THE Transport and Allied Workers' Union shall hereinafter be referred to as the Claimants and Port Transport Co. (1974) Ltd. shall hereinafter be referred to as the Respondents.

2. The parties were heard in Nairobi on the 31st January, 1983, and relied on their written and verbal submissions.

AWARD

3. The Notification of Dispute Form "A" dated 24th June, 1982, duly signed by the parties was received by the court on 1st October together with the statutory certificate signed by the Labour Commissioner.

The parties had a collective agreement in force in 1979 which contained a clause on acting allowance reading as follows:

"10. Where an employee is required to act in a higher grade for a period of not less than 30 days he shall be paid, in addition to his basic minimum wages an acting allowance equal either to 25 per cent of the basic wages of the employee for whom he is acting or to the full basic wages of the employee, whichever is the lesser amount."

It is not disputed that Mr. Maloba who is working for the Respondents as a mechanic was asked to perform some higher duties than his normal work with the Claimants maintaining that he was asked to act as an acting foreman in charge of mechanics department on 5th April, 1979, and the Respondents stating that they agreed to pay him a special duty allowance of K.Sh. 200 p.m. in view of the extra duties he might be called upon to perform in the absence of the foreman.

The matter was conciliated upon informally by the Ministry of Labour and it appears that the conciliator was satisfied that Mr. Maloba had acted in a higher grade during the clause 10 of the parties' collective agreement he should be paid a sum of K.Sh. 2,164.10 to cover the period 5th April to November, 1979.

The Claiman'ts accepted the recommendations of the informal conciliation but the Respondents rejected them which forced the Claimants to report a formal trade dispute to the Minister for Labour

The court is satisfied that the then foreman, Mr. Kakoo, used to earn a sum of K.Sh. 3,000 p.m. The Respondents, however, maintain that he had been engaged for a special task for a fixed period of one year. The Respondents have since employed another foreman on 4th Dcember, 1979, who is one Mr. Ismail Kassim and who is earning K.Sh. 3,500 p.m.

The court cannot accept the Respondents' submission that since the post of a foreman was not mentioned in the collective agreement at that time Mr. Maloba is not entitled to any acting allowance. If a unionizable employee is asked to act in a position of a non-unionizable employee he is entitled to get

the acting allowance in accordance with the provisions of the collective agreement.

The court is satisfied that Mr. Kakoo left the Respondents' employment having completed his fixed term of employment the Respondents have employed another foreman in his place who is earning K.Sh. 3,500 p.m., K.Sh. 500 more than what Mr. Kakoo used to earn. In view of this development the Claimants' claim for an acting allowance is valid because Mr. Maloba was acting as a foreman in a vacant post which has subsequently been filled.

The court has carefully considered all aspects of this dispute and finds that the Claimants' approach is reasonable under the circumstances in that they have based their claim on a salary of K.Sh. 2,000 instead of K.Sh. 3,000 which Mr. Kakoo was earning notwithstanding the fact that in their latest collective agreement they have evaluated the post of the foreman at K.Sh. 1,000.

After careful consideration of all the submissions the court finds that the informal conciliation came to the right conclusion in this dispute and the court accordingly awards that Mr. Maloba should be paid an acting allowance of K.Sh. 2,164.10 for the period between 5th April, 1979, to the end of November, 1979, during which he acted as a foreman.




