THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

CAUSE No. 70 OF 1982

Parties:

Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers
and
Fox Theatres (E.A.) Ltd.

Issue in dispute:

Dismissal of Matayo Opongo.

THE Kenya Union of Commercial Food and Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Fox Theatres (E.A.) Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 15th November, 1982, and in addition to relying on their written and verbal submissions called the following witnesses to give evidence, on oath:

Claimant.—Matayo Opongo.

Respondents.—E. O. Hassan and S. Njoroge.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 1st September, 1981, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 22nd July, 1982, together with the statutory certificates signed by the Minister for Labour and the Labour Commissioner.

This dispute concerns a person who had served the Respondents from 1968 until 19th November, 1980, when his services were terminated. He was at the time an usher/barman.

The reason for his termination was an allegation that on 13th November, 1980, he allowed four persons to get into the Kenya Cinema for the 9 p.m. show on one ticket. He was offered one month's salary plus leave due to him. The Claimants took up the matter on his behalf and reported the dispute to the Minister for Labour and the dispute was investigated by the Ministry whose findings which were released to the parties on 24th August, 1981, confirmed that Mr. Opongo had allowed the four patrons in the theatre against one ticket but considering that he had rendered good service to the Respondents for many years recommended that his dismissal should be converted to normal termination and he should be paid his terminal benefits in accordance with the parties' collective agreement.

During the hearing the court heard the evidence of Mr. Opongo and two witnesses called by the Respondents—Messrs. Hassan and Njoroge. The court is satisfied after carefully considering the evidence of these witnesses that Mr. Opongo did on the material day admit four patrons into the cinema on one ticket and he was seen doing this by the watchman, Mr. Hassan. Mr. Hassan appeared to be a truthful witness who clearly described what he saw—in that four patrons came and Mr. Opongo went to one of them and talked to him after which both of them went to the ticket window and Mr. Opongo gave the cashier K.Sh. 20 and got one ticket and K.Sh. 8 change which Mr. Opongo kept. After this Mr. Opongo took all the four patrons into the cinema. Mr. Hassan after confirming that only one ticket was issued by the cashier reported the matter to the manager who then came and went into cinema and brought the four patrons out. The manager asked all of them to come to his office at which point Mr. Opongo intervened and told them that he had helped them and that they should run away. The manager managed to catch one of the patrons and Mr. Opongo also caught him and a tug of war ensued at which point Mr. Hassan intervened and helped the manager take the patron inside the office. The manager confirmed from the patron that they had bought only one ticket for K.Sh. 20 and the change had been pocketed by Mr. Opongo.

The court finds that the submissions put on behalf of Mr. Opongo by the Claimants are very flimsy indeed and it was obviously an attempt to make out some sort of a case when it was perfectly clear that Mr. Opongo had indeed committed a gross misconduct.

The court finds this to be a straightforward case in which an employee was found to have committed a very grave offence which falls within clause 27 (a) of the collective agreement and notwithstanding the almost 12 years' service of Mr. Opongo the court is unable to help him. The court would like to emphasize once again that it will not help dishonest workers. The court accordingly rejects the Claimants' demand made on behalf of Mr. Opongo and directs that he is entitled to only what the Respondents have offered him in his letter of termination.

THE INDUSTRIAL COURT

CAUSE No. 85 OF 1982

Parties:

Kenya Union of Commercial Food & Allied Workers
and
Trufoods Ltd.

Issue in dispute:

House allowance.

THE Kenya Union of Commercial Food & Allied Workers shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Trufoods Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 2nd December, 1982, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 10th May, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 17th August together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The parties' collective agreement expired on 31st December, 1981, and it had a consolidated wage clause. During negotiations for revising the collective agreement the Claimants put forward a demand and indeed insisted that the workers should be given a separate house allowance. The Respondents refused to give in and although the parties settled all other issues they decided to refer the dispute on house allowance to the Industrial Court. It should, however, be noted that after the General Wages Order which came into force on 1st August, 1982, the Respondents had made the following proposals:

"(i) That the company would deconsolidate wages by showing the amount of housing allowance separately so as to comply with the union's previous request and the Regulation of Wages (General) Order 1982.

"(ii) That the housing element would be 15 per cent of the basic minimum wage for each grade as stipulated in the new Wages Order."

During the hearing the Claimants argued that the workers were entitled to a house allowance of K.Sh. 500 per month and pointed out that the Respondents were the only firm who were engaged in the same trade which did not give a separate house allowance like others i.e. Kenya Cannery Ltd. and Kenya Orchards Ltd.

The Respondents submitted that they had given the workers full entitlement under the guidelines by way of wage increases by offering them 11 per cent and 9 per cent for those earning above K.Sh. 800. They argued that if additional house allowance was awarded it would be violation of wages guidelines. They offered the following clause to cover the house allowance issue:

"It is agreed that 15 per cent of the basic minimum wage provided for under the minimum wages clause of this agreement shall constitute the housing allowance payment for every employee falling within the given grades under that clause."

The parties having themselves agreed to deconsolidation of wages it remains now for the court to determine an additional house allowance the workers should get on top of the wage increases already negotiated and agreed. The analysis prepared by the Division of Manpower Planning and Development shows that the Claimants are entitled to a maximum compensation of 26.6 per cent on wages. This being so, the court would like to refer to Guideline 4 (b) (1) which reads:

"(iv) (b) (i) Separate compensation for rent increases in addition to (iv) (a) above should be allowed provided that this will not exceed one half of the permissible percentage compensation due for a particular group as provided for under guideline (iv) (a) above."

Keeping in view the movement of cost of living indices and the revised guidelines which became effective on 1st August, 1982, the workers are entitled to an additional improvement in house allowance to a maximum compensation ceiling of 13.3 per cent. Keeping all these points in view the court has decided to award all the employees a house allowance of K.Sh. 76 per month on top of the 15 per cent housing element of the existing consolidated wages and that this award on house allowance should be with effect from 1st August, 1982, and should remain in force for the duration period of two years which the parties have agreed with effect from 1st January, 1982.

THE following notes are for the guidance of persons submitting "copy" for inclusion in the *Kenya Gazette, Supplements*, etc.:

- (1) The *Kenya Gazette* contains notices of a general nature which do not affect legislation. They are therefore submitted to the Government Printer directly.
- (2) *Legislative Supplement* contains Rules and Regulations which are issued by the Central Government. Because of this they must be submitted to the Government Printer through the office of the Attorney-General.
- (3) *Bill Supplement* contains Bills which are for introduction into the National Assembly.
- (4) *Act Supplement* contains Acts passed by the National Assembly.

All "copy" submitted for publication should be prepared on one side of an A4 sheet no matter how small the notice or Act, each page being numbered, and should be typewritten with double spacing. Copy should be clear, legible and contain a minimum of alterations.

Particular attention should be paid to the following points:

- (i) Signatures must be clarified by means of rubber-stamping or typing the name of the signer in capital letters.
- (ii) Dates must be correct and filed in where necessary.
- (iii) Care should be taken to ensure that all headings to notices and references to legislation are up to date and conform with the Revised Edition of the Laws of Kenya.

EXTRACT FROM THE CODE OF REGULATIONS, SECTION D—

Kenya Gazette

"D.14.(1) Communications for the *Kenya Gazette* should reach the Government Printer not later than 12 noon, on Tuesday of the week that publication is desired. The Government Printer will not publish communications received after that hour until the next subsequent issue of the *Gazette*.

"(2) It will facilitate work at the Press if Permanent Secretaries will forward *Gazette* notices to the Government Printer when ready."

It is emphasized that these notes are for guidance only, but it is requested that persons submitting copy for publication first satisfy themselves that such copy is complete in every respect.
