#### THE RABIES ACT

(Cap. 365)

ORDER

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 8 of the Rabies Act, the Director of Veterinary Services hereby orders that the following provisions shall have effect and be complied with in the area specified in the Schedule hereto, which is an area in which rabies has broken out:-

- il. For a period of three months from the coming into operation of this order, or for such longer period as the Director of Veterinary Services shall by notice declare, all dogs shall at all times be secured on leads except when in enclosed premises, a dwelling-house, or a building and shall be kept in enclosed premises, a dwelling-house, or a building between the hours of 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- 2. After the expiration of three months or such longer period as aforesaid, all dogs shall be secured on leads at all times when on or near a public road and shall be kept in enclosed premises, a dwelling-house, or a building between the hours of 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- 3. (1) Any dog that is suspected of having been bitten by or been in contact with a rabid animal may, if not destroyed, with the approval of a veterinary officer be secured in a place of isolation as hereinafter provided and kept under observation for a period of at least six months and shall be examined at least once a month by a veterinary officer during such period.
- (2) A dog is deemed to have been in contact with an animal if it has been the same building, kennel, field or other place as the animal.
- 4. For the purposes of paragraph 3, the dog shall be secured in a suitable place of detention in the immediate neighbourhood of the place where the dog is normally kept or in such other place as may be approved by the Director of Veterinary Services.
- 5. The place of detention shall comprise a kennel or other enclosure with sufficient adjoining space to provide for the full liberty of the dog in the open air, the whole being so enclosed as to prevent the escape of the dog therefrom or its contact with any other dog:

Provided that in the absence of such facilities the dog may, as a temporary expedient, be detained in such manner as may be approved by a veterinary officer or inspector.

- 6. A veterinary officer, or any person authorized by him in writing, may destroy any dog not controlled in accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 3, 4 and 5.
- 7. The carcass of an animal that has died from rabies or that has been destroyed on account of rabies shall be burned or buried by the owner or the person in charge of such animal.
- 8. No person shall move any dog or cause any dog to be moved out of or into the area specified in the Schedule without the prior written permission of a veterinary officer.

The Local Purchase Order has now been cancelled and the Government shall not accept any liability for any services rendered or any goods supplied against this Local Purchase Order.

THE INDUSTRIAL COURT CAUSE No. 57 of 1979

Parties:—

Kenya Union of Commercial Food & Allied Workers

and

Bank of India

Issue in dispute:-

Withdrawal of raincoats to subordinate staff.

- 1. The Kenya Union of Commercial Food & Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and the Bank of India shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents.
- 2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 31st day of October, 1979 and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

#### AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 10th July, 1979 duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 10th September, 1979 together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The parties signed a collective agreement on 4th August, 1977 effective from 1st April, 1977 for a period of two years. In this agreement there is a clause dealing with uniforms for technical and subordinate staff. It is clause 28 (a) and reads as follows:

"(a) Office messengers and cleaning staff

- 2 jackets,
- 2 trousers,

4 Shirts,

2 ties,

2 pairs of shoes.

(Raincoasts or capes or umbrellas to be available for use by office messengers carrying out delivery duties, but these items not be issued to individual office messengers."

At the time when the Claimants raised this dispute this agreement was in force. The Claimants, however, maintained that the Respondents had issued raincoats to each member of their subordinate staff on a biennial basis since 1954 up to 1975 after which they had discontinued this practice. The Claimants wanted the issue of raincoats to be reinstated.

The Respondents made it clear that the last issue of raincoats was made in July 1973 after which no issues had been made but pointed out that three umbrellas are made available for use of office messengers when required.

The Claimants' main argument is that the Respondents had acted wrongly in withdrawing a benefit which their members had enjoyed since 1954 notwithstanding they were a party to the aforesaid agreement on the ground that any benefits enjoyed by the workers should not be reduced just because the employer is a party to a collective agreement along with other employers which does not allow that benefit. The Claimants referred the Court to Cause No. 73 of 1975 between themselves and Pan Africa Insurance Co. Ltd. in support of their argument.

The Respondents have very strongly resisted this demand on the ground that the wording of the collective agreement effective from 1st April, 1977 was very clear in that it stated that raincoats or capes or umbrellas are to be made available for use by office messengers carrying out delivery duties but these items are not to be issued to individual office messengers.

The Court would like to point out to the Claimants that the facts in Cause No. 73 of 1975 were quite different to the facts in the present dispute. In that dispute Pan Africa Insurance Co. Ltd. wanted to join the Insurance group which would have resulted in some of the benefits which they allowed their workers to be reduced and the Claimants strongly objected to their joining the group. The Court upheld the Claimants' objections but in this dispute the Respondents are members of the Kenya Bankers' Employers Association which Association has a collective agreement with the Claimants effective from 1st April, 1977 with a clause on uniforms as set out earlier on in the award.

The Court notes that the Claimants informed the Court that during the negotiations of the said collective agreement they had put forward a suggestion which included the additional words. "But these items will be issued to individual office messengers where such practice is in existence". In view of this fit is quite obvious that the Claimants decided to sacrifice these words in order to achieve uniformity on this question in all the banks in the country. If the Claimants had felt very strongly on this matter then they should have declared a dispute with the Respondents and/or the Bankers' Employers Association before signing the 1977 collective agreement. Since they did not do so the Court must uphold the inference that they gave up this demand otherwise either there should have been a proviso to the existing clause catering for their present demand or they should have declared a deadlock and the dispute should have come to the Industrial Court at that time.

The Court finds that the Claimants missed the opportunity of raising this dispute which was prior to the signing of 1977 collective agreement. There is now a properly signed and duly registered collective agreement to which both the Claimants and the Respondents are parties and the Court finds that the Claimants are not entitled to press for any benefits which are not contained therein. In these circumstances the Court is not prepared to order the Respondents to reinstate the issue of raincoats to individual members of the subordinate staff and the Claimants' demand is accordingly rejected.

# IMPORTANT NOTICE TO SUBSCRIBERS TO THE KENYA GAZETTE

THE following notes are for the guidance of persons submitting "copy" for inclusion in the Kenya Gazette, Supplements, etc.:—

- (1) Kenya Gazette contains notices of a general nature and which do not affect legislation, and may be submitted direct to the Government Printer.
- (2) Legislative Supplement contains Rules and Regulations which are issued by the Central Government, and must be submitted through the Office of the Attorney-General.
- (3) Bill Supplement contains Bills which are for introduction into the National Assembly only.
- (4) Act Supplement contains Acts passed by the National Assembly,

All "copy" submitted for publication should be prepared on one side of a foolscap sheet no matter how small the notice or Act, each page being numbered, and should be typewritten with double spacing. Copy should be clear, legible, and contain a minimum of alterations.

Particular attention should be paid to the following points:

- (i) Signatures must be clarified by means of rubber-stamping or typing the name of the signer in capital letters.
- (ii) Dates must be correct and filled in where necessary.
- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings to notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya.

EXTRACT FROM THE CODE OF REGULATIONS, SECTION D-Kenya Gazette

D.41. (1) Communications for the Kenya Gazette should reach the Government Printer not later than 12 noon, on Tuesday of the week that publication is desired. The Government Printer will not publish communications received after that hour until the next subsequent issue of the Gazette.

(2) It will facilitate work at the Press if Permanent Secretaries will forward Gazette notices to the Government Printer when ready.

It is emphasized that these notes are for guidance only, but it is requested that persons submitting copy for publication first satisfy themselves that such copy is complete in every respect.
