Premature retirement of Babtista Kaburia.

- 1. The Kenya Local Government Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Nairobi City Council shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents.
- 2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 28th October, 1980 and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 28th March, 1980 duly signed by the parties was received by the Court on 21st July together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

In February, 1970 the Respondents at the request of the Chief City Superintendent decided to get 18 city askaris who looked too old and incapable of performing their duties to be examined by their doctor to ascertain if they had reached the retirement age of 60 years. B. Kaburia was one of these 18 askaris.

It was found by the Medical Officer of Health that he had not reached the age of 60 years vide a letter which he wrote to the Chief City Superintendent on 23rd November, 1972. He did suggest that Mr. Kaburia should be re-examined after two years.

It appears that he was again examined by the Assistant Medical Officer of Health who stated on 20th February, 1975 that Mr. Kaburia had now produced his identity card and according to it he is 58 years of age. Thereafter the Respondents took a decision to retire him form their service with effect from 1st April, 1978 on the ground of old age.

The Claimants took up the matter on behalf of Mr. Kaburia and reported a dispute to the Minister for Labour and an investigation was carried out. The Ministry's findings and recommendation were as follows conveyed to the parties on 21st February, 1980.

"It was found out to be true that Mr. Kaburia was examined by the Council's Medical Officer on two occasions and the verdict was that he had not attained the age of 60 which was the retiring age.

The National Social Security Fund showed that he was born between 1921 and 1922.

Therefore the retirement of Mr. Kaburia was found to be immature and wrongful as shown by the records quoted above.

In view of the facts contained in this report I recommend that Mr. Kaburia be reinstated back to his post without loss of benefits or break of service. He should also be paid half pay for the months he has been out of employment."

During the hearing the Claimants produced different documents showing that Mr. Kaburia had not reached the retirement age at the time he was retired by the Respondents. These documents are:

- (a) An identity card issued on 19th May, 1954 in which his age is given as 28 years.
- (b) A certificate of marriage native registry dated 20th July 1952 in which his age is given as 24 years.
- (c) An age assessment certificate issued by a doctor at Kenyatta National Hospital on 7th March, 1979 which gives his age as 52 years.
- (d) The latest identity card issued on 18th April, 1979 which shows his date of birth as 1927.
- (e) The National Social Security Fund (NSSF) computer record which gives his year of birth as 1925.

The Court has been asked to make a finding based on all these documents which are at variance with each other and are in conflict with the original identity certificate which Mr. Kaburia himself produced to the Respondents' Medical Officer of Health.

The Court decided to summon a representative of the NSSF to produce their official records of Mr. Kaburia's age. This official confirmed that the letter dated 23rd September, 1980 written by the Acting Director is correct and that the computer sheet showed an error regarding Mr. Kaburia's birth date.

This witness produced a copy of a certificate issued under the Native Registration Ordinance 1921 in which his circumcision age is given as Kiabita. The Acting Director of NSSF confirmed that this is the correct identity card No. 194291 issued on 20th March, 1942 and that according to this his date of birth is 1921.

The Court while appreciating the efforts made by the Claimants on Mr. Kaburia's behalf in producing all the aforementioned documents in support of their case proving that his birth date was between 1926 and 1928 has decided to rely on the NSSF records. At the same time the Court cannot overlook the fact that Mr. Kaburia did produce an identity card which was mentioned by the Assistant Medical Officer of Health in his letter of 20th February, 1975 according to which he was 58 years of age at that time.

The Court notes that Mr. Kaburia's retirement was confirmed by the Respondents' full council meeting held on 7th March 1978 and that he was paid as follows:

Both parties are agreed that through the carelessness of somebody Mr. Kaburia was overpaid the sum of K.Sh. 7,735 as he remained on the Respondents' payroll until 31st October, 1979.

The Court must at this stage refer to a medical examination form which was completed on 21st July, 1964 for the purpose of superannuation in which Mr. Kaburia's date of birth is given at first as 1927 which is deleted and the date of birth then is given as 1917. This alteration has been initialled by the medical officer. Notwithstanding this the Court sticks to its earlier decision of going by Mr. Kaburia's age as it appears in the NSSF records.

The Court finds that Mr. Kaburia was 57 years old when the Respondents decided to retire him but then the Respondents took the decision mainly through Mr. Kaburia's own action in producing an identity card in February 1975 which showed his age to be 58 years at that time. In these circumstances the Court has decided that although it finds that Mr. Kaburia was prematurely retired the dictates of justice required that he should not be reinstated and he should be given only compensation for the premature retirement. After careful consideration of all the submissions the Court awards that Mr. Kaburia should be paid 12 months salary by way of compensation for the premature retirement that he has suffered. The Court was told that his salary at the time of retirement was K.Sh. 1,316 p.m.






