Senior Clinical Officer (One Post) (No. 569/78)

Applicants must be civil servants with a minimum of nine years' experience and must have shown ability and merit in the performance of their duties over a period of at least three years' in Job Group "J". CAUSE No. 42 of 1978

Parties:—

Kenya Quarry and Mine Workers' Union
and

Miritini Building Products Ltd.

Issues in dispute:—

- (a) Wage increment.
- (b) Housing allowance.

1. The Kenya Quarry and Mine Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Miritini Building Products Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 23rd day of October, 1978, and relied on their written and verbal submissions. The Respondents called S. J. Ngaracu to give evidence during the hearing.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 23rd February, 1978, duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 23rd August together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The Respondents took over the business formerly carried on by Miritini Brick and Tile Works Ltd. in 1974. When they took over the business it was not operating and the Respondents stated that they had to start it from scratch.

The Respondents are a small private company and three of the directors are of one family and a fourth director is Ngaracu.

The parties entered into a collective agreement in April, 1977, effective from 1st January, 1975, for a period of three years. In this agreement they agreed that the basic minimum wages for all employees should be paid in accordance with the Regulation of Wages (General) Order L.N. 69 of 1975. They had also agreed to carry out a review of wages and housing during February, 1976, but since they signed the collective agreement in April, 1977, this particular clause was not complied with.

The Claimants are now seeking wage increases and house allowance for their members. They have naturally based their case on the cost of living increases which they claim entitles them to a 43 per cent increase, 23 per cent of which they would like to be awarded as the wage increase and 20 per cent by way of house allowance.

The Respondents on the other hand have very vigorously pleaded that their business is in a very poor state because of a big drop in the demand for their product, i.e. bricks which has come about due to loss of markets in Sudan and Arusha after the break-up of the Community and further because in all the modern buildings bricks are not being used. The only market they had was when bricks had to be at the moment they were supplying their product to the New Coast General Hospital under construction. They were able to operate because of a big bank loan as in the previous four years they had sustained losses as set out below:—

The Court is satisfied that the Respondents are indeed going through a difficult period and the Court notes that the Claimants are aware of this sad state of affairs. The Court cannot overlook the fact that unless the Respondents succeed in diversification of their business which they are planning to do by turning to block making activities the jobs of their employees are in jeopardy.

This dispute affects between 22 to 51 employees as depending on the requirements of the orders the Respondents take on casual employees.

The Court appreciates that the workers have indeed suffered due to increase in the cost of living. As from 1st January, 1975, the Nairobi wage earners' cost of living up to the end of 1977 rose by 55 per cent. Under the Guidelines they would be entitled to 36.7 per cent increase along with the increase in the Gross Domestic Product for 1977 which is estimated at 3.8 per cent. Under normal conditions the workers would be entitled to a wage increase of 20.3 per cent for the first year and 20.3 for the second year.

In this difficult situation where the Respondents are in real financial difficulty and the workers have suffered a big erosion in the purchasing power of their wages the Court finds it impossible to give workers full compensation to which they are entitled under the Guidelines. The Court cannot risk an award which would lead to these employees losing their jobs.

The Respondents have offered a wage increase of 5 per cent on the current consolidated wages without any backdating and have asked for it to be revised after 12 months.

After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court awards that whatever wage increase is to be given to the workers should be given on their present consolidated wages. The Court accordingly rejects the Claimants' demand for a separate house allowance.

The Court awards that the Respondents should give their employees a wage increase of 5 per cent with effect from 1st January, 1978, and they should give the workers a further wage increase of 7 per cent with effect from 1st January, 1979, the award to remain in force until 31st December, 1979.

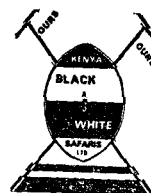
