the name of the allottee as stated in the letter of application.

4 The term of the grant will be for 99 years from the first day of the month following notification of the approval of the grant.

5 Each allottee of a plot shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands within 30 days of notification that his application has been approved, the initial estimated amount for the construction of roads and drains to serve the plot, the assessed stand premium and proportion of annual rent, together with the legal fees payable in respect of the preparation and registration of the grant (Sh 225) and the stamp duty in respect of the grant (approximately 2 per cent of the stand premium and annual rent). In default of payment within the specified time the Commissioner of Lands may cancel the allocation and the applicant shall have no further claim to the grant of the plot.

*Special Conditions*

1 No buildings shall be erected on the land nor shall additions or external alterations be made to any buildings otherwise than in conformity with plans and specifications previously approved in writing by the Commissioner of Lands and the Local Authority. The Commissioner shall not give his approval unless he is satisfied that the proposals are such as to develop the land adequately and satisfactorily.

2 The grantee shall within six months of the commencement of the term submit in triplicate to the Local Authority and the Commissioner of Lands plans (including block plans showing the positions of the buildings and a system of drainage for the disposal of sewage, surface and sullage water), drawings, elevations and specifications of the buildings the grantee proposes to erect on the land and shall within 24 months of the commencement of the term complete the erection of such buildings and the construction of the drainage system in conformity with such plans, drawings, elevations and specifications as amended (if such be the case) by the Commissioner.

Provided that notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained or implied by the Government Lands Act if default shall be made in the performance or observance of any of the requirements of this condition it shall be lawful for the Commissioner of Lands or any person authorized by him on behalf of the President to re-enter into and upon the land or any part thereof in the name of the whole and thereupon the term hereby created shall cease but without prejudice to any right of action or remedy of the President or the Commissioner in respect of any antecedent breach of any condition herein contained.

3 The grantee shall maintain in good and substantial repair and condition all buildings at any time erected on the land.

4 Should the grantee give notice in writing to the Commissioner of Lands that he/she/they/is/are unable to complete the buildings within the period aforesaid the Commissioner of Lands

shall (at the grantee's expense) accept a surrender of the land comprised herein.

Provided further that if such notice as aforesaid shall be given within 12 months of the commencement of the term the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee 50 per centum of the stand premium paid in respect of the land, or 2 at any subsequent time prior to the expiration of the said building period the Commissioner of Lands shall refund to the grantee 25 per centum of the said stand premium. In the event of notice being given after the expiration of the said building period no refund shall be made.

5 The land and the buildings shall only be used for (inoffensive) industrial purposes.

6 The buildings shall not cover more than 90 per centum of the area of the land or such lesser area of the land as may be laid down by the Local Authority in its By-laws.

7 The land shall not be used for the purpose of any trade or business which the Commissioner of Lands considers to be dangerous or offensive.

8 The grantee shall not subdivide the land without prior consent in writing of the Commissioner of Lands.

9 The grantee shall not sell, transfer, sublet, charge or part with the possession of the land or any part thereof or any buildings thereon except with the prior consent in writing of the Commissioner of Lands. No application for such consent (except of a loan required for building purposes) will be considered until Special Condition No 2 has been performed.

10 The grantee shall pay to the Commissioner of Lands on demand such sum as the Commissioner may estimate to be the proportionate cost of constructing, maintaining, repairing, reconstructing to a higher standard, or any other improvement of all roads, drains and sewers serving or adjoining the land and shall on completion of such construction and the ascertainment of the actual proportionate cost, either pay (within one month of demand) or be refunded the amount paid as aforesaid.

11 The grantee shall pay such rates, taxes, charges, duties, assessments or outgoings of whatever description as may be imposed, charged or assessed by any Government or Local Authority upon the land or the buildings erected thereon, including any contribution or other sum paid by the President in lieu thereof.

12 The President or such person or authority as may be appointed for the purpose shall have the right to enter upon the land and lay and have access to water mains, service pipes and drains, telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains of all descriptions whether overhead or underground, and the grantee shall not erect any buildings in such a way as to cover or interfere with any existing alignments of main or service pipes or telephone or telegraph wires and electric mains.

This application is before the Court as section 9A (6) of the

be subject to the approval of the Industrial Court

The three employees concerned are a painter, a carpenter  
and a welder and their details of service are given below —

**Mohamed Kipara**—Painter, Mr Kipara aged 38 years was  
employed by the Claimants on 15th March, 1959 at a monthly  
wage of Sh 200 p.m Today his wages are Sh 742 p.m

**Jamleck M Karani**—Carpenter Mr Karani now aged 28 years  
was employed by the Claimants on 8th March 1973 at a  
monthly wage of Sh 443.50 His wages today are Sh 742  
p.m

**Abdullahi A Jaka**—Welder Mr Jaka aged 33 years was  
employed by the Claimants on 4th March, 1968 at a monthly  
wage of Sh 340 His current wage is Sh 742 p.m

The Claimants' main ground for declaring them redundant is  
that since they expect to be out of business after about 16  
months or at the most two years when the new Nyali Bridge  
now under construction would be ready, they find that they  
are not able to provide work for them

M Kipara, the painter, according to the Claimants, was  
employed for repainting of houses and road signs in Nyali  
Estate but since the estate had been sold to the Government  
the work for which he was engaged no longer existed The  
Claimants added that they had continued to create work to  
keep this employee partially occupied but this could no longer  
be done in view of the fact that the Bridge will no longer be  
required in two years' time

J Karani, the carpenter, is one of the three carpenters

As far as A Jaka, the welder, is concerned, he is also one  
of the three welders employed by the Claimants The Claim-  
ants pointed out that he was employed at a time when the life  
of the Bridge was estimated to be another ten to 20 years His  
job was to reinforce and strengthen the various structures of  
the Bridge on a regular basis as part of a maintenance exercise  
The Claimants added that now that the life of the Bridge is  
considered to be approximately two years there is not enough  
work for three welders

Finally the Claimants stated that for some time now they had  
continued to invest work of no significant value to them just  
to keep these three employees employed and during this period  
an estimated amount of Sh 23,256 had been paid by way of  
wages to them

The Respondents have strongly opposed this application and  
have asked the Court not to approve the intended redundancies  
of the three workers involved because the Nyali Bridge con-  
tinued to operate as before and if anything the traffic crossing  
the Bridge each day had increased at an alarming rate which  
meant added revenue for the Claimants

The Respondents submitted that there was no reorganization  
involved to warrant these redundancies and the Claimants should  
wait until the new bridge was completed and started operation  
That would be the time to embark on the redundancies

The Court notes that the parties having realized the writing  
on the wall as far as the future of the Nyali Bridge was con-  
cerned had reached an agreement at their own level and paid  
redundancy pay to all their employees for their services rendered  
to the Claimants up to 30th June, 1977 This was done to  
enable the workers to start looking for alternative means of  
living and help them adjust their lives accordingly

The Court is satisfied that all the workers know that their  
employment with the Claimants will come to an end within  
16 months to two years but the Court fails to understand the  
logic of the Claimants which they put forward in support of  
this application

The Court cannot visualize that the maintenance of the Bridge  
for its remaining short life is not going to be up to the past  
standard As far as the painter is concerned the Claimants  
stated that they did not want the Bridge to be repainted and  
that the work for the other two had been reduced The Claim-  
ants, however, did not produce any supporting evidence either  
documentary or through the evidence of any witness to prove  
the reasons for the intended redundancies

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court  
finds no reason which could persuade it to allow the three  
workers involved in this dispute to be declared redundant There  
is no reason why these three workers should not continue in  
employment along with the rest of the 91 employees until the  
new Bridge is ready and the future of the present Nyali Bridge  
is decided upon in about two years time

The Court rejects the Claimants' application to declare  
redundant the three workers involved in this dispute
