THE IMMIGRATION ACT

(Cap. 172)

EXEMPTIONS

Incremental credits will be granted to successful candidates who are not civil servants for approved previous experience provided the maximum salary is not exceeded. They will also be eligible for benefits and privileges enjoyed by civil servants in accordance with existing Government Regulations.

Vacancies in the Ministry of Water Development:

Superintendent (Mechanical) (Three Posts) (No. 254/79)

Salary scale.-£1,446 to £1,938 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should have served a recognized apprenticeship in Mechanical Engineering followed by at least six years' workshop experience, part of which should have been in a senior

supervisory capacity. They should have knowledge of workshop costing and stores procedures. They should also have experience in administration, maintenance and operation of motor vehicles and earth-moving equipment. Knowledge of machine tools, gas and electric welding maintenance and repair of earth-moving equipment is desirable.

The successful candidates will be expected to take charge of busy workshops.

Senior Inspector (Mechanical) (Six Posts) (No. 255/79)

Salary scale.—£1,170 to £1,554 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants should be mature persons with good educational background and should have undergone an apprenticeship or approved course in Mechanical Engineering with considerable practical experience some of which should be in a responsible supervisory position requiring workshop administration, costing and staff control. They must be serving in the grade of Inspector Mechanical Job Group "G" or equivalent for at least two years. A knowledge of Mechanical tools, gas and electrical welding is desirable as is experience in fixed and mobile Mechanical nical plant maintenance and repairs. Ability to train junior mechanics is essential.

Two posts are at the Coast Province Water Branch Mombasa, and four posts are in the Ministry's various workshops in the Provinces.

Inspector (Mechanical) (Twenty Posts) (No. 256/79)

Salary scale, \$_£864 to £1,212 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREE-

Applicants must be in possession of the Kenya Government Grade I Trade Test Certificate for Motor Vehicles Mechanics or passed either the East African Examination Council Examination for Motor Vehicle Technicians Course Part I and II and must have served as Motor Vehicle Mechanic I for at least three years. They must be fully conversant with the repair and overhaul of Motor Vehicles, petrol and diesel engines and have knowledge of stationary power plants and must be cap-able of running a small workshop without supervision, inspec-tion and simple technical reports and conduct correspondence. They must also have knowledge of stores, accounts and stock control. They should be in possession of valid driving licences covering heavy commercial vehicles.

Successful candidates may be posted to any of the eight (8) Provinces in Kenya where the Ministry has workshops.

Survey Assistant Grade II (One Post) (No. 257/79)

Applicants must have passed the East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent with credits in Maths and English. They must have either had three years post-qualification experience after passing the final Examination of the Polytechnic Diploma in Surveying or have passed Survey of Kenya Occupational Test Grade I.

Duties will involve the supervision of survey personnel engaged in establising lines and grades for construction, providing basic information for design work and for preparation of maps and plans.

Survey Assistant Grade III (One Post) (No. 258/79)

Salary scale.—£864 to £1,212 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREEMENT.

Applicants must be in possession of the East African Certificate of Education with credits in Mathematics, Geography and English or equivalent Pre-Technical Certificate with appropriate credits. They must have had three years satisfactory service in surveying and must have finally been awarded the National Ordinary Technicians Diploma by the Kenya Polytechnic or passed other equivalent qualifications.

Duties will be related to project survey works, including supervision and taking charge of an independent survey team.

Electrical Technician Grade I (One Post) (No. 259/79)

Salary scale.-£642 to £900 p.a. PENSIONABLE or AGREE-MENT.

Applicants should be holders of Electrical Technicians Certificate Part II of the East African Examination Council or its equivalent. They should be in possession of electricians licence "B" and have at least two years post qualification experience.

Duties will include the maintenance and repair of electrical installations, motors and switchgear. Other operation experience in rewinding of motors and generators will be an advantage.

Applicants must be civil servants with minimum Educational qualifications of East African Certificate of Education or its equivalent and should have completed approved apprenticeship or training in an approved and recognized building and civil works trade and passed the Higher technician's certificate in Civil Engineering ot its equivalent. They must have at least eight years practical experience six of which must have been in a supervisory capacity in the field of Civil Engineering and have knowledge of administration and supervision of Roads Construction and maintenance. They must be neat Draughtsmen able to read and interpret Electrical and Mechanical services, structural engineers and architectural drawing estimate costs of new buildings and alterations with a working method for estimating the quantities of the material required.

Duties will include preparation and construction of Parks and Reserves roads, maintenance of Buildings and road construction equipment.

Applicants should have a degree in Social Science from a recognized University preferably with training in adult education methods. They should also have a thorough knowledge of the job descriptions and duties of extension-workers in all Ministries and Non-Government Organizations. Experience of training for intergrated rural development especially in teamwork will be an advantage.

The successful candidate will be attached to the Rural Services Co-ordination and Training Unit within the Rural Planning Section to review Curricula in non-formal education programmes in training institutions, Ministries and Non-Government Organizations with a view to introducing rural development concepts—especially an understanding of issues related to family life such as health, nutrition, population and family planning.

He/she will be required to assist institutions in developing courses to introduce these concepts and help develop in-service courses for existing extension staff in various Ministries and in Non-Government Organization and to develop information and instructional materials.

Trainee Vacancies in the Ministry of Agriculture (Agricultural Scientific Research Division):

Laboratory Technologist (Trainee) (Twelve Posts) (No. 267/79)

Applicants must posess at least Division II of the East African Certificate of Education with credit passes in English, Mathematics and two approved science subjects, i.e. Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Physical Science.

Training and Conditions

The training period is normally three years and involves attendance on a block or day release pattern depending on the course at Kenya Polytechnic. After appointment, trainees will be attached to the Laboratories or Science Workshop at the National Agricultural Laboratories, Nairobi, but may be posted to other Research Stations in the Republic for practical training.

Trainees will initially be appointed on temporary terms of service and will be paid an allowance of K.Sh. 520 per month plus a house allowance of K.Sh. 350 per month if they are living in privately rented accommodation.

On successful completion of the training, trainees will be eligible for appointment on probationary terms of service, as Laboratory Technologist Grade III, Job Group "G" (£864 to £1,212 p.a.).

Trainee Vacancies in the Ministry of Lands and Settlement:


