- (b) Business Calculations ($\frac{1}{2}$ hour)

Part II — (Any one subject only related to officer's duties) (Optional)

- (a) Accounts (1½ hours) or
- (b) Stores ($1\frac{1}{2}$ hours) or
- (c) Personnel (1½ hours) or
- (d) General Office Services (14 hours)

4 ELIGIBILITY TO ENTER

The examination will be open to civil servants only, who are serving as Clerical, Higher Clerical or Senior Clerical Officers, and who have completed at least four (4) years continuous service in the cadre. However, Clerical Officers who were appointed at a starting salary of K£435 per annum and above by virtue of their educational qualification or approved experience may enter the examination after completion of two (2) years' service Junior Clerical Officers, Copy Typist, etc., are not eligible to enter the Proficiency Examination for Clerical Officers

5 CONDITIONS FOR OBTAINING A PASS

Every candidate will be required to enter for and pass in all the three main papers (see paragraph 3 above) at one and the same sitting No partial passes will be allowed

6 Examination Registration Fees

Every candidate entering this examination will be required to pay a Registration Fee of K Sh 10 only for the whole examination. The Registration fee, which will be non-refundable, will be payable to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, in either Crossed Inland and Money Order, Postal Order or cash Personal cheques will not be accepted

7 Entry Forms

The candidates must complete and submit the examination entry forms in triplicate as set out at "Appendix" to this Circular Letter, copies of which can be reproduced and cyclostyled by each Ministry/Department, as required, and the completed entry forms, duly certified correct by the candidates' Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Department and accompanied by the Registration fees of K Sh 10 per candidate, should be submitted to the Secretary, Public Service Commission of Kenya, National Housing Corporation House, Aga Khan Walk, off Harambee Avenue, PO Box 30095, Nairobi, so as to reach him on or before Thursday, 19th October, 1978 Late entries and/or incomplete, uncertified or wrongly completed entry forms and entries not accompanied by the correct Registration fees, will automatically be rejected

8 Examination Centres

The examination will be held in all Provinces at Mombasa Nyeri, Embu, Nairobi, Nakuiu, Kakamega, Kisumu and Garissa centres The actual examination venue at each Provincial Centre will be notified to the candidates in due course

9 GENERAL CONDUCT OF THE EXAMINATION

Candidates will not be allowed to consult any books, files notes, magazines, etc., during the examination. Any infringement of this rule will result in immediate disqualification from the whole examination, and may also lead to disciplinary action being taken against the offenders. Examination papers and stationery will be supplied by this office to the Provincial Education Officers who will be in charge of the Examination Centres, and who will be responsible for the distribution of the papers and stationery to the candidates at the ricenties. Appointment of invigilators, airangement of the examination venues and return to this office of the candidates' answer scripts when the examination is concluded as directed by the Public Service Commission of Kenya, will be the responsibility of the Provincial Education Officers

- 1 Nyalı Ltd shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Kenya Engineering Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents
- 2 The parties were heard in Nanobi on the 6th day of September, 1978 and relied on their written and verbal submissions

AWARD

3 The Nonfication of Dispute Form "A" dated 14th April, 1978 duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 26th June along with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner

The Claimants have applied to the Court for permission to declare their above named three employees redundant

This application is before the Court as section 9A (6) of the Trade Disputes Act requires that all cases of redundancy shall be subject to the approval of the Industrial Court

The three employees concurred are a painter, a carpenter and a welder and their details of service are given below —

Mohamed Kipara—Painter, Mi Kipara aged 38 years was employed by the Claimants on 15th March, 1959 at a monthly wage of Sh 200 pm Today his wages are Sh 742 pm

Jam'eck M Kaicm—Carpenter Mr Karani now aged 28 years was employed by the Claimants on 8th March 1973 at a monthly wage of Sh 443 50 His wages today are Sh 742 pm

Abdillahi A Jaka—Welder M1 Jaka aged 33 years was employed by the Claimants on 4th March, 1968 at a monthly wage of Sh 340 His current wage is Sh 742 p m

The Claimants' main ground for declaing them red indant is that since they expect to be out of our ness after about 10 months or at the most two years when the new Nyah Bridge now under construction would be ready, they find that they are not able to provide work for them

- M Kipara, the painter, according to the Claimants, was employed for repainting of houses and road signs in Nyali Estate but since the estate had been sold to the Government the work for which he was engaged no longer existed. The Claimants added that they had continued to create work to keep thus employee partially occupied but this could no longer be done in view of the fact that the Bridge will no longer be required in two years' time
- J Karani, the carpenter, is one of the three carpenters employed by the Claimants. The Claimants find that due to change from timber steel in the maintenance of the Bridge the use of tumber had been reduced by nearly half and they could not keep three carpenters gainfully employed

As far as A Jaka, the welder, is concerned, he is also one of the three welders employed by the Claimants. The Claimants pointed out that he was employed at a time when the life of the Bridge was estimated to be another ten to 20 years. His job was to reinforce and strengthen the various structures of the Bridge on a regular basis as part of a maintenance exercise. The Claimants added that now that the life of the Bridge is considered to be approximately two years there is not enough work for three welders.

Finally the Claimants stated that for om time now they had continued to invent work of no significant value to them just to keep these three employees employed and during this period an estimated amount of Sh 23,256 had been paid by way of wages to them

The Respondents have strongly opposed this application and have asked the Court not to approve the intended redundancies of the three workers involved because the Nyali Bridge continued to operate as before and if anything the traffic crossing the Bridge each day had increased at an all imag rate which meanst added revenue for the Claimants

The Respondents submitted that there we some reorganization involved to warrant these redundancies and the Claimants should wait until the new bridge was completed and started operation. That would be the time to embark on the redundancies

The Court notes that the parties having realized the writing on the wall as far as the future of the Ny li Bridge was concerned had reached an agreement at their own level and pand redundancy pay to all their employees for their services rendered to the Claimants up to 30th June, 1977. This was done to enable the workers to start looking for alternative means of living and help them adjust their lives accordingly.

The Court is satisfied that all the workers know that the remployment with the Claimants will come to an end within 16 months to two years but the Court fails to understand the logic of the Claimants which they pit forward in support of this application

The Court cannot visualize that the maintenance of the Bridge for its remaining short life is not going to be up to the past standard. As far as the painter is conceined the Claimants stated that they did not want the Bridge to be repainted and that the work for the other two had been reduced. The Claimants, however, did not produce any supporting evidence either documentary or through the evidence of any witness to pove the reasons for the intended redundances.

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court finds no reason which could persuad, it to allow the three workers involved in this dispute to be declared red indant. There is no reason why these three workers should not continue in employment along with the rest of the 91 employee until the new Bridge is ready and the future of the present Nyali Bridge is decided upon in about two years time.

The Court rejects the Claimants' application to declare redundant the three workers involved in this dispute
