Issue in dispute:

Dismissal of E. Muinde.

- 1. The Kenya Union of Commercial Food & Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Barclays Bank of Kenya Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as Respondents.
- 2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 4th March, 1980 and in addition to relying on their written and verbal submissions called the following witnesses to give evidence on oath:

Claimants.-E. Muinde.

Respondents.-S. Gitau.

#### AWARD

- 3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 16th August, 1979 duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 27th December together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.
- E. Muinde was engaged by the Respondents as a clerk on the 11th May, 1971. He was dismissed on 31st December, 1977 when he was a cashier in the Respondents' Kilindini Road branch at Mombasa.

The Claimants reported a trade dispute to the Minister for Labour and an investigation was carried out. The Ministry's findings and recommendation were conveyed to the parties on the 14th July, 1979 in the following terms:

"The investigation revealed that in the past Mr. Muinde had petty shortages and the bank did not take any serious action or give him written warning. In the past six years service he is said to have had 13 identical shortages.

The shortage of 9th December, 1977 was again of petty nature. While the management believed that he had pocketed the money no proof has been produced to support this and I accordingly dismiss this belief.

Mr. Muinde's record while not very satisfactory, with the final incident, should not have resulted in instant dismissal. The management acted rather harshly.

I recommend that the dismissal be reduced to normal termination with the payment of terminal benefits as per the parties' collective agreement."

The Respondents accepted the Ministry's recommendation but the Claimants asked for the dispute to be settled through the Industrial Court.

The facts leading up to the dismissal of Mr. Muinde are that on the 9th December, 1977 while he was a cashier he had a shortage of K.Sh. 199/50. This shortage was, however, discovered the following day on 10th when another bank employee was allocated to take over from Mr. Muinde. When the money was counted in Mr. Muinde's presence the shortage of K.Sh. 199/50 was discovered. The money was counted once again but the shortage was still there. The matter was then reported to the accountant.

Mr. Muinde while giving evidence on oath stated that at the end of the day on 9th December, he had balanced the cash and at that time he found no shortage. He, however, stated that the next day the money was counted "in details" when the shortage was detected. He maintained that it was a genuine shortage as he had apparently ovarpaid the sum of K.Sh. 200 to a messenger from Central Pharmacy who had come for some change.

The Court notes that subsequent inquiries made by Mr. Muinde at the Central Pharmacy and the messanger invalved were not fruitful because they denied that they had been overpaid K.Sh. 200.

The Court must refer to the undersigned statement by two persons, one a union shopsteward, on this incident on the 22nd December, 1977:

"We the undersigned Zachary Karanja Gichini as union shopsteward and Stephen Mutui have considered the matter and all the evidence relating to the shortage found in the till of E. K. Muinde on the 10th December, 1977 and we have come to the conclusion that the circumstances of the difference is highly suspicious and the explanation given by him are not convincing."

Further to the above there is a letter from the shopsteward written to the chairman of Central Staff Committee on the 17th January, 1978 where he wrote as follows:

"I refer to our telephone conversation between Mr. Ayieche and the undersigned and confirm that I have had another meeting with he branch management on the matter and have come to the conclusion that the bank had a valid case against Mr. Muinde.

I mentioned here that the management acted after consultation with me as branch shopsteward although at the time I was not aware of the disciplinary action the bank was going to take.

However, I am of the opinion that the management had not in this case acted out of malice and we can only request the bank to reconsider Mr. Muinde's case sympathetically and reinstate him."

The Court has carefully considered the facts in this dispute and the evidence tendered by the parties and has come to the conclusion that the incident that led Mr. Muinde's termination could not be taken lightly. If there had been a normal shortage during the course of a day's business then Mr. Muinde should have spotted this shortage at the end of the day but he himself admitted that there was no shortage on 9th December. The Court is convinced that if a new cashier had not been allocated to take over from Muinde the next day this shortage may not have come to light, not so soon at least. The Court has taken into account what the Claimants stated that Muinde had once detected two frauds, one involving K.Sh. 8,500 and another K.Sh. 1,650. The Respondents stated that they had no knowledge of these incidents. The Court, however, while giving Muinde credit for this has come to the conclusion that the shortage of 9th December was not a normal shortage and therefore the bank were justified in terminating his services. The Court would like to recall that Mr. Muinde's record showed that from 1972 he was short in his till on 14 occasions and on several occasions letters of reprimand were issued to him.

The Court cannot encourage this sort of behavour among workers particularly when they deal with money. The Respondents stated that the banks in Kenya were losing millions of shillings every six months. The Court can find no grounds in this dispute to justify a reversal of the Respondents' decision to terminate the services of Mr. Muinde. Since the Respondents have accepted the Ministry's recommendation the Court cannot help the Claimants any more and the Court accordingly rejects the Claimants' demand that Mr. Muinde should be reinstated and paid compensation for the time he was out of employment. Mr. Muinde should collect the amount that has been offered by the Respondents in accordance with the Ministry of Labour's recommendation if he has not already done so.
